Group Swim Lesson Levels

Tadpole | Parent Assist | Ages 6-36 Months Water orientation class for younger children. Parents (one adult per child) required to be in the water with children. The goal of this class is to introduce water adjustment skills in a safe and friendly environment. Climbing in and out of the pool, floating on front and back, kicking, and arm movement. All swimmers in diapers must be in swim diapers.

Seahorse | Preschool | Ages 3-5 Years Through games and play, the goal is to introduce preschool aged kids to water and teach them how to safely navigate this exciting new environment. Students will work on submerging underwater, blowing bubbles with mouth and nose, supported floating, and introduce leg movements.
