These are Patrol oriented officers who have dedicated countless hours and sleepless nights to refining a generic system into one that can be used by our entire city and the numerous partner law enforcement agencies participating in the New World system implementation.

Led by Sgt. Paul Carpenter from Patrol, this unit has spent months in preparation for the final rollout of the system that happened on October 4, 2016. These officers were available every minute from 3:00am the day of rollout, through graveyard the following day. Several of them actually rewrote part of the system during the transition, identifying and fixing problems on-the-fly. These officers continue to have a positive outlook and demeanor through the entire process, always trying to put a positive spin on everything that was taking place, never complaining about the system or process.

The LERMS Transition team worked tirelessly to make the transition as smooth as possible and continue to do so. LERMS is the hub of the entire New World "wagon wheel" coordinating information received from CAD during emergency response, officer field activity and the police case report workflow that touches every unit of the department. LERMS documents are also critical to non-law enforcement entities like the Prosecutor's Office, Jail and Forensic Identification. The enormity of the transition involving millions of legacy data records and processes part of the October 4th go-live and has been a huge change for every staff member in the department. The LERMS Transition team has focused tirelessly on the needs of key units like Investigations and Records to make sure that initial training and workflow needs were identified and provided. Some areas were able to be accomplished prior to go-live, but many more have been illuminated after live operations began. They have maintained an ongoing effort to make sure that our staff understand the new environment in such a way to continue to operate effectively in their daily activities.
