CITY OF SPOKANE OBSTRUCTION NOTICE March 15 – 22, 2024

Projects highlighted in RED have notable changes this week. Construction is tentative and subject to change at any time.

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

DRISCOLL/ALBERTA/COCHRAN SIDEWALK

- Southbound Driscoll Boulevard is closed to thru traffic between Gordan Avenue and Lindeke Street with a detour in place.
- Northwest Boulevard has lane restrictions as crews install pedestrian beacons at the Milton Avenue intersection.
- This is a moving project with single-lane closures. Please follow all traffic control signage.

This project will install new sidewalks.

This is a \$1.5 million project.

HIGH SYSTEM WATER TANK

• No impacts to traveling public are anticipated at this time.

This project will construct a 2-million-gallon elevated steel and concrete water reservoir on the Hamblen Elementary property just south of Hamblen Park.

This is a \$9.8 million project.

MARSHALL ROAD & CHENEY SPOKANE ROAD WATER TRANSMISSION MAIN - PHASE 1

• Construction begins Monday, March 18. Marshall Road south of Thorpe Road will be closed to thru traffic; residents are recommended to go south to Spokane Cheney Road for access.

Phase 1 will construct a 30-inch water transmission main to increase water transmission capacity from the existing 30-inch water main on Thorpe Rd. southward, running parallel to US Highway 195 to the existing Qualchan reservoir.

This is a \$9.9 million project.

POST STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

- The Post Street Bridge is closed. <u>See the detour routes for pedestrians and bicyclists</u>.
- The intersection of Lincoln Street and Summit Boulevard is closed.
- Post Street is closed at Spokane Falls Boulevard with local access only. Parking is limited on Post, and the Riverfront Park parking lot on Post just south of the bridge is closed.

This project will replace the Post Street Bridge and associated utilities.

This is an \$18.5 million project.

SHILOH HILLS LIFT STATION UPGRADE - NEVADA AND ST. THOMAS MOORE

• No impacts to traveling public are anticipated at this time.

This project will install new pumps and rails in an existing wet well, install a new valve vault, install new pump controls, and replacement of diesel generator with a new natural gas generator.

This is a \$780,000 project.

SOUTH GORGE TRAIL CONNECTION

• The Monroe Street Bridge will be reduced to one lane in each direction from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Wednesday, March 20, and Thursday, March 21. These lane closures are for structural steel materials placement.

This project constructs a shared-use pathway under the Monroe Street Bridge connecting Main Avenue west of Monroe Street to the existing path attached to the north side of Spokane Falls Boulevard across from the Central Library.

This is a \$2 million project.

SPOKANE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT RESERVOIR

- No impacts to the traveling public are anticipated.
- Construction will be complete in 2024.

This project will construct a 3.6-million-gallon drinking water reservoir near the Spokane International Airport.

This is a \$13.3 million project funded with state and local funds.

STREET MAINTENANCE CURB RAMPS

 Construction will start Monday, March 18 at 4th Avenue between Madelia and Altamont Street.

This project will install ADA ramps on streets which will receive a grind and overlay by the Street Department.

This is a \$500,000 project.

THORPE RESERVOIR (THORPE & TRAINOR RD)

• No traffic impacts at this time.

This project construct five MG ground level steel water reservoir.

This is a \$5.1 million project.

TJ MEENACH SIPHON VAULTS

• Work continues with no traffic impacts.

This project connects the 60" siphon to be installed with <u>TJ Meenach Street and</u> <u>Stormwater Improvements</u> to the existing 60" siphon pipe.

This is a \$3.3 million project.

CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- The eastbound lane of Strong Road will be closed between Nettleton Court and Oak Street from 1/20/24 to 3/18/24.
- Crestline Street between Rowan and Joseph Avenue will have flaggers on-site to support TDS Metrocom LLC aerial fiber work from 2/19/24 to 3/19/24.
- 8th Avenue will be closed between McClellan and Division Street from 3/19/24 to 3/20/24 for Vancouver Sign Co.
- The westbound lane of 17th Avenue closed between Cook Street and S Lincoln Park from 3/18/24 to 3/21/24 for Wesslen Construction work.
- Riverside Avenue will be closed between Wall and Howard Street from 3/21/23 at 9 p.m. to 3/22/24 at 5 a.m. for Specialty Windows Commercial to replace the glass in the skywalk.
- Carlisle Avenue between Greene and Ralph Street will be closed from 3/18/24 to 3/22/24 for Max J Kuney Co. work.

- North Sky Communications will be working at the following locations from 3/13/24 to 3/22/24.
 - The westbound curb lane of Euclid Avenue is closed between Stone and Crestline Street.
 - The westbound curb lane of North Foothills Drive is closed between Napa and Pittsburg Street.
- Thorpe Road between Trainor Road and Westwood Lane will have lane closures with flaggers on-site from 3/11/24 to 3/22/24 to support Mastec work.

 - The eastbound curb lane of North Foothills Drive is closed between Astor and Cincinnati Street.

- TDS Metrocom will be installing an underground cable crossing at Alki Avenue and Sycamore Street there will be lane closures with flaggers on-site from 3/7/24 to 4/5/24.
- Evergreen Excavating LLC will be working at the following locations from 2/26/24 to 4/10/24.
 - 3rd Avenue will have a two-lane closure between Madison and Wall Street.
 - Post Street will be closed between 2nd and 3rd Avenue.
- Flaggers will be at the intersection of Monroe Street and Euclid Avenue from 3/11/24 to 4/11/24 for Mastec work.
- Flaggers will be at Electric Avenue between Spotted Road and Geiger Boulevard from 3/11/24 to 4/11/24 for Mastec work.
- The eastbound curb lane of 4th Avenue will be closed between Washington and Bernard Street from 3/11/24 to 4/11/24 for Mastec work.

SPOKANE PARKS AND RECREATION

RIVERFRONT PARK

• The South Suspension Bridge in Riverfront Park will open to pedestrians on Friday, March 15. <u>More here</u>.

CORBIN PARK

• The park will receive a new sport court, with two dedicated pickleball courts and one tennis court. Demolition of the existing court happened over fall, with new surfacing and amenities opening in the spring.

COEUR D'ALENE PARK

• A new irrigation system is being installed February – fall 2024. The park will remain open for use, with rotating sectional closures.

STREET DEPARTMENT PROJECTS

BRIDGE WORK

• Weather permitting, bridge crews are working on the Greene Street Bridge and Freya Way Bridges. There will be lane closures.

POTHOLE CREWS

City crews continue to fill potholes as weather allows. If you see a pothole, report it by calling 3-1-1. Potholes can also be reported online through <u>your MySpokane</u> <u>account</u>. Crews focus on the largest holes on the busiest streets first. Include as much information as possible on the location and size of the pothole.

SNOW REMOVAL

• Residents are asked to park on the odd side of the street in residential areas for snow season, which runs from Nov. 15 to March 15. Please give plow operators plenty of room.

SWEEPING CREWS

• Crews are sweeping when weather permits.

ADDITIONAL WORK

• Weather permitting, our concrete crew will be working on utility repairs throughout the city.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

CHILDREN OF THE SUN TRAIL

• This project continues to expand on the current Children of the Sun Trail located along the North Spokane Corridor between Columbia and Carlisle Avenue.

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER CROSSING

- South Riverton Avenue between Ermina Avenue and Fiske Street is closed.
- This project will construct the North Spokane Corridor bridge that will cross the Spokane River and connect the skyway portion near Spokane Community College to the south and at Carslie Avenue to the north of the river.
