Projects highlighted in RED have notable changes this week. Construction is tentative and subject to change at any time.

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

COCHRAN BASIN STORMWATER PIPE

- The following streets will reopen on Friday, Aug. 12.
 - o Riverview Drive from Euclid to Cleveland Avenue
 - Cleveland Avenue from Riverview Drive to C Street
- Starting Monday, Aug. 15, Cleveland Avenue will be closed from C Street to T.J. Meenach Drive.

This project will install a pipe to connect stormwater from the intersection of T.J. Meenach Drive and Northwest Boulevard to the Downriver Golf Course where it will connect to the pipe being installed as part of the <u>Cochran Basin Stormwater Pipe through Downriver Golf Course project</u>.

This is a \$3 million project funded with state and local funds.

CURE-IN-PLACE-PIPE (CIPP) SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION

• This project starts Monday, Aug. 15. Crews will be tying sewer lines near the Iron Bridge.

This project includes the installation of 13,800 linear feet cure-in-place pipe. Also, side sewer reconnections and service connection repairs.

This is a \$1.4 million project.

CYCLE 9 SCHOOL SAFETY

Crews are working in all three districts.

- District 1
 - Bemiss Elementary Euclid Avenue and Cook Street crosswalk
 - Arlington Elementary Francis Avenue and Cook Street crosswalk
 - Gonzaga Prep Perry Street and Dalton Avenue crosswalk
 - Whitman Elementary install sidewalk on Helena Street, North Avenue, and Sanson Avenue

- District 2
 - Cataldo Catholic −18th Avenue and Bernard Street
 - o Grant Elementary 9th Avenue and Perry Street
- District 3
 - o Audubon Elementary –Northwest Boulevard and Elm Street
 - Glover Middle School install sidewalks on Nettleton Street between Walton and Garland Avenue
 - Madison Elementary install sidewalks on Everett Avenue from Wall to Whitehouse Street

This project includes sidewalk and crosswalk improvements in all three City of Spokane districts.

This is a \$2 million project funded with local funds.

CYCLE 9 TRAFFIC CALMING

- This project will start Monday, Aug. 15. Crews will be working in the following areas:
 - Southeast Boulevard at Lincoln Park driveway
 - Riverside Avenue and Grant Street

This project includes street and sidewalk improvements focused on pedestrians and traffic calming.

This is a \$1 million project funded with local funds.

POST STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

- The Post Street Bridge is closed.
- The intersection of Lincoln Street and Summit Boulevard is closed.
- Post Street is closed at Spokane Falls Boulevard with local access only. Parking is limited on Post, and the Riverfront Park parking lot on Post just south of the bridge is closed.
- See the detour routes for pedestrians and bicyclists.

This project will replace the Post Street Bridge and associated utilities.

This is an \$18.5 million project.

RESIDENTIAL CHIP SEAL

- Crews are working on the following streets:
 - O Pittsburg and Napa Street from Empire to Rich Avenue
 - Walton, LaCrosse, and Rich Avenue from Pittsburg to Crestline Street
 - O Pittsburg, Martin, Lee, Stone, and Altamont Street from 44th to Thurston Avenue

This project includes sidewalk and crosswalk improvements in all three City of Spokane districts.

This is a \$1 million project.

RIVERSIDE AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION FROM DIVISION TO MONROE

- The following streets are closed for Phase I of construction:
 - o Riverside Avenue will be closed at Division west to Bernard Street.
 - o Division Street will remain fully open to traffic traveling north.
 - Browne Street will maintain two through lanes traveling south.
 - Traffic signal work will take place at Browne Street and Riverside Avenue.
 - Please follow all traffic control signs and detours.

This project will reconfigure traffic lanes on Riverside Avenue from Division to Wall Street to accommodate new bicycle lanes. Also, replacement of the main waterline and service replacements as needed.

This is a \$4 million project.

SPOKANE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT RESERVOIR

- No impacts to the traveling public are anticipated.
- Construction will be complete in 2024.

This project will construct a 3.6 million gallon drinking water reservoir near the Spokane International Airport.

This is a \$13.3 million project funded with state and local funds.

SUNDANCE III FORCE MAIN REPLACEMENT

• Comanche Drive is closed to through traffic from Ridgecrest Drive to Shawnee Avenue.

This project will upgrade an existing PVC sewer force main to ductile iron pipe.

This is a \$525,000 project.

THOR-FREYA RECONSTRUCTION (HARTSON TO SPRAGUE)

- Freya Street is closed from Sprague to Hartson Avenue. Two-way traffic is detoured to Thor Street.
- The Thor/Freya eastbound I-90 exit ramp is closed. Motorists are encouraged to exit at Altamont Street.
- 3rd Avenue is reduced to one lane at the Altamont I-90 eastbound off ramp to Lee Street.
- 5th Avenue is restricted to a single lane of westbound traffic from Freya to Thor. Eastbound traffic is detoured to 3rd Avenue.
- 5th Avenue will be closed between Rebecca and Freya Street. Westbound traffic will be detoured to 6th Avenue and eastbound traffic to 3rd Avenue.

This project will reconstruct the road, replace curb and stormwater facilities, upgrade ADA ramps, and replace water/sewer.

This is an \$8.9 million project funded with federal and local funds.

- 14th Avenue complete road closure between Tacoma Street and Grand Boulevard on 8/12/22.
- Westbound travel lanes channelized, and turnout created for event on US-2 between Russell Road and Campus Drive from 8/11/22 to 8/14/22.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

CHILDREN OF THE SUN TRAIL

 The right lane of Market Street at Garland Avenue is closed for piledriving and excavating for retaining walls of the Children of the Sun Trail. The right lane closure will remain in place through May.

This project continues to expand on the current Children of the Sun Trail located along the North Spokane Corridor between Columbia and Carlisle Avenue.

I-90 MULLAN ROAD BRIDGE DECK REPLACEMENT

 Contractor crews have closed the eastbound I-90 off-ramp to Argonne Road in Spokane Valley. Drivers will need to use the Broadway interchange to the west until further notice.

This project will replace the bridge deck with a new concrete driving surface.

I-90 RAMP METER INSTALLATION

 Contractor crews have various shoulder closures anticipated on eastbound I-90 at the US 2 interchange on the eastbound US 2 on-ramp to eastbound I-90 for the installation of a ramp meter.

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER TO COLUMBIA

The single lane reductions have been removed and Euclid Avenue is now fully open.

This project will complete the Wellesley Avenue interchange, including the mainline NSC bridge over Wellesley and two ramp bridges over BNSF spur line tracks.

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPRAGUE TO SPOKANE RIVER - PHASE 1

 Work has started in the Spokane Community College parking lot at the north end near Ermina Avenue to begin excavation for bridge footings. Augusta Avenue between Ralph and Greene Street on the campus will be closed for safety concerns.

This project will construct the skyway portion of the North Spokane Corridor that traverses over Spokane Community College (Mission to Ermina Avenue).

SR 290 – SPOKANE RIVER EAST TRENT BRIDGE

 Trent Avenue is closed between Hamilton Street and North Iron Court. Detours are in place.

This project will demolish the old Trent Avenue Bridge and construct a new bridge to take its place.
