Projects highlighted in RED have notable changes this week. Construction is tentative and subject to change at any time.

### **CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

### ARTERIAL GRIND & OVERLAY NORTH - ECONOMIC RECOVERY PROJECT

- Crews are working on Indian Trail Road between Francis and Kathleen Avenue. One lane of traffic is open in each direction. Please be aware of large equipment moving around.
- Due to the wildfire smoke, the start of this work was pushed back to Monday, Sept. 21.
  Nevada Street between Francis and Sharpsburg Avenue will have lane closures as crews start saw cutting.

This project will repave the following arterials Indian Trail Road (Francis to Kathleen Avenue), Nevada Street (Francis to Sharpsburg Avenue), Nevada Street (Holland Avenue to Magnesium Road).

This is a \$2 million project.

## ARTERIAL GRIND & OVERLAY SOUTH – ECONOMIC RECOVERY PROJECT

- Crews are working on Eagle Ridge Boulevard between Shelby Street and Meadow Lane.
  The street will remain open with flaggers directing traffic.
- Crews are working on Bernard Street between High Drive and 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Traffic control is in place allowing one lane of traffic each direction.

This project will repave the following arterials Eagle Ridge Boulevard (Shelby Street to Meadow Lane), Regal Street (46<sup>th</sup> to 55<sup>th</sup> Avenue), Bernard Street (High Drive to 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue)

This is a \$1.7 million project.

### FIVE MILE ROAD FROM LINCOLN TO STRONG ROAD

Crews are working on landscaping

This project included full depth pavement restoration on Five Mile Road, from Lincoln to Strong.

This is a \$2.7 million project.

## **GEIGER BOULEVARD PHASE 2 FROM SODA TO GROVE ROAD**

- Soda Road is closed between Geiger Boulevard and Electric Avenue.
- Geiger Boulevard is closed between Electric Avenue and Spring Road.

This project will install a water and sewer main.

This is a \$1 million project.

## HAMILTON STREET CORRIDOR SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

- Hamilton Street is reduced to one lane in each direction.
- Crews are working at the Sharp and Illinois Avenue intersections. Illinois Avenue is closed west of Hamilton Street. Access to businesses will be maintained.
- Additional Hamilton lane closures may occur for night work, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

The project is designed to make safety and traffic flow improvements at six intersections, including the addition of dedicated left turn pockets and signals.

This is a \$3.3 million project funded with local and federal funds.

## MAPLE STREET GATEWAY AND 4<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE LIVING WALL

 Crews are finishing planting. Work is adjacent to Fourth Avenue between Lincoln and Wall Street.

This project includes landscaping improvements adjacent to the I-90 viaduct.

The \$375,000 project is funded with local funds.

## NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR – CLEVELAND, GREENE, GRACE, JACKSON, RALPH

• The intersection of Ralph Street and Upriver Drive will be closed. A detour will be in place.

This project will relocate city utilities associated with construction of the North South Corridor.

This is a \$5.6 million project funded with local funds.

## **PAVING UNPAVED RESIDENTIAL STREETS – NORTHEAST**

- The following streets will be closed starting Monday, Sept. 21.
  - o Altamont Street, 46<sup>th</sup> to 49<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Napa Street, Francis to Dalke Avenue

This project will pave unpaved residential streets

This is a \$228,000 project funded with local funds.

### POST STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

- The Post Street Bridge is closed.
- The intersection of Lincoln Street and Summit Boulevard is closed and half of the adjacent parking lot.
- Parking is limited on Post Street, and the Riverfront Park parking lot on Post just south of the bridge is closed.
- The bridge will open in 2022. See the detour routes for pedestrians and bicyclists.

This project will replace the Post Street Bridge and associated utilities.

This is an \$18.5 million project.

## **RESIDENTIAL GRIND & OVERLAY**

• This project is substantially complete. Landscape and fencing repairs are being made.

This project will repave the following residential city streets Queen Avenue (Standard to Perry), Longfellow Avenue (Post Street to Division), Scott Street (43rd to Thurston), and Garfield Street (43rd to Thurston).

This is a \$1.1 million project.

## **ROWAN WATER & SEWER FORCE MAIN FROM HAVEN STREET TO MYRTLE STREET**

• Work continues on Rowan Avenue between Freya and Ferrall Street.

This project will relocate city utilities associated with construction of the North South Corridor.

This is a \$3.5 million project funded with state funds.

## **SOUTH GORGE TRAIL PHASE 2**

Due to the wildfire smoke, the start of this project was pushed back to Monday, Sept.
 21.

This project will construct a 10-foot wide pedestrian and bike trail, water main and pavement reconstruction of Clarke Ave, and storm water mitigation at various locations.

This is a \$4 million project funded with local and state funds.

### **SPOKANE ARTERIAL CURB RAMPS – SOUTH**

- Crews will work in the following intersection
  - Cedar Street and 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Cedar Street and 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Cedar Street and 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Cedar Street and 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - o Cedar Street and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Cedar Street and 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Cedar Street and 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Walnut Pl and 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue (West)
  - Walnut Pl and 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue (East)
  - Walnut Pl and 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue (West)
  - Walnut Street and 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Walnut Street and 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Walnut Street and 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Walnut Street and 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Walnut Street and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue

This project will update curb ramps for ADA compliance on streets where the Street Department is doing grind and overlay projects.

This is an \$816,000 project funded with local funds.

## SPOKANE FALLS BOULEVARD COMBINED SEWER OVERFLOW TANK (CSO 26) PROJECT

- Lincoln Street is closed between Spokane Falls Boulevard and Main Avenue. This closure will be in place until September 2020.
- Monday, Sept. 21 through Wednesday, Sept. 23, the south lane of Spokane Falls Boulevard between Post and Monroe Street will be closed.

This project is part of the City's efforts to get to a Cleaner River Faster. The tank includes a new public plaza with views of the lower falls of the Spokane River.

This is a \$20 million project funded with City Utility funds.

## RIVERFRONT PARK CONSTRUCTION

- North Bank: Work on the North Bank playground, wheels park, parking lot, and basketball court is underway. The trail immediately north of the river, between the Washington Street Bridge and the Howard Street Promenade, is closed to accommodate construction.
- West Havermale: An <u>inclusive playground</u> funded by Providence Health Care is anticipated to open fall 2020, along with a renovated Theme Stream from Expo '74 and enhanced connectivity to the Centennial Trail. Parking lot 6 in this area is closed during construction of the Post St. Bridge, but a few spaces will re-open for access to the playground this fall. <u>View a map</u>.

## **CRACK SEALING**

### **GRIND AND OVERLAY**

• Crews are working on Lindeke Street between Sunset Boulevard and 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

### **POTHOLE CREWS**

• City crews continue to fill potholes. If you see a pothole, report it by calling **3-1-1**. Potholes can also be reported online through your MySpokane account. Crews focus on the largest holes on the busiest streets first. Include as much information as possible on the location and size of the pothole.

### **STREET SWEEPING**

• All sweeping crews are finishing the arterials and starting residential sweeping.

o Northwest: Rt. 32, WestPoint to Falls and Evergreen to Monroe.

Northeast: North Arterial Route
 South: South Arterial Route

#### **UTILITY CREW**

Crews will be working throughout the city on water and sewer repairs.

## **ADDITIONAL WORK**

• Bridge crews will be working on various sections of the Maple Street Bridge and Freya bridge joints, as well as other projects.

### WASTEWATER DEPARTMENT PROJECTS

HAVEN STREET AT WELLESLEY AVENUE

Due to the wildfire smoke, this work was pushed to Monday, Sept. 21. Haven Street will be closed at Wellesley Avenue for a wastewater repair south of Hoffman Avenue. Haven Street traffic will be detoured right onto Wellesley Avenue, left onto Crestline Street, left onto Empire Avenue and right back onto Market Street.

## WATER DEPARTMENT PROJECTS

• SHOSHONE PLACE, BERNARD TO STEVENS STREET

Shoshone Place between Bernard and Stevens Street and the intersection of Oneida Place and Shoshone Place are closed. Crews are replacing a 111 year old steel water main and 17 service lines.

# WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

## I-90 – SPRAGUE AVENUE INTERCHANGE TO ARAGONNE ROAD INTERCHANGE

- Crews are working Sunday through Thursday, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.; drivers should expect delays.
- The Freya Street eastbound I-90 on-ramp is closed drivers will be detoured to the Custer on-ramp.
- Expect delays during the overnight hours with completion in early October 2020.

### I-90 – US 2 GARDEN SPRINGS TO BROADWAY AVE – RAMP METERS

 Crews are working nighttime and daytime hours, Monday – Thursday at multiple locations.

- Five new ramp meters will be constructed. Eastbound I-90 ramp meter locations:

## NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC BNSF 2ND RAILROAD REALIGNMENT

- Wellesley Avenue is closed between Market and Freya Street.
- The following streets are permanently closed:
  - o Bridgeport, Cleveland and Fairview Avenue between Ralph and Market Street
  - o Grace, Marietta, and Jackson Avenue between Ralph and Greene Street
- Drivers have east/west access on Francis, Upriver, Carlisle, and Euclid Avenue.

## **SR 290 – SPOKANE RIVER EAST TRENT BRIDGE**

• Trent Avenue is closed between Hamilton Street and North Iron Court. <u>Detours</u> for large trucks, light vehicles and pedestrians will be in place.
