TRS would love to have you volunteer in our Nordic program this winter. We will start off the season with an informational meeting for new instructors wanting to learn about the entire TRS ski program volunteer opportunities. **Tuesday, November 30, 2021 6:30 pm at Park Operation located at 2304 E. Mallon.** This is a great opportunity to encourage new people to come learn about the programs.

Once registered to volunteer the on snow training will be held at Mt. Spokane Saturday **January 8, 2022 9am to 12pm**. Meet at the Selkirk Lodge parking lot.

Remember you must have a Sno-park permit on your vehicle to park in the lot. The fee is \$70 for the groomed trail only pass, and \$50 for the Sno-park pass, totaling \$120. This pass goes a long way to pay for grooming trails on Mt. Spokane. TRS will be sending up one van each week and we are not sure if there will be room for volunteers. Last season TRS purchased a pass for a volunteer's vehicle to take up other volunteers. Please let us know if you need a ride.

Dave Bentz will once again be the Nordic program coordinator.

The Nordic program with students will be Saturdays at Mt. Spokane Selkirk Lodge January 15 – March 5 with no ski on Feb 12. Students are ages 12 and above with developmental disabilities. Many of our skiers enjoy competing and will do so at our local annual Langlauf Nordic Community Race February 13th, 2022. We appreciate Washington Special Olympics however at the time of planning there was not enough information regarding competitions. The decision has been made to not participate in 2022.
