

LOGAN NEIGHBORHOOD PLANNING MEETING NOTES

Discussion occurred with William Sinclair, planning intern and landscape architect, regarding planning for the nodes at both ends of the Hamilton Corridor (Trent & Foothills). We formulated a vision statement for the work he will do; *Frame a Logan neighborhood identity for the north and south nodes of the corridor for this and future generations who live, work, shop, and play here.* The intent is to take themes identified and work with GU & U-District to maintain continuity along the corridor. With our help, Will plans to be finished by the end of November.

Nikole shared that Bill Grimes of Studio Cascade signed the Form Based Code project proposal and intends to finish in 10 weeks. Interviews of business, property owners, and residents near the project boundaries of Hamilton from Sharp to Mission Ave, with assistance from our planner Nikole began this week. There will be a community charrette to create a preliminary corridor vision with a variety of form considerations and a preliminary regulating plan. It is scheduled for October 13, 2012 from 9am-3pm at Fourth Memorial Church (2000 North Standard, Spokane 99207--See flyer attached).
