



**City of Spokane Parks & Recreation Department
Rising Artists Poster Contest**

Parental Consent, Publicity Authorization, and Liability Release

The City of Spokane Parks & Recreation Department (“City”) requests permission to use artwork and related materials submitted to the Rising Artists High School Poster Contest for the **Gesa Pavilion Concert Series at Riverfront Spokane**. The selected artwork may be used to promote and advertise the concert series and related Parks & Recreation programming.

By signing this form, the student participant and their parent or legal guardian acknowledge and agree to the following:

1. Authorization to Use Artwork and Participant Information

I authorize the City of Spokane Parks & Recreation Department and its representatives to reproduce, publish, display, distribute, and otherwise use the student’s submitted artwork, name, image, likeness, and statements (collectively “Materials”) in print, digital media, video, social media, websites, signage, posters, advertising, and other formats now known or later developed.

These Materials may be used for promotional, educational, marketing, and public information purposes related to the Gesa Pavilion Concert Series at Riverfront Spokane and other City of Spokane Parks & Recreation programs. The City may retain submitted artwork and digital files for archival and promotional purposes.

I waive any right to inspect or approve the finished products or materials that incorporate the student’s artwork or likeness.

2. No Compensation

I understand and agree that the use of the student’s artwork, name, image, likeness, or related Materials will be without compensation, royalty, or other payment beyond any contest prizes that may be awarded.

3. Ownership and Rights

I understand and agree that the City of Spokane shall have the non-exclusive right to

reproduce, publish, distribute, and display the submitted artwork for promotional and marketing purposes related to City programs and events. The City may edit, adapt, resize, or otherwise modify the artwork as necessary for promotional use.

The student and parent/guardian represent that the submitted artwork is the student's original work, does not infringe the intellectual property rights of any third party, has not been generated using artificial intelligence tools or models, and has not been copied from copyrighted materials without permission.

4. Contest Prizes

If the student receives a prize or award as part of the contest, I accept the prize on behalf of the student and assume any risk of injury, harm, loss, or other damages associated with the acceptance or use of the prize.

I understand that prizes may have tax implications. If applicable, a Form 1099 may be issued if prize values meet federal reporting requirements. Any applicable taxes are the responsibility of the recipient.

5. Parental/Guardian Consent for Minor

I acknowledge that the participant named below is under 18 years of age and that I am the student's parent or legal guardian. I have the legal authority to consent to this agreement on the student's behalf.

6. Release and Hold Harmless

By signing below, I hereby release, forever discharge, and agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the City of Spokane, the Spokane Parks & Recreation Department, and their respective employees, officials, volunteers, and authorized representatives from any and all actions, claims, damages, costs, or expenses, including attorney's fees, which relate to or arise out of the student's participation in the poster contest, submission of artwork, acceptance of a prize, or the City's authorized use of the Materials described above.

7. Acknowledgment and Signature

By signing below, I acknowledge that I have read and understand this Parental Consent, Publicity Authorization, and Liability Release Form and agree to its provisions. I understand that my signature legally binds me and the student participant to the terms of this agreement.

Participation in the Rising Artists Poster Contest is voluntary. Submission of artwork constitutes agreement to the contest rules and eligibility requirements established by the City of Spokane Parks & Recreation Department.
