- Some construction projects have been suspended during the “Stay Home, Stay Healthy” order and others are on different schedules. Please be prepared for changes in street obstructions.

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

ARTERIAL GRIND & OVERLAY NORTH – ECONOMIC RECOVERY PROJECT

- **Indian Trail Road:** Crews are working on landscaping.
- **Nevada Street:** Crews are working on Nevada Street between Francis and Sharpsburg Avenue. **Wednesday, Oct. 21 crews are paving the northbound lanes.**
- **Nevada Street:** Crews are working on Nevada Street between Holland Avenue and Magnesium Road.

This project will repave the following arterials Indian Trail Road (Francis to Kathleen Avenue), Nevada Street (Francis to Sharpsburg Avenue), and Nevada Street (Holland Avenue to Magnesium Road).

This is a \$2 million project.

ARTERIAL GRIND & OVERLAY SOUTH – ECONOMIC RECOVERY PROJECT

- **Bernard Street:** Crews are working on Bernard Street between High Drive and 29th Avenue. **Wednesday, Oct. 21 to Friday, Oct. 23 crews are paving.**
- **Eagle Ridge Boulevard:** Crews are working on Eagle Ridge Boulevard between Shelby Street and Meadow Lane. The street will remain open with flaggers directing traffic. **Saturday, Oct. 24 and Monday, Oct. 26 crews are paving.**

- **Regal Street:** Crews are working on Regal Street between 46th and 55th Avenue. One lane of traffic will be open in each direction. **Saturday, Oct. 17 and Monday, Oct. 19 crews are paving.**

This project will repave the following arterials Eagle Ridge Boulevard (Shelby Street to Meadow Lane), Regal Street (46th to 55th Avenue), and Bernard Street (High Drive to 29th Avenue)

This is a \$1.7 million project.

BEN BURR CROSSINGS AT 2ND/PERRY & 3RD/PERRY

- Perry Street has lane restrictions from Second and Third Avenue.
- Liberty Park Place is closed to traffic between Third Avenue and Madelia Street.

This project includes crosswalk safety enhancements at Perry Street and Second Avenue and Perry Street and Third Avenue.

This is a \$363,000 project funded with local, state, and federal funds.

GEIGER BOULEVARD PHASE 2 FROM SODA TO GROVE ROAD

- Soda Road is closed between Geiger Boulevard and Electric Avenue.
- Geiger Boulevard is closed between Electric Avenue and Spring Road.

This project will install a water and sewer main.

This is a \$1 million project.

HAMILTON STREET CORRIDOR SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

- Hamilton Street is reduced to one lane in each direction
- Crews are working at the Sharp and Illinois Avenue intersections. Access to businesses will be maintained.
- Additional Hamilton lane closures may occur for night work, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

The project is designed to make safety and traffic flow improvements at six intersections, including the addition of dedicated left turn pockets and signals.

This is a \$3.3 million project funded with local and federal funds.

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR – CLEVELAND, GREENE, GRACE, JACKSON, RALPH

- The Market/Greene Street corridor is reduced to two lanes between Euclid and Jackson Avenue. The contractor is installing a new water line, making intersection improvement, and S-curve modifications. We anticipate the corridor improvements will be complete by Tuesday, Nov. 10.

This project will relocate city utilities associated with construction of the North South Corridor.

This is a \$5.6 million project funded with local funds.

POST STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

- The Post Street Bridge is closed.
- The intersection of Lincoln Street and Summit Boulevard is closed and half of the adjacent parking lot.
- Parking is limited on Post Street, and the Riverfront Park parking lot on Post just south of the bridge is closed.
- The bridge will open in 2022. [See the detour routes for pedestrians and bicyclists.](#)

This project will replace the Post Street Bridge and associated utilities.

This is an \$18.5 million project.

ROWAN WATER & SEWER FORCE MAIN FROM HAVEN STREET TO MYRTLE STREET

- Work continues on Rowan Avenue between Freya and Ferrall Street.

This project will relocate city utilities associated with construction of the North South Corridor.

This is a \$3.5 million project funded with state funds.

SOUTH GORGE TRAIL PHASE 2

- Water Avenue is closed west of Ash Street.
- The People's Park parking lot at the Sandifur Memorial Bridge is closed through Tuesday, Nov. 10. Foot and bicycle traffic access to the trails and bridge will be maintained throughout the project.

This project will construct a 10-foot wide pedestrian and bike trail, water main and pavement reconstruction of Clarke Ave, and storm water mitigation at various locations.

This is a \$4 million project funded with local and state funds.

SPOKANE ARTERIAL CURB RAMPS – SOUTH

- Crews will work on curb ramps at the following intersections
 - Walnut Pl and 10th Avenue (East)
 - Walnut Pl and 10th Avenue (West)
 - Walnut Street and 9th Avenue
 - Walnut Street and 8th Avenue
 - Walnut Street and 7th Avenue
 - Walnut Street and 6th Avenue
 - Walnut Street and 5th Avenue
 - Maple Street and 9th Avenue
 - Maple Street and 8th Avenue
 - Maple Street and 7th Avenue
 - Maple Street and 6th Avenue

This project will update curb ramps for ADA compliance on streets where the Street Department is doing grind and overlay projects.

This is an \$816,000 project funded with local funds.

NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- The west curb lane of Stevens Street between the Spokane River and Main Avenue and the north lane of Main Avenue between Wall and Stevens Street will be closed from 10/8/20 to 10/15/20.
- Crestline Street between 44th and 49th Avenue will be flagged both directions from 9/17/20 to 10/16/20 for Sefnco Work.
- The west curb lane of Washington Street between Dean Avenue and the Spokane River will be closed on 10/5/20 to 10/16/20 for Avista work.
- The westbound curb lane of Boone Avenue between Howard and Lincoln Street will be closed from 10/9/20 to 10/16/20 for Track Utilities work.
- The northbound curb lane of Regal Street between 32nd and 30th Avenue will be closed from 10/12/20 to 10/16/20 for Track Utilities work.
- The westbound curb lane of Wellesley Avenue between Stone and Pittsburg Street will be closed on 10/16/20 for Professional Pipe Service work.
- The west curb lane of Ash Street between Maxwell and Sharp Avenue will be closed from 10/5/20 to 10/18/20 for Avista work.
- Madison Street between Wellesley and Princeton Avenue will be closed on 10/19/20 for Zetin Contractor work.
- The following streets will be closed for Quanta work between 10/6/20 to 10/20/20:

- West curb lane of Lincoln Street between First and Sprague Avenue
- South curb lane of Sprague Avenue between Howard and Wall Street
- North curb lane of First Avenue between Wall and Howard Street
- The south curb lane of Sprague Avenue between Jefferson and Cedar Street will be closed from 9/30/20 to 10/23/20 for Cameron-Reilly work.
- Young Construction will be working at the northeast corner of Sprague Avenue and Havana Street with lane closures on Sprague and Havana from 10/5/20 to 10/23/20.
- Assembly Road between Windsor Road and 28th Avenue will be completely closed with a detour in place from 10/7/20 to 10/23/20 for MJM Grand work.
- **Wall Street between Spokane Falls Boulevard and Main Avenue will be closed from 10/12/20 to 10/23/20 for Yost Gallagher work.**
- **The northbound curb lane of Monroe Street between Gardner and Boone Avenue will be closed from 10/19/20 to 10/23/20 for CenturyLink work.**
- The intersection of Heroy Avenue and Lacey Street will be completely closed from 9/28/20 to 10/26/20 for Avista work.
- Both curb lands of Regal Street between Nora and Sharp Avenue will be closed from 9/9/20 to 10/28/20 for Cameron-Reilly work.
- **Hartson Avenue between Perry and Helena Street will be closed completely from 10/19/20 to 10/30/20 for Piersol Construction work.**
- All lanes of First between Walnut and Jefferson Street will be reduced to one lane from 10/5/20 to 10/30/20 for Cameron-Reilly work.
- The southbound curb lane of Freya Street between Olive and Sprague Avenue will be closed from 10/5/20 to 11/4/20 for Quanta work.
- **The east curb lane of Stevens Street between Spokane Falls Boulevard and Main Avenue will be closed from 10/19/20 to 11/13/20 for Potelco work.**
- The two east lanes of Lincoln Street between Second and Main Avenue will be closed from 10/5/20 to 04/05/21 for Avista work.

SPOKANE PUBLIC LIBRARY

DOWNTOWN LIBRARY CONSTRUCTION

- Lincoln Street is closed between Spokane Falls Boulevard and Main Avenue until March 2022.
- The sidewalks adjacent to the downtown library on Main Avenue, Monroe Street, and Spokane Falls Boulevard are closed until March 2021.

SPOKANE PARKS AND RECREATION

RIVERFRONT PARK CONSTRUCTION

- **North Bank:** Work on the North Bank [playground, wheels park, parking lot, and basketball court](#) is underway. The trail immediately north of the river, between the Washington Street Bridge and the Howard Street Promenade, is closed to accommodate construction.

- **West Havermale:** An [inclusive playground](#) funded by Providence Health Care is anticipated to open fall 2020, along with a renovated Theme Stream from Expo '74 and enhanced connectivity to the Centennial Trail. Parking lot 6 in this area is closed during construction of the Post St. Bridge, but a few spaces will re-open for access to the playground this fall. [View a map.](#)

SPOKANE TRANSIT AUTHORITY

- [City Line Construction](#)
 - The south curb lane of Main Avenue between Bernard and Division Street will be closed from until Saturday, Oct. 24.
 - The north curb lane of First Avenue between Cedar and Adams Street will be closed until early November.
 - The south curb lane of Sprague Avenue from Cedar to just east of Adams Street until mid-late November.

STREET DEPARTMENT PROJECTS

ALLEY CREW

- Alley crew is working on unimproved streets in the southwest and southeast section of the city.

CRACK SEALING

- Arterial Crack Sealing
 - Cochran Street, Northwest Boulevard to Courtland Avenue
- Residential Crack Sealing
 - Jefferson Street/18th Avenue et al.

GRIND AND OVERLAY

- Third Avenue between Perry and Stone Street.
- **Broadway Avenue, Chestnut to Maple Street.**

POTHOLE CREWS

- City crews continue to fill potholes. If you see a pothole, report it by calling **3-1-1**. Potholes can also be reported online through [your MySpokane account](#). Crews focus on the largest holes on the busiest streets first. Include as much information as possible on the location and size of the pothole.

STREET SWEEPING

- All sweeping crews are working on arterial routes.

UTILITY CREW

- Crews will be working throughout the city on water and sewer repairs.

ADDITIONAL WORK

- Bridge crews will be working on various sections of the Maple Street Bridge and Freya bridge joints, as well as other projects.

WATER DEPARTMENT PROJECTS

- **SHOSHONE PLACE, BERNARD TO STEVENS STREET**

Shoshone Place between Bernard and Stevens Street and the intersection of Oneida Place and Shoshone Place are closed. Crews are replacing a 111 year old steel water main and 17 service lines.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

I-90 – US 2 GARDEN SPRINGS TO BROADWAY AVE – RAMP METERS

- Crews are working nighttime and daytime hours, Monday – Thursday at multiple locations.
- Five new ramp meters will be constructed. Eastbound I-90 ramp meter locations:
 - Walnut Street
 - Monroe Street
 - Division Street
 - Hamilton Street
- Westbound I-90 on ramps include Division (Browne) Street only.

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC BNSF 2ND RAILROAD REALIGNMENT

- Wellesley Avenue is closed between Market and Freya Street.
- The following streets are permanently closed:
 - Bridgeport, Cleveland and Fairview Avenue between Ralph and Market Street
 - Grace, Marietta, and Jackson Avenue between Ralph and Greene Street
- Drivers have east/west access on Francis, Upriver, Carlisle, and Euclid Avenue.

SR 290 – SPOKANE RIVER EAST TRENT BRIDGE

- Trent Avenue is closed between Hamilton Street and North Iron Court. [Detours](#) for large trucks, light vehicles and pedestrians will be in place.
