CITY OF SPOKANE OBSTRUCTION NOTICE

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April 30 - May 7, 2021

- Some construction projects have been suspended due to the pandemic and others are on different schedules. Please be prepared for changes in street obstructions.

Projects highlighted in RED have notable changes this week. Construction is tentative and subject to change at any time.

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

GEIGER BOULEVARD PHASE 2 FROM SODA TO GROVE ROAD

• Geiger Boulevard from Flightline Boulevard to just west of Soda Road is closed with a detour in place. Please follow the detour signs.

This project includes water and sewer main installation.

This is a \$1 million project.

HAMILTON STREET CORRIDOR SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

- Crews are working at the intersections of Indiana Avenue and North Foothills Drive.
 There are no left turns onto Indiana Avenue or North Foothills Drive.
- Hamilton is reduced to one lane in each direction between Augusta Avenue and just north of North Foothills Drive.
- One eastbound lane of Mission Avenue and one northbound lane of Hamilton Street will
 close for signal work. The closures starts Monday, May 3 and will be in place for three
 weeks.

The project is designed to make safety and traffic flow improvements at six intersections, including the addition of dedicated left turn pockets and signals.

This is a \$3.3 million project funded with local and federal funds.

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR - CLEVELAND, GREENE, GRACE, JACKSON, RALPH

- The following streets are closed
 - o Ralph Street is closed from Cleveland to Grace Avenue
 - Cleveland Avenue is closed from Market to Regal Street
 - Regal Street is closed from Cleveland to Illinois Avenue

Please follow all traffic control signs and detours.

This project will relocate city utilities associated with construction of the North South Corridor.

This is a \$5.6 million project funded with local funds.

POST STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

- The Post Street Bridge is closed.
- The intersection of Lincoln Street and Summit Boulevard is closed and half of the adjacent parking lot.
- Parking is limited on Post Street, and the Riverfront Park parking lot on Post just south of the bridge is closed.
- The bridge will open in 2022. See the detour routes for pedestrians and bicyclists.

This project will replace the Post Street Bridge and associated utilities.

This is an \$18.5 million project.

SOUTH GORGE TRAIL PHASE 2

- Clarke Avenue is closed from Spruce to Elm Street.
- Landscaping work is taking place in the vicinity of Sandifur Bridge parking area.

Please follow all traffic control signs and detours.

This project will construct a 10-foot wide pedestrian and bike trail, water main and pavement reconstruction of Clarke Ave, and stormwater mitigation at various locations.

This is a \$4 million project funded with local and state funds.

SPRAGUE AVENUE REBUILD PHASE 2B

- Sprague Avenue is closed between Grant and Division Street.
- Starting Monday, May 3, the two east lanes of Division Street will close, leaving the west lane open. This closure will be in place for about ten days. Motorists should expect delays.

Business access is available via First Avenue and also the alley north of Sprague Avenue from Grant to Cowley Street. Arterial traffic is detoured to Second and Third Avenues.

This project will reconstruct Sprague Avenue from Division to Grant Street while enhancing pedestrian and cyclist safety and provide utility replacements/upgrades.

This is a \$3.8 million project funded with local and federal funds.

STREET MAINTENANCE CURB RAMPS

- Crews are working on curb ramps in conjunction with the Hamilton Street Corridor project. This work does not have any additional closures.
- Crews are working on the northeast corner of Havana Street and Third Avenue. One southbound lane of Havana Street will be closed until Friday, May 7.
- Starting Wednesday, April 28, crews will be working in the Garland District.
 - Garland Avenue and Oak Street
 - Garland Avenue and Elm Street
 - Garland Avenue and Cannon Street
 - Garland Avenue and Elgin Street
 - Garland Avenue and Belt Street
 - o Rowan Avenue, Addison to Cincinnati Street
 - Rowan Avenue and Bemis

This project consists of installing curb ramps on streets where the Street Department has or will be doing grind and overlay work.

This is a \$500,000 project funded with local funds.

NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- The west curb lane and shoulder of Highway 2 between Hawthorne Road and Holland Avenue will be closed from 3/1/21 to 4/30/21 for NNAC work.
- The north curb lane of First Avenue between Jefferson and Monroe Street will be closed from 3/22/21 to 4/30/21 for Cameron-Reilly work.
- The northbound curb lane of Jefferson Street between Second and Fourth Avenue will be closed from 3/29/21 to 4/30/21 for Sefnco work.

- The northbound curb lane of Division Street between Francis and Lyons Avenue will be closed from 4/8/21 to 4/30/21 for Sefnco work.
- Assembly Road will be completely closed between Windsor Road and 29th Avenue from 4/12/21 to 4/30/21 for MJM Grand work.
- The northbound curb lane of Hamilton Street between Boone and Marietta Avenue will be closed from 4/21/21 to 4/30/21 for Cameron Reilly work.
- The southbound curb lane of Regal Street between 39th and Thurston Avenue will be closed, and the southbound curb lane of Regal Street will be shifted into the median between 45th and 47th Avenue from 4/26/21 to 4/30/21 for Sefnco work.
- The southbound curb lane of Nevada Street between Highway 2 and Westview Court will be closed from 4/19/21 to 4/30/21 for Avista work.
- The westbound curb lane of Cozza Drive will be shifted into the median between Nevada and Hamilton Street from 4/19/21 to 4/30/21 for Avista work.
- Sinto Avenue between Howard and Washington Street will be closed completely from 4/26/21 to 4/30/21 for Piersol Construction work.
- The northbound curb lane of Nevada Street between Lyons and Sharpsburg Avenue will be closed from 4/20/21 to 4/30/21 for Baker Construction work.
- The northbound curb lane of Ray Street between 14th and 17th Avenue, as well as the southbound curb lane of Thor Street between 9th and 14th Avenue will be closed on 4/30/21 for Sefnco work.
- The east lane of Washington Street will be closed from the I-90 overpass to Second Avenue from 5/3/21 to 5/17/21 for Avista work.
- Wall Street between Main and Riverside Avenue will be closed completely from 4/28/21 to 5/5/21 for Yost Gallagher work.
- The southbound curb lane of Greene Street between Nora and Mission Street will be closed from 4/27/21 to 5/6/21 for Cascade Cable work.
- The intersection of Crestline Street and 33rd Avenue is closed from 3/15/21 to 5/7/21 for the <u>Garden District PUD</u> project.
- Both curbside lanes of Five Mile Road between Austin Road and Belt Street will be closed, as well as the south curbside lane shifted into oncoming center lane at a separate time from 4/30/21 to 5/7/21 for Sefnco work.
- Freya Street between 47th and 57th Avenue will be flagged for short periods of time when needed from 4/12/21 to 5/10/21 for Quanta work.
- The northbound curb lane of Washington Street between North River Drive and Boone Avenue will be closed from 4/28/21 to 5/12/21 for Quanta work.
- The southbound curb lane of Regal Street between Thurston and 44th Avenue will be closed from 5/7/21 to 5/12/21 for Sefnco work.
- The eastbound curb lane of 29th Avenue between Perry Street and Southeast Boulevard will be closed from 5/7/21 to 5/14/21 for Sefnco work.
- Dean Avenue will be closed completely between Howard and Washington Street from 5/3/21 to 5/21/21 for Lydig Construction work.
- Rotating lane closures on Main Avenue between Howard and Stevens Street from 5/11/21 to 5/25/21 for Quanta work.

- Rowan between Avenue Standard and Nevada Street will be flagged from 5/3/21 to 5/28/21 for Track Utilities work.
- Both curbside lanes of Grand Boulevard between 13th and 14th Avenue will be closed from 5/3/21 to 5/28/21 for Sefnco Work.
- The intersection of Driscoll Boulevard and Bismark Avenue will be flagged all directions from 5/10/21 to 5/28/21 for Track Utilities work.
- Lidgerwood Street between Wellesley and Queen Avenue will be flagged from 5/10/21 to 6/11/21 for Track Utilities work.
- The northbound curb lane of Five Mile Drive between Stratton Avenue and Cascade Way/Lincoln Road will be closed from 5/3/21 to 6/2/21 for Quanta work.
- All curb lanes and turn lanes at the intersection of Wellesley Avenue and Crestline Street will be closed and traffic flagged from 5/24/21 to 6/4/21 for Sefnco work.
- Lidgerwood Street between Wellesley and Queen Avenue will be flagged from 5/10/21 to 6/11/21 for Track Utilities work.
- Street closure on Granite Street at Upriver Drive starting 4/5/21 for the <u>Riverview</u>
 Granite Street project. This will eventually be a complete street vacation of Granite Street.

SPOKANE PARKS AND RECREATION

RIVERFRONT PARK

- North Bank: Work on the North Bank playground, wheels park, parking lot, and basketball court continues, with plans for completion in May 2021.
- West Havermale: The StepWell art piece is slated for opening in the fall of 2021.
- North Suspension Bridge: Reconstruction of the bridge will begin in mid-May, and it will remain closed until winter/spring 2022. The eastbound lane of Broadway Avenue between Lincoln and Post Street, including the south sidewalk, will be closed Monday, May 3 early January. The south suspension bridge and snxw mene? island will also be closed to accommodate construction. The north bridge will receive a new deck, floor beams, lighting, and electrical components. The detour is across the Howard Street Promenade through Riverfront Park.

MANITO PARK

 <u>Nishinomiya-Tsutakawa Japanese Garden</u>: The Koi Pond is undergoing a water conservation project that will improve pond quality and save 16 – 18 millions of gallons of water annually. The garden will remain closed until July 2021 to accommodate construction.

SPOKANE PUBLIC LIBRARY

DOWNTOWN LIBRARY CONSTRUCTION

- Lincoln Street is closed between Spokane Falls Boulevard and Main Avenue until March 2022.
- The sidewalks adjacent to the downtown library on Main Avenue, Monroe Street, and Spokane Falls Boulevard are closed.

SPOKANE TRANSIT AUTHORITY

CITY LINE CONSTRUCTION

- The two southern lanes of Sprague Avenue between Monroe and Madison Street are closed for utility work until late-April to accommodate utility and roadway work in preparation for a City Line station. Construction signage and detours are in place.
- The two northern lanes of First Avenue between Monroe and Madison Street are closed until late-April to accommodate utility and roadway work in preparation for a City Line station. Construction signage and detours are in place.
- The two southern lanes of Main Avenue between Wall and Howard Street are closed until early-May to accommodate utility and roadway work in preparation for a City Line station. Construction signage and detours are in place.
- Pacific Avenue between Chestnut and Spruce Street is closed until late-May to accommodate utility and roadway work in preparation for a City Line station. Construction signage and detours will be in place.
- Pacific Avenue between Elm and Monroe Street is closed until late-May to accommodate utility and roadway work in preparation for a City Line station. Construction signage and detours will be in place.

STREET DEPARTMENT PROJECTS

ALLEY CREW

- Crews will be working Monday and Tuesday in the southeast section of the City, between 29th and 36th Avenue, Ray/Thor Street areas.
- On Wednesday and Thursday, the crews will be working in the northwest quadrant of the City, focusing on alleys off of Hoffman and Wellesley Avenue, and Calispel and Normandie Street areas.

CRACK SEALING

- Arterial Crack Sealing
 - Rowan Avenue, Driscoll to Monroe Street
- Residential Crack Sealing
 - Kathleen Avenue to Indian Trail Road, Et Al.

GRIND AND OVERLAY

- Crews are wrapping up Garland Avenue between Ash and Alberta Street.
- Monday, May 3, crews will start a project on Rowan Avenue between Addison and Nevada Street. Drivers should expect lane closures and delays.

POTHOLE CREWS

• City crews continue to fill potholes. If you see a pothole, report it by calling **3-1-1**. Potholes can also be reported online through <u>your MySpokane account</u>. Crews focus on the largest holes on the busiest streets first. Include as much information as possible on the location and size of the pothole.

STREET SWEEPING

- All sweeping crews are finishing the arterials and starting residential sweeping.
 - o Northwest: Rt. 16, Wellesley Rowan, Driscoll "A" St.
 - Northeast: Rt. 34, Division Mission, Helena/S. Riverton Trent/Parkwater
 - o South: Rt. 39, 18th Avenue 5th Avenue, Southeast Boulevard Crestline

ADDITIONAL WORK

- Crews are working on water and sewer repairs cuts.
- Bridge crews are working on various bridges to clear drains.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

I-90 – GEIGER ROAD INTERCHANGE RECONSTRUCTION

• The westbound loop on-ramp is permanently closed. A detour is in place to direct northbound Grove Road traffic to westbound I-90. A detour is also in place for all traffic exiting I-90 on the westbound off-ramp heading towards south Grove Rd.

The reconfigured interchange at Geiger Boulevard will provide for more efficient vehicle movement. Improvements include interchange ramp terminal intersection roundabouts.

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER TO COLUMBIA

 Euclid Avenue is reduced to one lane in each direction between Market and Ralph Street.

This project will complete the Wellesley Avenue interchange, including the mainline NSC bridge over Wellesley and two ramp bridges over BNSF spur line tracks.

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC BNSF 2ND RAILROAD REALIGNMENT

- Wellesley Avenue is closed between Market and Freya Street.
- The following streets are permanently closed:
 - o Bridgeport, Cleveland and Fairview Avenue between Ralph and Market Street
 - o Grace, Marietta, and Jackson Avenue between Ralph and Greene Street
- Drivers have east/west access on Francis, Upriver, Carlisle, and Euclid Avenue.

This project will realign the BNSF railroad tracks in north Spokane for the future US 395 highway.

ROSAMOND AVENUE OVERCROSSING OF I-90

• The Rosamond Avenue overcrossing of I-90 is closed. A detour utilizing the Lindeke Street is in place.
