Projects highlighted in RED have notable changes this week. Construction is tentative and subject to change at any time.

# **CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

# **HATCH ROAD BRIDGE DECK REPLACEMENT**

- The Hatch Road Bridge is closed.
- The northbound right lane of Highway 195 will be closed periodically during construction.
- Hatch Road is open from Hangman Valley to the bridge to local traffic only.

This project will replace the existing bridge deck.

This is a \$1.9 million project funded with federal funds.

#### **NORTH RIVER DRIVE SIDEWALK**

 North River Drive is closed at Washington Street. Businesses are accessible via Division Street.

This project includes a grind and overlay, sidewalk installation (on the south side), and stormwater improvements.

This is a \$1 million project funded with local funds.

# POST STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

- The Post Street Bridge is closed.
- The intersection of Lincoln Street and Summit Boulevard is closed.
- Post Street is closed at Spokane Falls Boulevard with local access only. Parking is limited on Post, and the Riverfront Park parking lot on Post just south of the bridge is closed.
- The bridge will open in 2022. See the detour routes for pedestrians and bicyclists.

This project will replace the Post Street Bridge and associated utilities.

This is an \$18.5 million project.

#### **SOUTH GORGE TRAIL PHASE 2**

- Crews are working on the landslide area in the vicinity of the intersection of Clarke Avenue and Elm Street.
- Clarke Avenue is closed between Ash and Elm Street.
- Southbound Elm Street at Clarke Avenue and eastbound Clarke Avenue at Elm Street will be closed between 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Please follow all traffic control signs and detours.

This project will construct a 10-foot wide pedestrian and bike trail, water main and pavement reconstruction of Clarke Avenue, stormwater mitigation at various locations and repair the land slide at Clarke Avenue and Elm Street.

This is a \$4 million project funded with local and state funds.

# SPOKANE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT RESERVOIR

- Construction will begin on Monday, April 11 and will be complete in 2024.
- No impacts to the traveling public are anticipated.

This project will construct a 3.6 million gallon drinking water reservoir near the Spokane International Airport.

This is a \$13.3 million project funded with state and local funds.

# **STREET MAINTENCANCE CURB RAMPS**

- There are shoulder closures at the following intersections:
  - Perry Street and Carlisle Avenue
  - Perry Street and Jackson Avenue
  - Perry Street and Marietta Avenue
  - Perry Street and Buckeye Avenue
  - Empire Avenue and Morton Street
  - Empire Avenue and Perry Street
  - Empire Avenue and Helena Street

This project consists of installing curb ramps on streets where the Street Department has or will be doing grind and overlay work.

This is a \$690,000 project funded with local funds.

# THOR-FREYA RECONSTRUCITON (HARTSON TO SPRAGUE)

- The Thor/Freya eastbound I-90 exit ramp is closed. Motorists are encouraged to exit at Altamont.
- Thor Street is closed from Sprague to 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Two-way traffic is detoured to Freya Street.
- Freya Street is closed from Alki to Sprague Avenue with traffic detoured to Havana Street.
- The westbound I-90 entrance ramp at Thor/Freya remains open.

This project will reconstruct the road, replace curb and stormwater facilities, upgrade ADA ramps, and replace water/sewer.

This is an \$8.9 million project funded with federal and local funds.

 Havana Street between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be closed for an asphalt repair from Tuesday, April 12 to Thursday, April 14.

# 43<sup>RD</sup> AVENUE AND SCOTT STREET

• On Monday, April 18 the intersection of 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Scott Street will be closed for pavement repairs.

# WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

# **CHILDREN OF THE SUN TRAIL**

 The right lane of Market Street at Garland Avenue is closed for piledriving and excavating for retaining walls of the Children of the Sun Trail. The right lane closure will remain in place through May.

This project continues to expand on the current Children of the Sun Trail located along the North Spokane Corridor between Columbia and Carlisle Avenue.

# NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER TO COLUMBIA

• The single lane reductions have been removed and Euclid Avenue is now fully open.

This project will complete the Wellesley Avenue interchange, including the mainline NSC bridge over Wellesley and two ramp bridges over BNSF spur line tracks.

#### NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPRAGUE TO SPOKANE RIVER - PHASE 1

 Work has started in the Spokane Community College parking lot at the north end near Ermina Avenue to begin excavation for bridge footings. Augusta Avenue between Ralph and Greene Street on the campus will be closed for safety concerns.

This project will construct the skyway portion of the North Spokane Corridor that traverses over Spokane Community College (Mission to Ermina Avenue).

# **ROSAMOND AVENUE OVERCROSSING OF I-90**

• The Rosamond Avenue overcrossing of I-90 is closed. A detour utilizing the Lindeke Street is in place. Work to make repairs on the bridge are scheduled to take place this summer.

#### SR 290 – SPOKANE RIVER EAST TRENT BRIDGE

• Trent Avenue is closed between Hamilton Street and North Iron Court. Detours are in place.

This project will demolish the old Trent Avenue Bridge and construct a new bridge to take its place.
