

CSO 41 Project Narrative

The Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) Control Facility 41 project proposes construction of a ±96,000 gallon underground combined sewerage detention facility in Upriver Drive at Rebecca Street. CSO 41 detention storage will be provided by installing a 600-700 foot length 72" diameter pipe connected with concrete vaults. Sanitary sewer work on the project includes replacement of an aging, existing sewer main in Upriver Drive from approximately 500 feet east of Rebecca Street to approximately 350' west of Freya Street. A portion of the sewer and CSO facility installation will take place beneath the Centennial Trail. The project also includes retrofit of storm catch basins at Freya Street and Rebecca Street to remove stormwater from the combined sewer system. Disturbed areas within Upriver Drive, the Centennial Trail, and side streets will be resurfaced following utility installation.
