Description of Proposal: The City of Spokane has an existing booster station roughly 1,000 square feet in size, located along Belt on this same parcel. A new, larger (roughly 40' X 80') booster station is proposed as a replacement, south of the existing booster station but set back further from Belt St. The ultimate plan is to remove the existing booster station, but the City intends to leave the existing station in place for one year in order to properly test the new station in action.
