
# WELCONE to Hazel's Creek!

Hazel's Creek is an important stormwater facility, for the Moran Prairie and the City of Spokane at-large, offering education in Low Impact Development (LID) an approach to stormwater management that attempts to mimic nature by storing and treating stormwater as close to where it falls as possible.

In addition, Hazel's Creek is a cultural and natural amenity, highlighting a recent agricultural past and providing valuable open space. The land contains critical wetland and upland habitat that support a diverse array of plant and animal life.

## How to Navigate & Interpret the Site




You can explore the trails at Hazel's Creek in any direction you choose. Each interpretive **station** is marked with a pole and its own number. Look for these as you explore. The map to the right marks their locations and what you can expect to see. Each station interprets an individual topic and can be understood by using any of the following resources:
