- Foster economic partnerships between the City and stakeholders, allowing for the kind of economic growth envisioned by the Comprehensive plan.


What values guided the Economic **Development chapter?**


The values that are important to Spokane's future, as identified by the Citizens during preparation of the original Comprehensive Plan remain. Those include:


- Encouraging livable wage jobs.
- Developing a viable, economically strong downtown area.
- Developing a variety of job opportunities that include professional and industrial as well as service opportunities.
- Ensuring that economic growth pays its appropriate share for costs of new services needed.
- Encouraging economic development that values the environment as a component of our quality of life.

What's New?

- Data and statistics from the original Comprehensive Plan have been updated.
- Since the original adoption of this chapter, the City has created a dedicated team of Economic Development professionals in the Planning Department. That team took a critical look at the chapter and provided changes where necessary to make sure the policies and discussions were current and correct.
- Where previous policies called for the creation of programs that have since been created, the policies have been modified to maintain those programs into the future.
- As with all chapters, the text of the chapter has been streamlined, superfluous discussion has been removed, and redundancies have been removed.










The City recently issued a series of pamphlets, categorizing the various incentives and economic development programs available in each of six target areas:





What are the goals of the Economic **Development chapter?**

Cooperative Partnerships ED 1

Encourage cooperative partnerships to address the economic expansion of the city and region.

Land Availability for Economic Activities ED 2

Ensure that an adequate supply of usable industrial and commercial property is available for economic development activities.

ED 3 Strong, Diverse, and Sustainable Economy

Foster a strong, diverse, and sustainable economy that provides a range of employment and business opportunities.

Income and Employment Opportunity ED 4

Enhance the economic future of the community by encouraging the creation of jobs that provide a livable wage and reduce income disparity.

Education and Workforce Development ED 5

Improve Spokane's economy through a well-educated citizenry and a qualified labor force that is globally competitive and responds to the changing needs of the workplace.

Infrastructure ED 6

SHAPING

Implement infrastructure maintenance and improvement programs that support new and existing business and that reinforce Spokane's position as a regional center.

Regulatory Environment and Tax Structure ED 7

Create a regulatory environment and tax structure that encourage investment, nurture economic activity, and promote a good business climate.

Quality of Life and the Environment ED 8

Improve and protect the natural and built environment as assets that attract economic development opportunities and enhance the City of Spokane's quality of life.
