Location Description: 4511 S Hogan St, Spokane WA – Parcels 34042.1204; 34042.0008; and, 34042.0007

Description of Proposal: The Application is proposing a Pocket Development Project to reconfigure three parcels totaling 36,879.37 sq. ft. into two legal building lots for the purpose of retaining an existing home and building one new unit. The existing home currently sits on two of the three parcels. This proposal would allow for the development of the third, currently landlocked parcel, to be developed under the City's Pocket Residential Code.

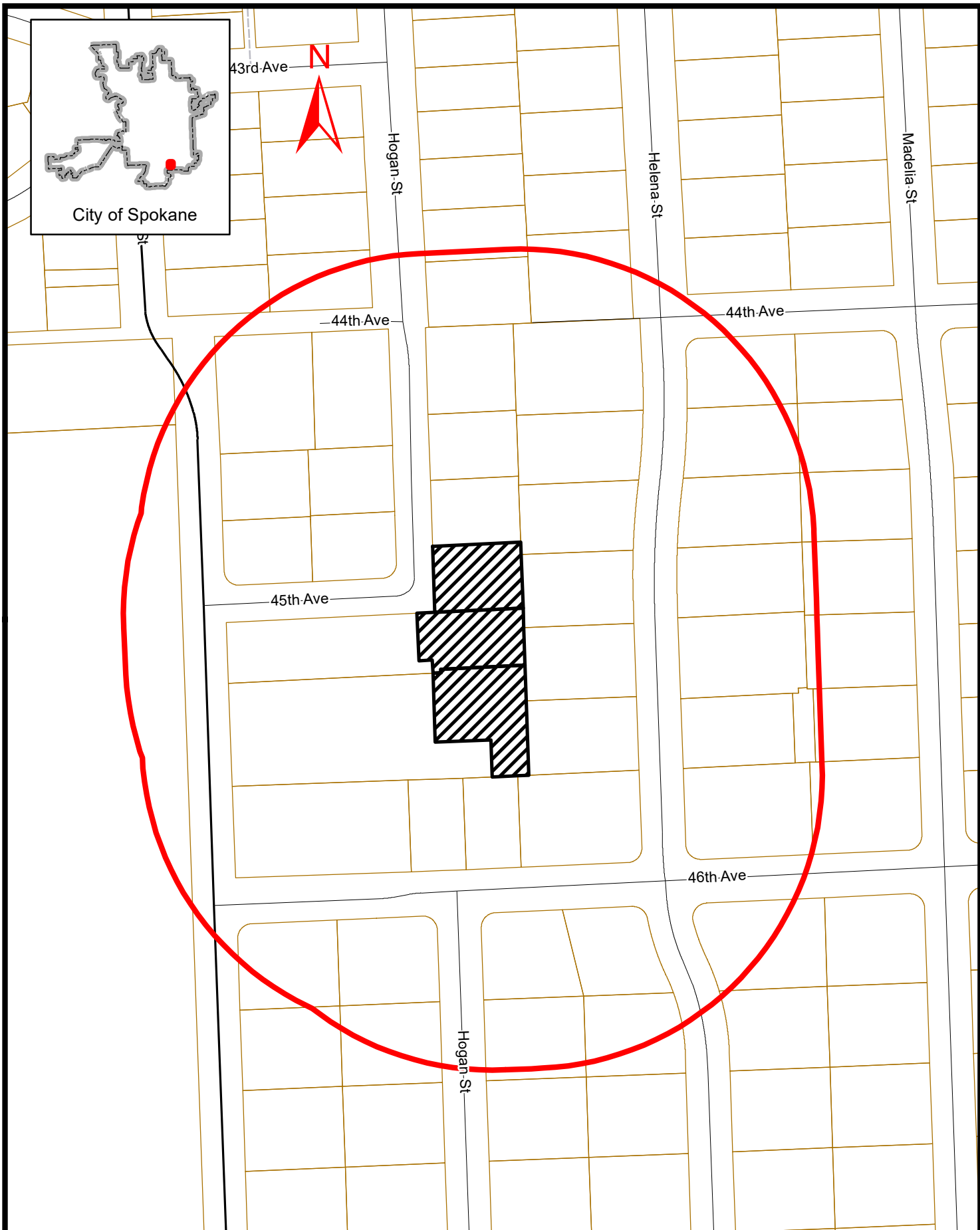
Legal Description: Parcels 34042.1204; 34042.0008; 34042.0007 – A complete legal description is available with the Planning Department.

Once the public comment period has ended, staff will prepare a staff report and issue an appeal deadline.
