*Projects highlighted in **RED** have notable changes this week. Construction is tentative and subject to change at any time.*

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

COCHRAN BASIN STORMWATER PIPE

- Cleveland Avenue will have intermittent lane closures from C Street to T.J. Meenach Drive.

This project will install a pipe to connect stormwater from the intersection of T.J. Meenach Drive and Northwest Boulevard to the Downriver Golf Course where it will connect to the pipe being installed as part of the [Cochran Basin Stormwater Pipe through Downriver Golf Course project](#).

This is a \$3 million project funded with state and local funds.

COCHRAN BASIN TREATMENT FACILITIES

- The Downriver Disc Golf Course and the TJ Meenach watercraft access area are closed.

This project will construct treatment and infiltration ponds at the Downriver Disc Golf Course to treat stormwater generated in the Cochran Basin which includes most of north Spokane.

This is a \$4 million project funded with state and local funds.

CURE-IN-PLACE-PIPE (CIPP) SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION

- Crews are installing liners.

This project includes the installation of 13,800 linear feet cure-in-place pipe. Also, side sewer reconnections and service connection repairs.

This is a \$1.4 million project.

POST STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

- The Post Street Bridge is closed.
- The intersection of Lincoln Street and Summit Boulevard is closed.
- Post Street is closed at Spokane Falls Boulevard with local access only. Parking is limited on Post, and the Riverfront Park parking lot on Post just south of the bridge is closed.

This project will replace the Post Street Bridge and associated utilities.

This is an \$18.5 million project.

SPOKANE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT RESERVOIR

- No impacts to the traveling public are anticipated.
- Construction will be complete in 2024.

This project will construct a 3.6 million gallon drinking water reservoir near the Spokane International Airport.

This is a \$13.3 million project funded with state and local funds.

THOR-FREYA RECONSTRUCTION (HARTSON TO SPRAGUE)

- Freya Street between 3rd and Hartson Avenues is closed. Two-way traffic is detoured to Thor Street.
- Hartson Avenue is closed between Thor and Freya Streets.
- The Thor/Freya eastbound I-90 exit ramp is closed. Motorists are encouraged to exit at Altamont Street.
- 3rd Avenue is reduced to one lane at the Altamont I-90 eastbound off ramp to Lee Street.

This project will reconstruct the road, replace curb and stormwater facilities, upgrade ADA ramps, and replace water/sewer.

This is an \$8.9 million project funded with federal and local funds.

WASHINGTON BASIN STORMWATER PROJECT

- Knox Avenue between Wall and Howard Street has reopened but is gravel only. Work is complete for the season.

This project includes replacing the water and sewer lines and installing three large stormwater treatment vaults and drywells to infiltrate the treated water.

This is a \$1.5 million project.

NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Eastbound curb lane of Francis Avenue closed between Alberta and Cannon Street from 11/2/22 to 12/2/22.
- Tent Avenue between Freya Way and Greene Street will have alternating lane closures for Avista work from 11/3/22 to 12/3/22.
- A single lane closure in each direction of Riverside Avenue between Browne and Washington Street on 12/6/22.
- Avista Utilities will be working at the following locations on 12/6/22 and 12/7/22:
 - The east curb lane of Browne Street will be closed between Main and Sprague Avenue.
 - The south curb lane of Sprague Avenue will be closed between Bernard and Washington Street.
 - The west turn lane of Bernard Street will be closed between Bernard and Washington Street.
- The west curb lane of Lincoln Street will be closed between Spokane Falls Boulevard and Main Avenue from 11/14/22 to 12/8/22.
- 14th Avenue between Wall and Monroe Street will have lane closures from 11/28/22 to 12/9/22.
- The east curb lane of Washington Street between 7th and 3rd Avenue will be closed from 11/14/22 to 12/16/22.
- The east curb lane of Stevens Street between 4th and 6th Avenue will be closed from 12/5/22 to 12/16/22.
- The west curb lane of Ruby Street between Ermina and Jackson Avenue will be closed from 12/5/22 to 12/16/22.
- The east curb lane of Maple Street between Euclid and Courtland Avenue will be closed from 12/5/22 to 12/16/22.
- North and southbound curb lanes of Havana Street closed between Boone Avenue and the railroad tracks from 11/21/22 to 12/21/22 for Sefnco Communications work.

- Sefnco Communication will be working at the following locations from 11/21/22 to 12/21/22:
 - Eastbound curb lane of 37th Avenue closed between Mt. Vernon and Regal Street.
 - Westbound turn lane closed at the 37th Avenue and Regal Street intersection.
 - Southbound curb lane of Regal Street closed between Southeast Boulevard and Thurston Avenue.
- Freya Street between Liberty and Courland Avenue will have lane closures with flaggers on-site from 11/14/22 to 12/23/22.
- North Sky Communications will be working at the following intersections with flaggers on-site from 11/14/22 to 12/23/22:
 - Perry Street and 34th Avenue
 - Perry Street and 35th Avenue
- Washington Street will have curb lane closures between 8th and 7th Avenue from 11/26/22 to 12/26/22 for Sefnco Communications work.
- North and southbound Flint Road curb lanes closed between Highway 2 and Airport Drive and flagging at the Hilton Street intersection from 11/26/22 to 12/26/22 for Sefnco Communications work.
- Westbound curb lane of Highway 2 closed between Flint and Deer Heights Road from 11/27/22 to 12/27/22.
- 50% road closure on Napa Street between Desmet and Cataldo Avenue from 11/28/22 to 12/28/22.
- Eastbound curb lane of Francis Avenue closed between Myrtle and Havana Street from 12/2/22 to 1/2/23.
- Westbound curb lane of Sunset Highway will be closed between Spotted Road and Technology Boulevard from 12/5/22 to 1/5/23.
- **The westbound curb lane of Trent Avenue will be closed between Byrd and Langley Street from 12/5/22 to 1/5/22.**
- West curb lane of Stevens Street closed between Riverside and 1st Avenue from 12/16/22 to 1/16/23.

SPOKANE PARKS AND RECREATION

RIVERFRONT PARK

- **South Suspension Bridge:** The South Suspension Bridge in Riverfront Park is temporarily closed for inspection and minor repairs. We apologize for the inconvenience; please detour along the Howard Street Promenade/blue bridge. The length of temporary closure will be determined by the inspection and scope of minor repairs needed.
- **West Havermale:** The StepWell art piece is slated for opening in 2022.

DON KARDONG PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE

- The Don Kardong pedestrian bridge reconstruction project began in May, and runs through April 2023. A detour is in place. The Kardong bridge is part of the Centennial Trail near Gonzaga University, connecting the University District and surrounding area with downtown. [Read more on the Kardong bridge.](#)

SPOKANE TRANSIT AUTHORITY

CITY LINE CONSTRUCTION

- One eastbound lane of 1st Avenue between Cedar and Adams Street will be closed periodically.
- One eastbound lane of 1st Avenue between Madison and Monroe Street will be closed periodically.
- The westbound bus only lane on Sprague Avenue between Howard and Post Street will be closed periodically.
- One northbound lane of Wall Street between Sprague and Riverside Avenue will be closed.
- One eastbound lane of Main Avenue between Wall and Howard Street will be closed periodically.
- One eastbound lane of Main Avenue between Bernard and Washington Street will be closed periodically.
- Pine Street between Main Avenue and Spokane Falls Boulevard will be closed periodically in both directions.
- Spokane Falls Boulevard between Sherman and Pine Street will be closed periodically in both directions.
- Cincinnati Street between Springfield Street and the Centennial Trail will be closed periodically in both directions.
- Cincinnati Street between Desmet and Boone Avenue will be closed periodically in both directions.
- Mission Avenue between Hamilton and Superior Street will be limited to one line in each direction periodically.

ADDITIONAL WORK

- One eastbound lane of Riverside Avenue between Post and Wall Street will be periodically closed.

STREET DEPARTMENT PROJECTS

LEAF PICKUP

- The City's leaf pickup service is intended to remove only the leaves that naturally fall into the streets. **Residents *should not* rake leaves into the street.**
- A detailed neighborhood leaf pickup schedule is available [online](#). An [online map](#) will also track the progress of leaf pickup. The need for snow removal can delay this schedule.

POTHOLE CREWS

- City crews continue to fill potholes. If you see a pothole, report it by calling **3-1-1**. Potholes can also be reported online through [your MySpokane account](#). Crews focus on the largest holes on the busiest streets first. Include as much information as possible on the location and size of the pothole.

SNOW REMOVAL

- Bridge crews are working on various winter projects.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

CHILDREN OF THE SUN TRAIL

- The right lane of Market Street at Garland Avenue is closed for piledriving and excavating for retaining walls of the Children of the Sun Trail. The right lane closure will remain in place through May.

This project continues to expand on the current Children of the Sun Trail located along the North Spokane Corridor between Columbia and Carlisle Avenue.

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER TO COLUMBIA

- The single lane reductions have been removed and Euclid Avenue is now fully open.

This project will complete the Wellesley Avenue interchange, including the mainline NSC bridge over Wellesley and two ramp bridges over BNSF spur line tracks.

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPRAGUE TO SPOKANE RIVER – PHASE 1

- Work has started in the Spokane Community College parking lot at the north end near Ermina Avenue to begin excavation for bridge footings. Augusta Avenue between Ralph and Greene Street on the campus will be closed for safety concerns.

This project will construct the skyway portion of the North Spokane Corridor that traverses over Spokane Community College (Mission to Ermina Avenue).

SR 290 – SPOKANE RIVER EAST TRENT BRIDGE

- Trent Avenue is closed between Hamilton Street and North Iron Court. Detours are in place.

This project will demolish the old Trent Avenue Bridge and construct a new bridge to take its place.
