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Officer stopped a vehicle for FTYOW. The male driver provided the officer with a fictitious name. Officers attempted to arrest the male who actively resisted arrest. A struggle ensued and the suspect, using manual force, was taken down to a prone-handcuffing position. The male later admitted to having a pre-existing shoulder injury. The driver also sustained injuries consistent with prone-handcuffing on asphalt. The arrestee told me that his shoulder, jaw and face hurts. Please attach photographs and radio traffic.

**Reviewing Supervisor: Sgt. Kakuda #443**

**Incident Summary:** Officer Pavlischak stopped a vehicle for FTYOW. The male driver provided the officer with a fictitious name. Officers attempted to arrest the male who actively resisted arrest. A struggle ensued and the suspect, using manual force, was taken down to a prone-handcuffing position. The male later admitted to having a pre-existing shoulder injury. The driver also sustained injuries consistent with prone-handcuffing on asphalt.

**Officers Interview Summaries:** Officers written reports reflect the statements they made to me.

**Subject Interview Summary:** I contacted Larry Tuckey at the SCSO Jail. I observed Tuckey laying down in the holding cell and he began moaning and groaning as he attempted to sit-up.

Larry Tuckey's paraphrased statement: He was told to place his hands behind of his back. Officers "wrenched" his arms behind of his back. He attempted to warn officers of his bad shoulder. He told me that, "I don't remember half of what happened." There were three officers attempting to arrest him. Approximately five years ago, he suffered a broken rotator cuff and shattered collar bone. Between the five years and now, he says it still hurts all the time. He said he "fought" with officers to protect his bad shoulder, but was told to "shut-up" when he told them of his shoulder problems. He kept fighting with officers even when he was on the ground, fearing that his shoulder would "break." He added that he "freaked out" due to having a warrant. He said that "I messed up, no excuse for that." He informed me that his shoulder, face, and jaw hurts. He further added that he is "afraid" of jail and wants his "freedom," explaining to me his earlier actions.

I confirmed with Tuckey that he verbally told/informed the officers that he had a bad shoulder, which he acknowledged he did.

It should be noted that jail staff accepted Tuckey without first having him get medically cleared. See my body camera footage for more information.

**Witness Interview Summary:** See below officer's body camera footage for more information.



**Witness Officer Interview Summary BWC Y/N:** Officer Matt's body camera footage caught a female passenger's statement saying something to the fact that "what are you doing, stay in the car," referring to Tuckey.

**Any Relevant Clarifying Information and Observations:** I viewed Officer Matt's body camera footage a couple of times. Not once during the arrest process did Tuckey inform/tell the officers that he had shoulder issues. I did hear Tuckey say once when he was placed against an officer's patrol car, something to the fact of "oh my arm" and he has "pin pricks in my fingers." Also, I heard one of the female passengers say to Officer Pavlischak something along the lines of "what are you doing, stay in the car," referring to Tuckey.

**Sergeant Findings:**

Officers were within policy and did not use excessive force to arrest Tuckey.



071916 (1808hrs) I was headed N/B on Lidgerwood, South of Lacrosse. Susp Larry Tuckey was driving in susp veh headed E/B on Lacrosse, West of Lidgerwood. The susp was facing a yield sign. He drove through the sign without delay. I had to abruptly slam on my brakes to avoid colliding with his veh.

I pulled in behind the veh and the susp immediately pulled over. As I was putting out the stop to dispatch the susp immediately got out of the veh. I exited and ordered him back into the driver's seat. I stood outside of my veh to get his plate and looked back at Lidgerwood to get my cross street.

While I had turned my back the susp got out of the veh a second time and dropped a box of crackers onto the ground. He told me he had accidentally dropped the crackers and was picking them up. I put my hand on my firearm and told him to get back into the car and not get out again. He got back into the car but left the door ajar.

I approached the veh and observed there were two other females and another male in the car with him. I got his information and was given the name- Tuckey, Christen L. July 30, 1976. He had to think about the spelling on his name and date of birth. I walked back to my veh and observed his door open slightly again. He was looking at every move I was making through his rear view mirror.

I called for backup to respond and stood by outside of my veh. Ofcs Matt and Henderson arrived and I had them watch the susp while I ran his name. The susp had advised he didn't have his drivers license with him at the time and couldn't show me any other veh information. I ran his name and found his DOL photo.

His DOL photo did not match his face at all. I knew the name he had given me was false and his actions before making contact put me on alert of his possible attempt to flee or fight with us. I also had concerns of the three other occupants inside the veh with him.

We went back up to the veh and I had him step out. I immediately took right arm control and ordered him to turn around and put his hands behind his back. Ofc Matt took left arm control and the susp struggled to bring both arms into his upper chest area.

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I yelled at him to put his arms behind his back and put his right hand into a wrist lock. He continued to fight and struggle attempting to pull away from us. I was able to get his arm behind his back and we forced him down onto the pavement. He was able to get his left arm away from Ofc Matt and brought it under his body.

We continued to yell at him to get his arm out and he was able to get his knees up to his chest. He was trying to stand up and pull away from us. I forced his right arm straight up behind his head and grabbed his hair. I then pulled his head sideways forcing his right cheek flat onto the pavement.

I forced my right knee onto the back of his neck and put some of my weight onto his neck and upper body. I was attempting to get him to prone out and give up his left arm. Ofc Matt was able to get the arm out and after continuing to struggle, we finally got his hands behind his back. We had to force his hands together to get them cuffed up. Once he was cuffed he continued to try to get his knees up to his chest to stand back up.

He continued to struggle and I took both of his cuffed arms and pulled them straight up into the air. I then again forced my knee onto the back of his neck and upper body and we were finally able to get him into the prone cuffing position. Once he was proned out he advised he was done and did not want to resist any longer.

We were able to stand him up, get him to the back of my patrol veh and search him. He gave me his true identity and it was found he had a warrant out of Airway Heights for DWLS 3rd. DOL showed he was also currently DWLS 3rd. We ran the other three occupants in the veh and the susp requested we secure the veh and leave it on scene.

He was transported to jail and enroute apologized for fighting with us. He said he was scared because he knew he had the warrant and didn't know what to do. Once at jail we had medical staff look him over. He had superficial abrasions on his right cheek and forehead from the altercation.

He was also complaining of left arm/shoulder pain. I contacted Sgt Kakudo and informed him of the situation. He responded to the jail and conducted an interview with the susp. The susp was booked into jail on his warrant, obstructing and DWLS 3rd. He was cited and released for failure to yield at the yield sign, no insurance, no registration and no license on person.

The susp was cleared by jail medical staff and booked. There were no other apparent wits to interview at the time or apparent evidence to gather. I forward my report and cleared the call.

On 7/19/2016 at approximately 1808 hours, I heard Officer J.Pavlishak make a traffic stop at Lidgerwood St. and Lacrosse Ave. Officer Henderson and I were patrolling as a two man car and responded to back Officer Pavlishak on the traffic stop.

As we pulled up to the traffic stop we parked parallel with Officer Pavlishak's patrol vehicle. Officer Pavlishak told us to watch the driver because he was moving around in the vehicle for some unknown reason. As Officer Pavlishak ran the driver's name that he was given, he checked a Department of Licensing photo of the name the driver gave. The person in the DOL photo didn't match what the driver looked like. Officer Pavlishak advised we were going to contact the driver to see who he really was.

We walked up to the vehicle and asked the driver to step out of the vehicle. We told the driver to turn around and face the vehicle. The driver refused to turn around and comply with our commands. Officer Henderson and Officer Pavlishak grabbed the male driver by his arms. The male began to pull away and kept his back against the vehicle. I grabbed the males left arm and placed his arm behind his back while Officer Pavlishak had control of the males right arm. The male continued to try and pull away. We were able to walk the male back to the rear of his vehicle as he continued to attempt to pull away with his arms. We decided to place the male on the ground to gain better control of him. We pulled the male on the ground for the following reasons:

## Crime:

The male was obstructing our investigation by giving a false name to Officer Pavlishak. The male was resisting arrest by not complying with our commands after we pulled him out of the vehicle.

## Threat:

The male posed a threat by previously moving around in the vehicle. It is unknown if he was concealing weapons or grabbing weapons during his movement. The male wasn't pat searched for weapons and he was wearing baggy pants that can easily conceal multiple items on his person. The car was occupied by three other unknown subjects who haven't been contacted or identified. There was no way of knowing if they had weapons or access to ones to help the male. It was

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unknown if the male knew more people in the neighborhood where if he was able to flee he could easily access some weapons.

### Resistance:

The male immediately resisted commands to turn around and face the car by backing up and placing his back against the driver's side of the vehicle. Upon grabbing his arms, he tensed up by balling up his fists and widening his stance for balance. He attempted multiple times to pull his arms away and break free from our control. He refused to get on the ground by moving his feet to keep his balance. He continued to pull away after multiple commands for him to stop resisting. Once he was going to the ground he got onto his knees and was able to pull his left arm back underneath him towards his unsearched waist.

We were able to gain control of both of the males arms, place the male fully on his stomach, and he was secured in handcuffs, DL behind his back. The male continued to kick at us as we were gaining control of his legs. The male calmed down and was helped up by Officer Pavlischak and myself. After helping up the male we noticed he had an abrasion from the pavement on the right side of his face consistent with prone handcuffing.

We escorted the male to the rear of Officer Pavilschak's patrol vehicle. We advised the male he was under arrest for resisting and obstructing. The male finally identified himself as Larry Tuckey. Upon running Larry's name, Officer Pavlischak advised he had a misdemeanor warrant for DWLS 3rd.

Larry was placed in the rear seat of Officer Pavlischak's patrol vehicle and transported the Spokane County Jail. Larry didn't complain of any injuries after we got him in handcuffs. See Officer Pavlischak's report for further information.

There is no more information at this time.

On 07-19-2016 at 1808 hours, Officer Matt and I were working as a two man patrol unit for the City of Spokane. We were driving our fully marked patrol vehicle, equipped with emergency lights and audible siren. We were both wearing our department issued uniforms, which clearly identified us as police officers.

We were dispatched as an assisting unit to Officer Pavlischak, who was on a traffic stop at the corner of N Lidgerwood St and E Lacrosse.

When we arrived I could see there were four occupants of the vehicle. Officer Pavlischak stated when he stopped the vehicle, it looked as if the driver, later identified as Larry Tuckey, was going to attempt to run. Officer Pavlischak then pulled up a DOL photo of the name the driver had given and stated it did not look like the driver. He showed the photo to Officer Matt who also agreed the photo did not match the driver. Officer Pavlischak then told Officer Matt and myself that he wanted us to assist in getting the driver out of the vehicle and detaining him.

Officer Pavlischak, Officer Matt and myself approached the vehicle on the driver's side. Officer Pavlischak told Larry to exit the vehicle and turn around. At that time, Larry stepped out of the vehicle, but did not do as he was instructed and continued to face us. Officer Pavlischak grabbed a hold of Larry's right arm and I attempted to grab a hold of Larry's left arm. Larry began to tense up his muscles and began to shuffle his feet to the left. Officer Matt eventually grabbed a hold of Larry's left arm, but Larry continued to struggle. Larry was given verbal commands multiple times to turn around, but he did not listen. Officer Pavlischak stated we should take Larry to the ground, in the prone position in order to place handcuffs on him. I grabbed a hold of Larry's hair in order to help guide him to the ground. We decided to place Larry in the prone position for the following reasons:

Crimes:

Larry was obstructing our investigation by giving someone else's name instead of his. He was resisting arrest by pulling his hands away and not following our commands as we tried to detain him.

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Larry looked as if he was looking around in order to find an avenue of escape. Based on my training and experience this made me think he was going to run from the vehicle. Larry had not given his correct name, which caused me to believe he may be hiding his identity due to having warrants or being listed as a suspect in a crime. There were three occupants of the vehicle which added the threat of being assaulted by one of the occupants during our struggle to place Larry into handcuffs. I had to divide my attention between placing Larry into handcuffs and watching the vehicle, which did not allow me to focus on gaining control of Larry. I did not know if there were any weapons inside the vehicle that could be accessed by the other occupants or Larry. Larry had not yet been searched so I did not know if Larry had any weapons on him or if he was trying to access a weapon. Larry was actively resisting our efforts by tensing his muscles and shifting his weight back and forth.

### Resistance:

Larry was actively resisting our efforts to place him into handcuffs by not turning around to face the car as he was instructed. Larry actively resisted when he tensed his muscles and began to wiggle back and forth as soon as we attempted to grab onto his arms. Larry was told multiple times to stop resisting and he would not comply. Once Larry was on the ground he continued to struggle and would not place his hands behind his back. Larry finally stopped moving around and placed his hands behind his back when he was threatened to have a Taser deployed on him.

After Larry was placed into the prone position he was placed in handcuffs without further incident (gauged and double locked). Upon helping Larry to his feet, we noticed he had a small abrasion on his right cheek from the pavement consistent with prone handcuffing. Officer Pavlischak then transported Larry to Spokane County Jail.
