## **INCIDENT SYNOPSIS**

Officers responded to a Domestic Violence call. Several open cases existed with probable cause to arrest the male suspect. Officers developed probable cause that the suspect was inside the apartment. A search warrant was sought, granted, and executed. Officers made multiple announcements over a two-hour timespan outside of the residence and made additional announcements inside the apartment before deploying the K9. A K9 handler deployed his K9 to apprehend the suspect. There were two males inside the apartment; the male contacted by the K9 was not the DV suspect. The male was transported to the hospital for treatment. The DV suspect was hiding under the couch. He was taken into custody and was booked into jail for three counts of 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Assault-Domestic Violence, 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Malicious Mischief, Obstructing, Resisting Arrest, and a felony warrant for Assault.

Note: This incident is the same incident as F22-060. The incident has two tracking numbers as each K9 incident is tracked separately.
