 - O Household travel surveys are the gold-standard for understanding the who, when, where, why, and how of our daily travel. Oregon hasn't had a new survey for over 10 years...until now! The Oregon Travel Study (OTS) captured behavior, attitudes, and much more from over 20,000 participating households from 2023-24. For the first time, many households participated for a full week using their smartphones. New topics included: E-bikes and micromobility, ride hail use, e-commerce, EVs, and working from home.
