

CITY OF SPOKANE OBSTRUCTION NOTICE

June 5 – 12, 2020

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- The state of Washington is complying with Gov. Jay Inslee’s [“Stay Home, Stay Healthy”](#) order to provide social distancing to slow the spread of COVID-19 in our communities. Please limit travel to essential trips only during this time.
- Some construction projects have been suspended during the “Stay Home, Stay Healthy” order and others are on different schedules. Please be prepared for changes in street obstructions.

Projects highlighted in RED have notable changes this week. Construction is tentative and subject to change at any time.

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

[37TH AVENUE SIDEWALK, MANITO BOULEVARD TO LATAWAH STREET](#)

- Crews will be installing sidewalks and driveways on the south side of 37th Avenue between Manito Boulevard and Latawah Street. The road will be open but construction will make access limited at times.

Utility companies are onsite moving their services.

This project will construct a six-foot sidewalk on south side of 37th Avenue, to include ADA curb ramps and storm drain modifications as required.

This is a \$430,000 project funded with local and state funds.

[CINCINNATI GREENWAY SPOKANE FALLS BOULEVARD TO EUCLID AVENUE](#)

- Crews are working in the intersection of Foothills Drive and Cincinnati Street installing catch basins, bump outs, and an island with lane closures on Foothills.
- Concrete crews installing sidewalk on Cincinnati Street at various locations between Mission and Euclid Avenue.

This project will add greenway elements to Cincinnati Street.

This is a \$567,428 project.

ROWAN WATER & SEWER FORCE MAIN FROM HAVEN STREET TO MYRTLE STREET

- Crews will be working at the intersection of Haven Street and Rowan Avenue. Southbound Haven Street is closed at Rowan Avenue and traffic is detoured to Market Street. During this work, Market Street will serve both southbound and northbound traffic.

This project will relocate city utilities associated with construction of the North South Corridor.

This is a \$3.5 million project funded with state funds.

SPOKANE ARTERIAL CURB RAMPS – NORTH

- Crews are installing ramps on Freya Street between Upriver Drive and Garland Avenue.

This project will update curb ramps for ADA compliance on streets where the Street Department is doing grind and overlay projects.

This is a \$1.1 million project funded with local funds.

SPOKANE FALLS BOULEVARD COMBINED SEWER OVERFLOW TANK (CSO 26) PROJECT

- The following streets will be closed Thursday, June 4, 7 p.m. to Friday, June 5, 5 a.m.
 - Lincoln Street from Riverside to Main Avenue
 - Eastbound Main Avenue between Monroe and Lincoln Street
- The lower walkway on the north side of the plaza will be closed for painting from Monday, June 8 to Friday, June 19.
- Monday, June 8, Lincoln Street will be close between Spokane Falls Boulevard and Main Avenue. This closure will be in place until September 2020.

The project is part of the City's efforts to get to a Cleaner River Faster. The tank will includes a new public plaza with views of the lower falls of the Spokane River.

This is a \$20 million project funded with City Utility funds.

STREET PRESERVATION – NORTH

- Crews are working on a grind and overlay project on Mission Avenue between Greene Street and Trent Avenue. One lane will be open in each direction.

The grind and overlay project will also update curb ramps for ADA compliance. This is a federally funded project and is separate from our regular grind and overlay projects.

This is a \$1.4 million project funded with federal funds.

The following streets will be closed:
 - Summit Parkway between Cedar Street and Jefferson Lane
 - Adams Lane north of Summit Parkway

NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Lyons Avenue between Perry and Nevada Street will be completely closed from 6/1/2020 to 6/5/2020 for Inch by Inch Excavating work.
- Lincoln Street between 14th and 16th Avenue will be flagged on from 05/26/2020 to 06/08/2020 for Avista work.
- The east curb lane of Stevens Street between Main and First Avenue will be closed from 5/26/2020 to 6/9/2020 for Quanta work.
- Francis Avenue between Cedar and Madison Street will have alternating lane closures at night from 5/11/2020 to 6/11/2020 for Avista work.
- The westbound curb lane of 29th Avenue between Lee and Martin Street will be closed from 6/8/2020 to 6/11/2020 for MJM Grand work.
- The eastbound curb lane of Francis Avenue between Atlantic and Calispel Street will be closed from 6/1/2020 to 6/15/2020 for Quanta work.
- The eastbound curb lane of Spokane Falls Boulevard between Hamilton and Sherman Street will be closed from 6/4/2020 to 6/18/2020 for Quanta work.
- The northbound curb lane of Grand Boulevard between Sumner Avenue and Rockwood Boulevard will be closed from 5/19/20 to 6/19/2020 for Quanta work.
- Fourth Avenue between Madelia and Magnolia Street and Pittsburg Street between Third and Fifth Avenue will be completely closed from 6/8/2020 to 6/19/2020 for Avista work.
- Regal Street between 44th Avenue and Palouse Highway will have night work and flaggers in place from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. until 6/26/2020.
- Belt Street between Everett and Sanson Avenue will be temporarily closed and flagged when needed from 5/28/2020 to 6/28/2020 for Avista work.

PARKS

MANITO PARK MIRROR POND

- The next phase of work on the Manito Pond Mirror Pond master plan is nearly complete. [Read details here](#). Work is anticipated to be completed in June. Thank you for your patience during renovations while we create a healthier pond!

RIVERFRONT PARK CONSTRUCTION

- **North Bank:** Work on the North Bank [playground, wheels park, parking lot, and basketball court](#) is underway. The playground is anticipated to open spring 2021. Some pathways are impacted, along with the closure of Parking lot 1 off Washington Street and North River Drive during construction. [View a map](#).
- **West Havermale:** An [inclusive playground](#) funded by Providence Health Care is anticipated to open fall 2020, along with a renovated Theme Stream from Expo '74 and enhanced connectivity to the Centennial Trail. The lower portion of parking lot 6 is closed. [View a map](#).

STREET DEPARTMENT PROJECTS

ARTERIAL CRACK SEALING

- Francis Avenue, Division to Freya Street.

GRIND AND OVERLAY

- Nevada Street, Sharpsburg Avenue to Magnesium Road
 - Work continues on this project.

POTHOLE CREWS

- City crews continue to fill potholes. If you see a pothole, report it by calling **3-1-1**. Potholes can also be reported online through [your MySpokane account](#). Crews focus on the largest holes on the busiest streets first. Include as much information as possible on the location and size of the pothole.

STREET SWEEPING

- All sweeping crews are finishing the arterials and starting residential sweeping.
 - Northwest: Rt. 6, Francis to Wellesley, Ash to A St. **Rt. 10, Indian Trail Rd to Greenwood, Nadine to Marjorie.**
 - Northeast: Rt. 28, Rich to Bruce, Havana to Crestline. **Rt. 29, Francis to Wellesley, Crestline to Nevada**
 - South: **Rt. 51, 5th Ave to 14th Ave, Monroe to Cannon. Rt. 39, 18th Ave to 10th Ave, Southeast Blvd to Crestline.**

UTILITY CREW

- Crews will be working throughout the city on water and sewer repairs.

ADDITIONAL WORK

- Bridge crews will be working on various sections of the Maple Street Bridge.
- Alley crews will be working in the southwest and southeast sections of the city.

WATER DEPARTMENT

CRESTLINE STREET

- Northbound Crestline Street will be merged into the center turn lane between Lacrosse and Rockwell Avenue on Tuesday, June 9.

BROADWAY AVENUE

- Broadway Avenue between Chestnut and Nettleton Street will be closed on Wednesday, June 10. Detours will be in place.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

I-90 – US 2 GARDEN SPRINGS TO BROADWAY AVE – RAMP METERS

- Five new ramp meters will be constructed. Eastbound I-90 ramp meter locations:
 - Walnut St.
 - Monroe St.
 - Division St.
 - Hamilton St.
 - US 195 - constructed and will be operational spring 2019

Westbound I-90 on ramps include Division (Browne) St. only.

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC BNSF 2ND RAILROAD REALIGNMENT

- The three-year Wellesley Avenue closure between Market and Freya Street began Nov. 21, 2019.
- The following streets are permanently closed:
 - Bridgeport, Cleveland and Fairview Avenue between Ralph and Market Street
 - Grace, Marietta, and Jackson Avenue between Ralph and Greene Street
- Drivers have east/west access on Francis, Upriver, Carlisle, and Euclid Avenue.

SR 290 – SPOKANE RIVER EAST TRENT BRIDGE

- Trent Avenue is closed between Hamilton Street and North Iron Court. [Detours](#) for large trucks, light vehicles and pedestrians will be in place.
