Radiators - Can go to the WTE or transfer stations for recycling or check with recycling buy back centers. (Link to Spokane County Recyling Centers)

Radiator Fluid - Antifreeze - Residential Drain radiator into a one gallon (or up to 5 gallon) container. This should be taken to the HHW area at the transfer stations or the WTE plant for free drop-off. They can pour it for you if you need your containers returned.

NEVER POUR DOWN STORM DRAINS OR INTO GUTTERS.

Commercial Drop Off. – Link to SRSWS or DOE Hazardous contractors list

Radiator Flush - New, Unused. In this concentration it is hazardous and should be taken to a Household Hazardous Waste Drop Site.

Railroad Ties - SEE DEMO-WASTE-

Railroad ties may also be taken to the WTE plant or the transfer stations as garbage.

Rust Remover (containing phosphoric acid) - deliver to the Household Hazardous Waste drop site at the WTE plant or transfer stations. If empty, rinse container before discarding.

Scrap Metals – Link to Spokane County Recycling Centers

Septic Tank Degreasers (Cesspool Cleaner Containing Organic Solvents) - DO NOT USE any cesspool or septic tank degreaser containing organic solvents; most solvents will pass through the system unchanged and enter the ground water. To minimize your need to use a degreaser, collect kitchen fat in cans and place in trash instead of flushing it down the drain. Deliver it to a Household Hazardous Waste Drop Site at the WTE plant or transfer stations.

Septic Tanks - Disposal Of Household Hazardous Waste -

Anything placed in the septic tank will eventually percolate down into the ground water. Things such as solvents, grease, oil etc. shouldn't be disposed of in the septic tank. Always read labels for biodegradability and if hazardous deliver to a Household Hazardous Waste Drop Site.

Shampoo For Head Lice - containing the insecticide lindane, deliver it to a Household Hazardous Waste Drop Site.

Sheetrock (**Drywall Or Plasterboard**) - Drop off at the WTE plant and transfer stations or Graham Road Landfill 244-0151.

<u>Unpainted</u> sheetrock **ONLY** for a fee. They also sell the fertilizer that they make from the sheetrock.

Other Options For Disposal

Sulphur dioxide is formed when sheetrock is burned. Businesses with dedicated loads of sheetrock may take it to the Northside landfill Mon. - Fri., 8-4 ONLY. Sheetrock may be taken to the WTE facility or the transfer stations and the materials will be back hauled to the Northside landfill by the city.

If you want to put it in your garbage can - the can must not weigh over 85 lbs. and the sheetrock can't stick out of the can more than 2-3 inches.

Shoe Dye - Deliver to a Household Hazardous Waste Drop Site.

Shoe Polish - containing petroleum distillates. Discard dried out cans.

Smoke Detectors (Ionization Type) - Return to manufacturer or retailer. May dispose of in regular trash. If the unit has been physically damaged pick it up with your hand inside of a plastic bag, turn the bag inside out and seal it. Household Hazardous Waste Drop Sites will not accept radioactive materials.

Swimming Pool Supplies - Pool Acid - Deliver to a Household Hazardous Waste Drop Site. See POOL CHEMICALS.

Syringes & Needles - Residents who use hypodermic needles should replace the cap after use and place ALL components into a Sharps container, a plastic pop bottle or milk jug with a screw on lid. <u>Label the container</u> "**SYRINGES - DO NOT RECYCLE".** When the container is full take it to the HHW area at the transfer stations or the WTE plant free of charge. It is against WA State law to dispose of syringes and needles in your trash bin.

Tires - Remove from rim if possible.

Residential (3-4 old tires) may be taken to the WTE plant or the transfer stations as part of a load of trash. Will take them on rims if necessary. If the outside tire diameter is over 36" the tires must be cut into 2ft. lengths. No dedicated loads of tires. It must be tires and garbage.

<u>Commercial Loads</u> Regular garbage rates apply. Large loads CALL FIRST. Approximately 100 passenger tires = 1 ton. (20lb./tire)

Alpine Tire - 535-0261 3534 E. Trent Will take tires for disposal (cold process retreading). Retains right to refuse if someone has too many. **CALL FIRST** for tire disposal fees.

Toilet – Old or broken porcelain toilets are not recyclable. Put them out for the garbage truck or take them to the WTE plant or transfer station. If they are in working order and not cracked you may be able to take them to one of the following:

Brown Building Materials 535-0112. They must be complete. (lid, tank and bowl).

Habitat For Humanity - Will take reusable toilets if they are watersavers and meet current building codes. 535-9517

Toilet Bowl Cleaner - (sodium hydroxide type) Rinse the empty container before putting it in the trash; do not get the rinse water on your hands. If you have a lot of leftover cleaner, take to a Household Hazardous Waste Drop Site.

Toner Cartridges - Owners of HP LaserJet printers are being encouraged to return their empty cartridges rather than just throw them into the trash. All new cartridges should have a UPS label in the box for returning the old cartridge. If not, customers can get a free toner cartridge recycling kit by calling 1-800-340-2445.
