On 8/14/16 at 2039 hours, Officer Rankin and I were dispatched to 3902 E. Pacific reference a hit and run collision.

Upon arrival, I observed a gray 2005 Mitsubishi sedan parked sideways across the sidewalk and curb in front of 3902 E. Pacific. The vehicle's roof was caved in, the rear windshield was smashed out and the front windshield was caved in. The rear lights were broken and there was body damage to the trunk.

I spoke with a witness (Harry Simpson) who lives across the street from 3902 E. Pacific. Simpson said at around 1745 hours, he observed a skip loader tractor drive westbound on E. Pacific. The tractor turned toward the Mitsubishi sedan and pushed it from the street, over the curb and onto the sidewalk. The tractor's bucket was raised above the vehicle and dropped on top of the vehicle three times, causing major damage to the vehicle. The tractor then drove back eastbound on E. Pacific. Simpson did not see who was driving the tractor.

I spoke to Ashlee Weber, who also witnessed the incident. Weber said she was outside of 3902 E. Pacific when she observed a male (described as a white male in his mid 30's, tall and thin, clean shaven and wearing a black T-shirt and black jeans) exit the residence at 3821 E. Pacific. The male walked into the front yard of 3902 E. Pacific and said "Olly olly oxen free!" He walked up to a white Cadillac parked in the driveway and looked inside. The male stated "That shouldn't be hard to get into." He then said, "You guys fucked up. I hope you guys have big guns!" The male walked eastbound on E. Pacific and south on Myrtle. A short time later, the same male drove westbound on E. Pacific in a large tractor. He used the tractor to push the Mitsubishi sedan onto the sidewalk and then he smashed the roof of the vehicle with the bucket. The male then drove the tractor eastbound on E. Pacific and southbound on Myrtle. Weber then saw the male walking n/b on Myrtle.

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Weber told her friend, Desirae Scott about the incident. Scott, who's boyfriend owns the Mitsubishi, called police to report the incident.

I spoke to Scott, who said she parked the Mitsubishi on the south curb in front of 3902 E. Pacific earlier in the day. There was no damage on the vehicle. The vehicle belongs to her boyfriend, Scott Lindquist.

Scott said earlier in the day, Lindquist was in a fight with a male named Justin who lives at 3821 E, Pacific. Police responded and Justin was arrested for a warrant. Scott believed Justin was the individual who damaged Lindquist's vehicle because he was upset about the fight and getting arrested.

I checked the call history from earlier in the day. There was a physical altercation reported at 3902 E. Pacific and Justin Walls was arrested for a warrant. Walls resides at 3821 E. Pacific.

Officer Rankin and I made contact with Angela Brazeau at 3821 E. Pacific. Brazeau said Walls is her boyfriend. She said he was attacked in front of 3902 E Pacific earlier in the day. Brazeau said 3902 E. Pacific is a drug house and Walls is the only person in the neighborhood who is brave enough to confront the drug dealers there. Brazeau said Walls was arrested for a warrant and she had not seen him since he was arrested. I informed her about the incident with the vehicle and she said she didn't know anything about it. Brazeau agreed to call SPD if Walls showed back up at her residence.

Corporal Bodie responded to photograph the damage to the Mitsubishi. He also photographed the tractor, which was parked on Myrtle just south of Pacific. The tractor's bucket had fresh scrapes on the blade and inside, consistent with the damage described by the witnesses. Corporal Bodie also noted the ignition appeared to have been tampered with. Corporal Bodie attempted to contact the owner of the tractor but he was unable to reach anyone.

Scott attempted to get ahold of Lindquist regarding his vehicle, but she was unable to do so.

Due to the extensive major body damage to the vehicle, it will likely be considered a total loss (estimated damage \$9,000).

Refer to the collision report for further details.

At 2254 hours, Scott called SPD to report Justin had walked by her residence and pointed a pistol at her house. Scott said Justin was walking westbound on E. Pacific. Scott said Justin was wearing a hooded sweatshirt and jeans.

Sgt. Kannberg and I arrived at the location and observed a male standing in the open doorway of

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3821 E. Pacific with Brazeau. The male was wearing a dark hooded sweatshirt and pants. He was screaming something similar to "you're going down!" toward 3902 E. Pacific. I recognized the male to be similar in appearance to Walls, based on his physical descriptors and a jail booking photograph I viewed earlier.

I illuminated the male with my flashlight and asked him to put his hands up so I could verify he was unarmed. The male and Brazeau retreated into the residence and slammed the door. Several officers arrived and established containment on the residence.

I spoke to Scott, who said it was actually Weber who saw Justin walk by. I spoke to Weber, who said she was inside of 3902 E. Pacific. She looked out the window and, across the street, she observed a male wearing a hooded sweatshirt. The male bladed his body and held his arm up toward the residence as if he was holding a pistol. Weber could not tell if he had anything in his hand. She also could not see the male well enough to be able to say it was the same male who crushed the Mitsubishi earlier. The male walked westbound on E. Pacific and south on Myrtle. She did not see the male again.

A neighbor from across the street walked up as I was speaking with Weber and said the male was not holding a gun. The neighbor said he saw the male with the hooded sweatshirt point a slingshot at the crushed vehicle and shoot something at it. The male walked westbound on E. Pacific. The neighbor only described the male as wearing a hooded sweatshirt. The neighbor said he didn't think the male in the hooded sweatshirt was Justin.

I returned to 3821 E. Pacific. Officer Stewart had made contact with Brazeau on the porch. Brazeau was screaming and belligerent. She said Walls was not inside and she hadn't seen him. She was upset that we were at her house and not at 3902 E. Pacific where they are sellling drugs. I spoke with Brazeau and explained why we were there. I asked who was standing with her in the doorway when we arrived. Brazeau said it was her brother. Brazeau would not provide her brother's name and said we had no reason to speak with him.

I went back to 3902 E. Pacific again to confirm with Weber that she was unable to recognize the male as the same person who smashed the vehicle earlier.

As I returned to the residence, Officers had made contact with Walls inside of the residence. Walls was extremely uncooperative, confrontational and belligerent.

As Officers in the front of the residence were attempting to establish a dialogue with Walls, Brazeau continued to stand on the porch and scream at officers. In an effort to remove Brazeau from the volatile and potentially dangerous situation, Officer Stewart and Sgt. Kannberg asked her to exit the porch. Brazeau refused.

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The communication with Walls was deteriorating as he became increasingly confrontational and retreated back into the residence. Sergeant Kannberg attempted to pull Brazeau off of the porch to remove her from harms way, and to allow Officers a safe space to deal with the tense, uncertain and rapidly evolving situation. Brazeau wrapped her arm around a porch post and held on, pulling her arm away from Sgt. Kannberg. Sgt. Kannberg told Brazeau she was under arrest for obstructing.

I grabbed Brazeau's left arm and pulled her off of the porch. Brazeau attempted to pull away from me and she fell to the ground. I dragged her approximately 8' across the lawn in the front yard so she and we could be in a safer position to take her into custody.

I handcuffed Brazeau, who continued to struggle and actively resist us until she was handcuffed.

I walked Brazeau to my patrol vehicle. I checked Brazeau for any injuries and asked if she was injured. Brazeau said she was not injured and didn't need medical attention. Corporal Daniels responded and photographed Brazeau to verify she had no injuries.

Officers took Walls into custody.

I transported Brazeau to Spokane County Jail for booking.

Officer Stewart attempted to conduct an in field show up of Walls with Weber, but she had left the location. I was unable to reach Weber on the phone.

Officer Stewart transported Walls to Spokane County Jail for booking. A hospital nurse requested he be medically cleared before booking due to a broken tooth. Officer Stewart, who was on the initial fight call involving Walls, said the tooth was broken during that incident with Lindquist. Refer to Officer Stewart's report for further details related to that incident.

I transported Walls Deaconess Medical Center. While at the location, I read Walls his Miranda admonishment, per my SPD issued Card. Walls gave an implied waiver of his rights by speaking with me afterward. I asked Walls about the incident involving his neighbor's car and the tractor. Walls said he is a heavy machinery operator and has keys which start a variety of tractors. Walls said he used his keys to start the tractor and then used the tractor to demolish the vehicle. Walls said the neighbors were using the vehicle to make drugs. He said the car has been parked on the street for months and has been "tagged," but they still refuse to move the vehicle. Walls said the people who own the vehicle don't have licenses. Walls said he demolished the vehicle so they would not be able to drive the car anymore and it would cease to be a problem for his neighborhood.

After being medically cleared for booking, I transported Walls to Spokane County Jail. He was booked without incident.

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I was informed by Sgt. Kannberg that Walls threatened officers with a taser while they were attempting to establish contact with him at the residence. Sgt. Kannberg said there was probable cause to arrest Walls for Assault 2nd. Refer to Sgt. Kannberg's report for further details.

On 8/14/16 at approximately 2256 hrs dispatch advised several SPD officers of a person with a weapons complaint, located at 3902 E Pacific Ave Spokane, Wa. Dispatch advised Justin Walls was walking towards some bulldozers and pointing a pistol at the complainant, Desirae Scott. Scott and Walls were involved in an earlier altercation/incident. For more information on that see 16-302357. I advised dispatch I would be enroute.

I was familiar with Walls due to an earlier assault complaint 16-302134, where Walls went to jail on some warrants. Also present in the residence when Walls went to jail was his girlfriend Angela Brazeau.

I arrived at the above location at approximately 2302 hrs. Just before I arrived I heard someone say he ran to the back of the residence. Sgt Kannberg ran to the back and didn't see anyone come out. Sgt Kannberg stayed at the location to keep watch on the back until there were more units on scene.

Officer Gonsalves and I continued to have eyes on the front of the residence in case anyone came out.

After several minutes Angela came out of the front of the residence. I advised her why we were there. I told her we needed to speak with Justin about the alleged brandishing of the pistol at the neighbors. Angela advised me Justin wasn't inside, and only her brother was inside. I asked Angela if I could talk with her brother to see if he knew what was going on or if he could shed some light onto the developing story. Angela stated we couldn't go inside and speak with him and he wasn't coming out since he didn't do anything wrong. Angela was told several times there was two sides to every story and as of right now we only had one side.

At this time it was learned Justin didn't have a gun but rather a slingshot he was pointing at the neighbor.

Angela was completely hysterical. She was crying and yelling that the drug dealers across the street didn't get in trouble. It was hard to make out Angela's speech at times.

Sgt Kannberg was standing on the front porch with Angela and I attempting to calm her down. He

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was again explaining to her why we were there. Angela didn't care and thought she was the victim. She wanted to press charges on the neighbors and the police department.

Sgt Kannberg advised her since she wasn't going to cooperate and let us in to search with her permission for her brother or for Justin, we would go apply for a search warrant. Angela didn't like that and said she was going to wait inside. Sgt Kannberg advised her since we were applying for a search warrant we had to secure the residence and she was not allowed back inside. Angela attempted to get back in several times. Angela continued to act out and yell at us. Angela stated she would just go inside and leave the door open. I had to grab onto Angela several times so she wouldn't go inside.

Angela calmed down at one point and stood on the porch off to the side of the residence. I stood right next to her, with Officer Gonsalves near me. We were waiting to start the application for a search warrant.

Several minutes later I heard Sgt Kannberg tell everyone on the radio they were making contact with Justin in the back of the residence. A few seconds later Sgt Kannberg advised the radio Justin was armed with a taser in the back. Shortly after that Justin went back inside and Sgt Kannberg stated he was walking towards the front door, where Angela, Officer Gonsalves, and I were located.

I attempted to grab Angela off the porch and advised her she needed to get off of the porch for her safety. Angela refused and several times made attempts to go back into the house.

Sgt Kannberg shined his flashlight at the front door which had a few small windows at the top of the door and saw Justin peering out from it with the taser in his hand. Sgt Kannberg told commanded Angela to get off the porch as well as the officers on the porch. I again grabbed Angela from the porch while I had to keep my eyes on the front door for Justin. I was currently armed with my less lethal taser and my flashlight. I put my flashlight away and attempted to pull Angela off the porch again just as the front door opened. Justin was still armed with his taser. When the front door opened and I saw it was Justin I turned my taser to the on position. Since the events of the night were rapidly tense and were constantly evolving I deployed my taser into prob mode.

The crimes known to me that the suspect had committed or is suspected of committed is felony malicious mischief, theft of a motor vehicle, assault 2nd degree for intimidating officers with a weapon and activating said weapon, and resisting arrest.

Justin posed in immediate threat to myself, his girlfriend Angela, and other officers on scene by the following actions. Justin had exhibited violent behavior in displaying the hand held taser to officers on scene, while activating it. Justin had previously been arrested a few hours prior due to the neighbors calling the police on him, and was angry. Justin was refusing to cooperate with officers on scene by refusing to come out and speak with officers even though he threatened them with a taser.

Justin actively resisted arrest or attempted to evade arrest by flight by the following: Justin knew we were actively looking for him and needed to speak with him. Justin came out of his residence through the back armed with a taser, and threatened the taser on officer's by activating it as he had it raised. Justin continued to ignore commands from officers by running back inside the residence to the front door. Justin was peering out the window above the door and was yelling at the officers on the porch continuing to ignore commands. I was approximately 7-10 feet away from Justin when he opened the door. I turned my taser on and pointed in around the midline of Justin.

Once I fired my taser into probe mode I believed the probes to be in-effective since Justin was wearing a heavier jacket and both probes didn't come in contact with his skin. Justin went back inside his residence and shut the door.

Officer Hayward had to drag Angela off the porch since she was hindering our main concern which was to deal with Justin. Sgt Kannberg advised Officer Hayward she was under arrest for obstructing. Officer Hayward walked her back to his patrol vehicle and placed her inside.

The officers who were near the front of the residence backed up towards the street to get distance between us and Justin, and was unknown if he was still armed with his taser.

Sgt Kannberg yelled at Justin that he was under arrest. Justin kept opening the door and shutting the door. This lasted for around 1 minute. The final time Justin came all the way out of the doorway and walked down the porch. I couldn't see the taser in his hands at all. At this point I had already reloaded to a new taser cartridge with probes and continued to have it in the on position. Justin took his jacket all the way off as if in a threatening manner as if he wanted to fight, and continued to yell at me, and the other officers on scene. At one point Justin claimed he was going to taze the officers. Justin also stated, "You're going to taze me? You're going to wish you didn't!" Justin had his palms facing me as if challenging me to a fight. Justin then stated, "come on let's go, one at a time!" Justin continued to progress towards me singling me out of everyone. Justin was walking directly towards me. Just was approximately 10-13 feet away from me aggressing rapidly. I took a few steps towards him aimed my tazer, pointed in, and activated my tazer into probe mode, striking Justin in the stomach.

We attempted to arrest and handcuff Justin, however once we went hands on with Justin he attempted to fight with us. There were around 4 officers who went hands on with Justin was kicking and had not been searched yet. It was not known if Justin had any weapons or not. While he was struggling with officers I activated my tazer again since I thought the probes were still attached to Justin.

The crimes known to me that the suspect had committed or is suspected of committed is felony malicious mischief, theft of a motor vehicle, assault 2nd degree for intimidating officers with a weapon and activating said weapon, and resisting arrest.

Justin posed in immediate threat to myself, his girlfriend Angela, and other officers on scene by the following actions. Justin had exhibited violent behavior in displaying the hand held taser to officers on scene, while activating it. Justin had previously been arrested a few hours prior due to the neighbors calling the police on him, and was angry. Justin was refusing to cooperate with officers on scene by refusing to come out and speak with officers even though he threatened them with a taser. Justin made a significant effort to threaten officers on scene by being armed with the taser, running back inside, and going to the front of the residence and opening the door still armed with the taser. Justin continued to actively resist arrest after being tazed and Officers going hands on with him. Justin continued to struggle and attempt to fight with officers.

Justin actively resisted arrest or attempted to evade arrest by flight by the following: Justin knew we were actively looking for him and needed to speak with him. Justin came out of his residence through the back armed with a taser, and threatened the taser on officer's by activating it as he had it raised. Justin continued to ignore commands from officers by running back inside the residence to the front door. Justin was peering out the window above the door and was yelling at the officers on

the porch continuing to ignore commands. Sgt Kannberg had advised Justin he was under arrest.

I was not sure if the probes were still attached or if that tazer deployment effected him. A few seconds later I heard one of the officer yell out, "He's out!" (I took that to mean someone put a lateral neck restraint onto Justin). It turned out Officer Rankin was the one who put Justin in an LNR.

While Justin was unconscience, we rolled him onto his stomach and secured him in handcuffs. Justin was not harmed and woke up a few seconds later.

Medics were called for tazer deployments and for being put unconscience.

Justin was continuing to talk to me in an aggressive manner. Justin was checked out by medics who removed the taser probes.

Once the medics checked him out and cleared, Justin thought he could get up and start walking. I commanded him to remain seated. Justin started to get up anyways and Officer Gonsalves and I had to push him down and put our body weight on him to keep him down.

After Justin was allowed to get up, Officer Rankin and I walked Justin back to my patrol vehicle.

Justin was transported to the Spokane County Jail where he was booked in for Assault 2nd degree, and resisting arrest. Officer Hayward charged Justin with Malicious Mischief 1st degree, and Theft of a motor vehicle, on previous reports.

On 8-15-2016 at about 2215 hr. I contacted Officer Hayward at 3902 E. Pacific reference a theft of vehicle and hit and run. Officer Hayward advised he developed PC for Justin Walls for this crime. See his report. Officer Hayward indicted the neighbors had claimed 3902 E Pacific was a drug house and they have had numerous problems at the residence. At this time I had not been briefed on an incident earlier in the day involving Justin Walls. See report # 16-302134. Justin Walls current location was unknown however he lived at 3821 E. Pacific.

At about 2254 hr. Desirae Scott called police and stated Justin Walls was walking to the back-hoe carrying a gun. I responded back to the residence with other officers.

I arrived on scene just after Officer Hayward. As we were walking down the road I saw 2 subjects (one was a female and I could not ID the 2nd person) standing in the doorway at 3821 E. Pacific (Justin Walls' residence). Officer Hayward shined his light on the residence and the 2 subjects retreated into the residence. Officer Hayward indicted the female was Justin Walls girlfriend and the other person could have been Justin Walls but he was not sure. He did see the other subject carrying a sling shot.

Officers set up a perimeter around the residence and began talking to neighbors. I took a position at the back of the residence watching the back door. I was then advised officers made contact at the front door with Angela Brazeau. I was informed Ms. Brazeau stated her brother was in the residence and not Justin Walls. As officer were talking to Ms. Brazeau she was yelling at the neighbors from 3902 E. Pacific and at officers. I was informed Justin Walls was the person that was at the front door with Ms. Brazeau.

Ms. Brazeau wanted to re-enter the residence and continued denying Justin Walls was in the residence. Because officers had PC to arrest Justin Walls for 1* malicious mischief and vehicle theft I made the decision to lock down the residence until a warrant could be obtained for the residence. I informed Ms. Brazeau of this. She was not happy with this and did not believe I could prevent her from entering the residence. She did comply by stepping back from the front door but she was still on the front porch of the residence with officers.

I re-contacted Officer Hayward and asked him to confirm with witnesses that Justin Walls was in the residence before proceeding any further. He began to do this.

As Officer Hayward was talking to witnesses Justin Walls opened the back door and began talking to officers at the back of the residence. I walked to the back of the residence to listen to the conversation. As I walked to the back of the residence I heard what sounded like a TASER going off. I was then informed Justin Wells was armed with a TASER. I broadcasted this information. I then moved to the front of the residence and told the officers to get Ms. Brazeau off the

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front porch. I could see officers trying to get her to move off of the front porch. I then moved up by the front door to watch for Justin Wells.

I saw Justin Wells looking out the glass in the front door. He was saying something about Ms. Brazeau being TASED. During this time officers were trying to get Ms. Brazeau off the front porch. I advised officer to arrest her as she was not complying.

Justin Walls then opened up the front door with the TASER in hand. He pointed the TASER out at me and other officers. Officer Stewart then deployed his TASER at Justin Wells. Justin Wells stepped back and dropped his TASER. He appeared to jolt a little and then move off to the side stating something about the TASER. It appeared the TASER probes fouled in his clothing. He then shut the door. I grabbed onto Ms. Brazeau who was holding onto the railing on the front porch. I informed her she was under arrest and pulled her off the front porch falling to the ground. An officer then grabbed Ms. Brazeau and pulled her away.

I ordered officer to back away from the front door and requested a patrol unit to the front of the residence. Officer backed off and a patrol car pulled up to the font of the residence with its lights on.

Justin Wells exited the residence and I advised him he was under arrest. Other officers then began talking to him. Justin Wells walked out into the front yard taking off his shirt. He stated he would fight officers one at a time and took an aggressive threatening posture. I moved toward him as he was aggressing on officers to the right of me. Justin Wells was then TASED. I then moved up to place handcuffs on Justin Wells with other officers.

I took control of his right hand as other officers took control of his left hand. Officers attempted to roll Justin Wells over to a prone cuffing position, as they did this he began fighting again. Justin Wells was able to sit up and he pulled me in to him as I was holding onto his forearm. He pulled his hand to his stomach as I held on. A second TASER application was applied. At this time my hands were entangled in the TASER wires and I was shocked. Due to the shock I could not hold onto Justin Wells' hand, I let go and fell backwards. By the time I regained my position I saw Officer Rankin had taken his back and place him in a Level 2 neck restraint and rendered him unconscious. Officer were then able to place him in a prone cuffing position for handcuffing. During this time I monitored Justin Wells to see his airway was not being blocked. Once he was in handcuffs he was immediately rolled onto his back and sat up in a sitting position. He immediately regained conscious. Just after the altercation began somehow the switch on my body camera was deactivated. This in looking at the footage of this incident it appears this occurred when I was holding on to Justin Wells hand and he was pulling me around.

Medics checked on Justin Wells at the scene. He was transported to jail and booked. Because he exited the residence with the TASER pointed at me and other officers I requested 2* assault charges. Ms. Brazeau was booked for obstructing because she refused to move off the porch when asked and she held on to the porch railing resisting officers efforts to remove her from the front porch.

I did talk to Ms. Brazeau at jail about this incident. She stated she was not injured. Also talked to Justin Walls at the hospital and he stated he was not injured by officers in this incident. He did have a loose tooth from the previous assault at 3902 E. Pacific.

On 08/14/2016 at approximately 2052 hours, I responded to 3902 E Pacific Ave to investigate a hit and run complaint. Cross references on the incident indicated that an assault had occurred earlier in the day between the damaged vehicle's owner and the hit and run suspect.

l arrived on scene with Ofc. Hayward. I observed a Gray Mitsubishi Lancer with damage to the rear bumper, trunk, rear windshield, and roof. Please refer to Ofc. Hayward's report for additional information.

I conferred with Ofc. Hayward, who told me witnesses indicated that someone used a "tractor" to damage the vehicle. Witnesses indicated that the tractor traveled eastbound on E Pacific Ave before turning southbound on S Myrtle St. I located a tractor matching the witnesses description parked at the intersection of S Myrtle St and E 2nd Ave. I observed that there appeared to be fresh scratch marks on the bucket of the tractor, and the ignition appeared to have been manipulated by an object other than a key (pry marks, bent metal around ignition).

l requested a Spokane Police Department Corporal to take photographs of the damaged vehicle and tractor.

I then interviewed Victoria D. Howell (02/01/1952), who lived at 2828 E Pacific Ave. Victoria told me the following (paraphrased): Victoria told me that she observed a large, 1980's model, "blue and silver" truck run into the back of the Gray Mitsubishi Lancer, pushing it from the street, and onto the sidewalk. Victoria did not see who was driving the truck. Victoria said she observed a white female, approximately 5'03" tall, heavy set, and approximately 25 years old, exit the truck and walk towards 3821 E Pacific Ave. Victoria did not know the female, but noted that the female was laughing as she walked away from the collision.

Approximately an hour after the truck collided with the Gray Mitsubishi Lancer, Victoria observed a tractor

coming westbound down E Pacific Ave. The tractor stopped next to the Gray Mitsubishi Lancer, and used the bucket to strike the roof of the Lancer "three times". The tractor then travelled eastbound down E Pacific Ave and went out of Victoria's sight.

I then contacted Robert S. Evans (06/22/1936) at 3822 E Pacific Ave. I interviewed Robert, who told me the following (paraphrased): Robert was outside working on the water spigot in the front yard when he observed a tractor approach the Gray Mitsubishi Lancer and strike the roof of the Lancer with the tractor bucket, approximately four times. Robert did not see a blue and silver truck strike the Mitsubishi Lancer. Robert did note that a large blue and white truck is often parked behind 3821 E Pacific Ave.

I conferred with Ofc. Hayward about the facts surrounding the incident. I went to 3821 E Pacific Ave in an attempt to contact Justin C. Walls (02/13/1982). Justin was identified as the suspect in damaging the Mitsubishi Lancer by witnesses in the area. I looked for any vehicles matching Robert or Victoria's description around the premises. I did not observe a truck in the front of the residence, or in the alley behind the residence. Ofc. Hayward interviewed Angela R. Brazeau (02/24/1983), who identified herself as Justin's girlfriend. Angela told us Justin was not home, did not have a vehicle, and did not have his cell phone on him.

I pulled up Justin's SPRS photograph for reference.

As we were unable to locate and interview Justin, I cleared the call in order to take other calls for service.

At approximately 2254 hours on 08/14/2016 I responded back to 3812 E Pacific Ave to investigate a person with a firearm complaint. The original complainant who reported the damaged Mitsubishi Lancer called 911 and reported that Justin was back in the area and walking around with a pistol.

As I was enroute an officer reported that a male matching Justin's description went inside of 3821 E Pacific Ave. I arrived on scene and positioned my patrol vehicle in the alley behind Justin's residence. Of note a blue and white Ford pickup (WA B20458P) was now parked in the alley. Dispatch informed me that Justin had recently purchased the vehicle.

I heard officers speaking with Angela at the front of the residence. I could not hear specifics, but heard Angela begin to yell and scream at the officers in the front of the residence.

I then heard an electroshock weapon being activated (quick, high frequency, repetitive clicking noise) behind the rear door of the residence. Justin then opened the rear door of the residence with a black electroshock weapon in his right hand.

I asked Justin to exit the residence and speak with me. Justin appeared agitated and was upset that officers

were speaking with Angela at the front of the residence. Justin was upset that Angela was 'in trouble' with law enforcement. As Angela screamed, Justin entered the residence, and closed the rear door.

I then heard elevated voices at the front of the residence and heard radio traffic that officers were making contact with a male at the front of the residence. I went to the front of the residence and observed Justin 'slamming' the front door of the residence repeatedly. Justin then called the officers "fucking punks" and stated "I'm going to TASE you!" Justin then yelled, "you TASE mel You're going to wish you didn't!"

Justin then removed the thick green flannel shirt that he had been wearing, and threw it to the ground, and held his arms out to his side with his palms facing me. The muscles in Justin's torso, arms, and shoulders all appeared to be tense, and he stood with a bladed, combative stance. All of these actions indicated to me that Justin was preparing for a physical altercation.

Of note, Justin is approximately 6'2" and 200 pounds with an athletic, muscular build.

Justin then stated "come on! Let's go!" One at a time, one at a time!" Justin then began walking towards Ofc. Stewart.

I observed TASER probes impact Justin. Justin fell to the ground. I moved in and placed Justin in a prone cuffing position, placing his left wrist in a set of my handcuffs. Justin's body then became rigid as he pulled his arms towards his torso. Justin ignored commands to stop resisting arrest. Justin was able to roll onto his right side and prevent me from placing his right wrist in the other handcuff. Justin continued his refusal to cooperate, and attempted to stand up.

Severity of the Crime:

Justin was the suspect in an assault earlier on 08/14/2016 where he attempted to kick in the front door of a residence. Justin then escalated his erratic behavior by allegedly stealing a nearby tractor and damaging a vehicle. Finally, Justin was allegedly in the same area of the first two incidents, walking around brandishing a pistol. What started as a simple assault and potential burglary had escalated into severe damage into personal property and potential threats with a dangerous weapon.

Threat Factors:

Justin had a black electroshock weapon in his hands the last time I saw him. I had heard Justin activate the electroshock weapon inside of his residence. Justin's actions were becoming more and more erratic, and were escalating in violence. Justin was refusing to listen or cooperate, was verbally threatening police officers, and was displaying signs of wanting a physical confrontation. Justin was wearing gray, baggy sweat pants with pockets on each side. I could not observe what was inside of Justin's pockets, and I had not had the opportunity to conduct a pat-frisk to check Justin for the electroshock or other weapons. Justin also had my

metal handcuffs attached to his left wrist. The handcuff that was not attached to Justin's right wrist was floating free due to Justin's resistance.

Resistance Factors:

Justin was tightening the muscles in his legs, torso, and arms. Due to Justin's size and build he was able to roll onto his right side as multiple officers attempted to keep him in the prone cuffing position. Justin refused to listen to commands to stop resisting arrest, and pulled his arms towards his torso, and near the pockets that had not been searched for weapons. Justin then attempted to stand up with my metal handcuffs (a potential weapon) attached to his left wrist.

Use of Force:

Due to the fact that Justin's behavior was becoming more erratic and violent, Justin had been seen with an electroshock weapon, Justin was able to fight through an application of a TASER and resist as multiple officer attempted to secure him in handcuffs, I applied a Level 2 Lateral Vascular Neck Restraint (LVNR) on Justin in order to get his right wrist in handcuffs and reduce the length of a prolonged struggle. I applied the Level 2 LVNR for approximately five seconds.

Cpl. Daniel informed me that the Level 2 LVNR was successful. I released the LVNR and placed Justin's right wrist in handcuffs. I moved Justin onto his side and then placed him on his buttocks, to ensure that he could breathe. I double locked the handcuffs.

I notified a Spokane Police Department Sergeant of my application of the Level 2 LVNR.

I assisted in collecting TASER components and placing them in property bags.

Please refer to the multiple other officer's reports for additional information.

On 081416 at 2321 hrs, I responded to 3821 E Pacific to assist multiple other SPD Officers who were attempting to make contact with an apparent 1st Degree Malicious Mischief suspect who was identified as Justin C Walls (021382).

While making my approach to the front of the Pacific residence, I heard an update that Walls was armed with a Taser. As I made my way to the front of the residence, Officers were just taking a female in to custody and off of the property. She was identified as Angela R Brazeau.

I maintained my visual attention the front of the house as Walls was opening and shutting the front door. Walls appeared very agitated and not cooperating with Officers who were attempting verbals with him. I had my duty weapon drawn and at the low ready (depressed muzzle) due to Wells being armed with the taser and also earlier mention of him possibly armed with a pistol.

There was poor lighting and a lack of cover so I elected to return to my fully marked patrol SUV and drive it to the front of the residence to better illuminate the front porch and provide cover for Officers if needed.

I arrived at the front of the residence and positioned my patrol SUV directly in front and illuminated Walls who was in the doorway of the residence. He began challenging Officers and eventually came down off of the front porch. He began saying he wanted to take Officers on one at a time. He appeared to be advancing on Officer(s) in the front yard and an Officer deployed his taser.

The taser deployment proved to be very effective and momentarily subdued Walls in the grass in front of the porch. This allowed myself and several Officers to safely move in and attempt to gain control of Walls. I grabbed single arm control as we began attempting to get him handcuffed. He continued to resist arrest and even started to stand up and overpower several Officers. A level 2 neck restraint was applied by Ofc Rankin which rendered Walls unconscious. Once unconscious I released my arm control and Walls was rolled to his stomach for prone cuffing. He was safely handcuffed at this point.

Medical personnel were immediately started to evaluate Walls and remove any and all taser probes.

On 8/14/16 at approximately 1641 hrs dispatch advised several SPD units of an assault taken place at 3902 E Pacific Ave, Spokane, Wa. Dispatch advised a neighbor named Justin, pushed his way into her house, and was armed with a fire extinguisher and beating on the door. I advised dispatch I would be enroute with other officers.

I arrived on scene at approximately 1648 hrs. I saw a male wearing no shirt standing on the street sidewalk. He saw me and went inside the front door to 3821 E Pacific Ave. I briefly spoke with an unrelated neighbor who advised me that male was Justin. Dispatch had previously advised me Justin had warrants for his arrest.

I walked over to 3902 E Pacific and spoke with Lucinda Karber. Karber advised me the following. She was cleaning out her van in front of her house. There was an altercation with her daughter's boyfriend, Scott, unknown last name. She came in the house to call 911 when she saw Justin's girlfriend Andgela Brazeau start walking at her with a fire extinguisher in her hands. Karber went inside and locked the door. Justin came out and was cooperative. I advised him he was under arrest for his warrants. I handcuffed him.
