Location: This amendment is effective City wide.

<u>Description of Proposal:</u> An ordinance amending Chapter 17C.200 Landscaping and Screening, specifically Section 17C.200.090 Completion and Bonding, of the Spokane Municipal Code. The proposed code amendment will require that prior to issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy, the landscape design professional shall conduct an inspection to evaluate and assess that the landscaping conforms to the approved design and is planted correctly. The City has proposed a form for documenting such an assessment.

<u>SEPA:</u> This amendment is categorically exempt from SEPA.

Only the applicant, persons submitting written comments and persons testifying at a hearing may appeal the decision of the Plan Commission and City Council.
