WAC 197-11-970 and Section 11.10.230(3) Spokane Environmental Ordinance

PROJECT: E-B2508575

PROPOSAL: GRADING APPROX 1,290 CY FOR 129 STRUCTURES, INSTALL OF THE STRUCTURES WILL BE EITHER DIRECT BURIED OR PLACED IN CONCRETE FOUNDATIONS. A 100' DIAMETER LANDING WILL BE CREATED AT EACH STRUCTURE. GRADING APPROXIMATELY 3000 CY TO RESTORE/ CREATE VEHICLE ACCESS RDS. CONSTRUCTION WILL INVOLVE INSTALLING NEW SINGLE STEEL POLES AND STRINGING 230kV CONDUCTORS (CABLES) AND OPTICAL GROUND WIRE. PROJECT OCCURS IN SPOKANE COUNTY, SPOKANE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AND THE CITY OF SPOKANE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES. THIS PERMIT IS FOR GRADING WITHIN SPOKANE COUNTY BOUNDARY.
