Sgt. Tom Hendren recently nominated Detective Randy Lesser for the Spokane Police Department Medal of Merit Award. The Medal of Merit is awarded to members of the department who distinguish themselves by meritorious achievement or meritorious service. The meritorious actions must clearly surpass that which is normally required or expected. This service or achievement need not be unique but must be exceptional and superior. When the Special Awards Committee reviewed this nomination, it was apparent that Detective Randy Lesser is more than deserving of this award.

Sgt. Hendren wrote, Det. Lesser's performance has been superior, not just during this recent quarter, but for over a decade in his role as the team leader for the SWAT Team. Randy has served as a SWAT member for 22 years. He is calm and confident and his decisions are made with the highest priority the safety of citizens, officers and suspects.
