CHALK IT UP! CHALK ART COMPETITION

Riverfront Ribbon | Saturday, October 13 | 11am - 4pm

Riverfront Park and Wheatland Bank invite you to be a participant at our first annual chalk art competition, Chalk It Up! Competition space is limited. We encourage you to register early and enjoy the festivities at Fall Fest prior to chalking time which begins at 1pm.

Where is the chalk art competition?

Chalk It Up! will be held on Saturday, October 13 in conjunction with Fall Fest activities in downtown Spokane. The competition area will be held on the skate ribbon at Riverfront.

What is the schedule?

Saturday, October 13

Registration at the Ribbon	11am - 1pm
Chalking Time	1 - 3pm
Judging	3 - 3:45pm
Awards Announced	3:45pm

Sunday, October 14

Public viewing of artwork on the skate ribbon and voting for the People's Choice Awards, 11am - 5pm.

Is there a prize?

First place cash prizes will be announced at 3:45pm on the day of the competition. You do not need to be present to win. People's Choice cash prize winners will be contacted on Monday, October 15.

What are the divisions and prizes?

Note: Each registrant will be assigned a 4' x 4' space.

Youth Division, Ages 6-12	\$75 first place, \$50 people's choice
Teen Division, Ages 13-18	\$100 first place, \$75 people's choice
Adult Division, Ages 19+	\$150 first place, \$100 people's choice

Got an artist under six years old?

No problem, we'll have a community chalk area located near the competition blocks so our younger guests can chalk too!

What kind of art can I create?

Art must be of good, family-oriented taste with lewd artwork strictly prohibited. If a participant is observed creating this type of work, they will be excused from the competition. Likewise, political or commercial advertising through artwork as well as stenciling is prohibited.

How is the competition judged?

Day of competition will be judged by members of the presenting sponsor. Decisions of the judges and organizers are final based on categories of first impression, creativity and use of color. The public will be invited to visit the artwork on Sunday and place their votes for the People's Choice awards.

Is chalk provided?

Wheatland Bank is providing each participant one 24-color pack of chalk. Adult and Teen divisions are welcome to bring extra chalk, chalk pastels and blending tools if they wish, but no variety of paint is allowed. Charcoal and oil based chalk will not be allowed and all chalk must be non-toxic.

Will I have my own work space?

Yes, you will be assigned a 4' x 4' chalk-block work space on the skate ribbon. We recommend that participants bring a towel, knee pads, hats, water or anything else to keep them comfortable! If participants in the youth division need a helper, they may, but are limited to one extra person in their same age group for a maximum of two people working on one block. Please note that two-person teams will be treated as one entry, so any prize awarded must be shared.

What happens with the art I create?

All art is left on display until the Ribbon is cleaned and prepared for the ice season. Photos will be taken and used for future publicity.

What else do I need to know?

- All participants will be required to sign a liability waiver.
- In the event of rain, this contest will be cancelled.
