

Wildfire Debris Disposal

Victims of the Oregon Rd and Gray wildfires are encouraged to use their insurance claim process and a certified waste contractor for property clean up.

The City of Spokane's Waste to Energy facility <u>will now accept</u> fire damaged materials which are recognizable and free of ash <u>if accompanied by an asbestos survey.</u>

Accepted items include:

- · Household items and furniture
- Clothing
- Household Hazardous Waste
- Bagged spoiled food
- Appliances
- Charred yard waste (oversized items will be charged the garbage rate)

Items NOT accepted at Waste To Energy include:

- Asbestos containing material
- Presumed asbestos containing material
- Materials without an asbestos survey
- · Ash, soil, and items burned beyond recognition
- · Complete loads mixed with the any of the above items will be rejected

Ash, asbestos containing material or presumed asbestos containing material must be taken to Graham Rd Landfill:

*Call ahead for an appointment and documentation requirements.

Materials must be accompanied by a conventional asbestos survey or an alternate asbestos survey from an AHERA building inspector showing no asbestos. A copy must be left at the scalehouse when disposing of debris.
