## INCIDENT SYNOPSIS

Officers contacted a male for pedestrian interference. The male paced back and forth, refusing directions to keep his hands out of his pocket. The suspect gave a false name and then ran from officers. Officers gave commands to stop but the male did not. He tossed a gun while running. He was tackled by officers and resisted arrest. During the arrest, with prone handcuffing, the male suspect suffered an abrasion on the right side of his face. Because the suspect was a convicted felon, he was not allowed to have a firearm. The suspect was transported to jail and booked for 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Unlawful Possession of Firearms, Resisting Arrest, Obstruction, Making a False Statement to a Public Servant, Disorderly Conduct, 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Assault, and a warrant.
