*Projects highlighted in **RED** have notable changes this week. Construction is tentative and subject to change at any time.*

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

9TH AND PINE BOOSTER STATION

- 9th Avenue is closed between Cowley Street and Rockwood Boulevard. Access to the Providence employee parking lot will be maintained.

This project will replace the out-of-service booster station with a modern facility.

This is a \$5.3 million project.

FREYA TRANSMISSION MAIN – GARLAND TO WELLESLEY

- Freya Street is closed between Garland and Wellesley Street. The detour is Euclid Avenue to Wellesley via Market Street.

This project replaces an aging 30-inch steel water transmission main along Freya Street with a new 30-inch ductile iron main. Work also includes reconstructing the roadway, improving sidewalks, and installing stormwater management features.

This is a \$4.7 million project.

HIGH SYSTEM WATER TANK

- There are no impacts to the traveling public.

This project will construct a 2-million-gallon elevated steel and concrete water reservoir on the Hamblen Elementary property just south of Hamblen Park.

This is a \$9.8 million project.

SPOTTED ROAD BOOSTER STATION

- Westbow Boulevard is closed at Spotted Road. Drivers on Spotted Road are not able to turn left or right onto Westbow Boulevard.

Construction of a new water booster station for the Plains Pressure Zone.

This is a \$2 million project.

THORPE RESERVOIR (THORPE & TRAINOR RD)

- Work continues with no traffic impacts.

This project construct five MG ground level steel water reservoir.

This is a \$5.1 million project.

NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- The roundabout at Sharp Avenue and Cincinnati Street will have flaggers with intermittent stops from 3/3/25 to 3/14/25 for Avista Utilities work.
- The north curb lane of 3rd Avenue will be closed between Washington and McClellan Street from 3/3/25 to 3/14/25 for Avista Utilities work.
- Napa Street will have lane reductions with flaggers on-site between Cataldo and Desmet Avenue from 3/3/25 to 3/14/25 for Avista Utilities work.
- Mastec North America will be working at the following locations from 2/10/25 to 3/14/25.
 - The west curb lane of Lincoln Street will be closed between Riverside and Main Avenue.
 - The eastbound curb lane of Main Avenue will be closed between Monroe and Lincoln Street.
- The southbound curb lane of Crestline Street will be closed between Houghton and Weile Avenue from 2/10/25 to 3/14/25 for Mastec North America fiber work.
- Both curb lanes of Lincoln Road will be closed between Division and Standard Street from 2/10/25 to 3/14/25 for Mastec North America work.
- The westbound curb lane of Francis Avenue will be closed between Howard and Wall Street from 2/17/25 to 3/17/25 for Mastec North America fiber work.
- The northbound curb lane of Grand Boulevard will be closed between 31st and 33rd Avenue from 2/17/25 to 3/17/25 for Mastec North America work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 1/20/25 to 3/14/25.
 - The eastbound curb lane of Northwest Boulevard will be closed between Buckeye Avenue and Cannon Street.
 - Belt Street will have alternating lane closures between York Avenue and Northwest Boulevard.
 - Flaggers will be at the intersection of Belt Street and Northwest Boulevard.
- **Cameron-Reily will be working at the following locations on 3/24/25.**
 - **The eastbound curb lane of Sprague Avenue will be closed between Rebecca and Myrtle Street.**
 - **The southbound and northbound curb lanes of Havana Street will be closed between Ferry and Sprague Avenue.**

- Hydromax USA LLC will be working in the following 5-mile areas 3/10/25 to 3/24/25.
 - Flagging at cross-intersections of W Strong Rd between N Cannon St and N Palm Pl
 - Lane closure on EB W Strong Rd between N Elm St and N Oak St
 - Lane closure on W Strong Rd between N Palm Pl and N Summerhill Ln
 - Flagging at intersection of W Strong Rd and N Cedar Rd
- Alternating lane closures on Strong Road between Elm Street and Panorama Drive from 3/10/25 to 3/24/25 for Hydromax USA work.
- Southeast Boulevard will be reduced to one lane with flagger son 3/25/25 for tree trimming by A1 Tree Service.
- The northbound curb lane of Assembly Street will be closed between Sanson Avenue and Bismark Place from 3/12/25 to 3/28/25 for North Sky Communications to install fiber.
- Assembly Street will have a northbound lane shift between Everett and Olympic Avenue from 2/28/25 to 3/28/25 for Mastec North America fiber installation.
- Freya Street will be reduced to one lane with flaggers between Garland and Rich Avenue from 2/26/25 to 3/28/25 for Avista Utilities to replace a gas main.
- The northbound curb lane of Assembly Street will be closed between Crown and Sanson Avenue with flaggers on-site from 2/17/25 to 3/28/25 for North Sky Communications work.
- Fatbeam LLC will be working at the following locations from 3/1/25 to 3/29/25.
 - The south curb lane of Spokane Falls Boulevard will be closed between Division and Bernard Street.
 - The east curb lane of Browne Street will be closed between Spokane Falls Boulevard and Riverside Avenue
 - Main Avenue will be reduced to one lane between Bernard and Browne Street.
- The northbound curb lane of Indian Trail Road between Woodside and Weile Avenue from 3/17/15 to 3/31/25 for Hydromax work.
- The southbound curb lane of Crestline Street will be closed between Houghton and Weile Avenue from 2/10/25 to 3/31/25 for Mastec North America fiber work.
- Southbound Sherman Street will have a lane closure between 3rd and Hartson Avenue from 3/3/25 to 4/4/25 for Mastec North America work.
- Mastec North America will be working at the following locations from 3/4/25 to 4/4/25.
 - Browne Street will be reduced to one lane in either direction between 3rd and 7th Avenue. Flaggers will be onsite.
 - 5th Avenue will be reduced to one lane between Washington and Division Street with flaggers onsite.

- Mastec North America will be working at the following locations from 3/5/25 to 4/5/25.
 - The northbound curb lane of Assembly Street will be closed between Gustavus Street and Wellesley Avenue.
 - The southbound curb lane of Assembly Street will be closed between Olympic and Wellesley Avenue.
 - Flaggers at the intersection of Assembly Street and Wellesley Avenue.
- Post Street will be closed between Spokane Falls Boulevard and Summit Parkway from 3/24/25 to 4/8/25 for Washington Equip MFG Co Inc. work.
- Magnesium Road will be reduced to one lane with flaggers between Standard and Nevada Street from 3/13/25 to 4/13/25 for Mastec North America to perform aerial fiber work.
- Mastec North America will be installing underground fiber on A Street, Alberta Street, Belt Street, Broad Avenue, and Wellesley Avenue from 2/17/25 to 4/14/25.
- North Sky Communications LLC will be installing ariel fiber and will have lane closures in the following areas from 3/18/25 to 4/17/25.
 - Southbound Lincoln Street between 21st and 24th Avenue
 - Northbound Lincoln Street closed between 25th to 24th Avenue
 - Northbound Lincoln Street closed between 21st and 20th Avenue
- Southbound Driscoll Boulevard closed between Providence and Gordon Avenue from 2/17/25 to 4/17/25 for TDS Metrocom work.
- Mastec North America will be working at the following locations from 2/10/25 to 4/18/25.
 - The west curb lane of Lincoln Street will be closed between Riverside and Main Avenue.
 - The eastbound curb lane of Main Avenue will be closed between Monroe and Lincoln Street.
- The westbound lane of Strong Road will be closed between Maple and Elm Street from 3/24/25 to 4/23/25 for NPL Construction work.
- Mastec North America Inc will be performing utility installation in the following areas from 3/25/25 to 4/28/25.
 - The northbound curb lane of Nevada Street between Holland Avenue and Northpoint Access Lane.
 - The eastbound curb lane of Holland Avenue closed between Dakota and Nevada Street.
 - The westbound curb lane of Holland Avenue closed between Northpointe Access Lane and Colton Street.
 - The eastbound curb lane of Holland Street closed between U.S. 2 and Colton Street.

- Mastec North America will be working at the following locations from 1/20/25 to **4/30/25**.
 - The eastbound lane of Sharp Avenue will be closed with flaggers on-site between Post and Howard Street.
 - The northbound curb lane of Lincoln Street/Post Place will be closed with flaggers on-site between Mallon and Spofford Avenue.
 - The center lane of Maxwell Avenue will be closed with flaggers on-site between Lincoln and Wall Street.
- Post Street is closed between Riverside and Sprague Avenue from 1/6/25 to March 2026 for the Peyton Building remodel.

COEUR D'ALENE PARK

- A new irrigation system is being installed February – spring 2025. The park will remain open for use, with rotating sectional closures.

POTHOLE CREWS

Crews focus on the largest holes on the busiest streets first. Include as much information as possible on the location and size of the pothole.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

CHILDREN OF THE SUN TRAIL

- The Garland Bridge reopened as of Friday, Oct. 15. Minor work remains on the trail.

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER CROSSING

- Upriver Drive between Greene and Ralph Street will be one lane with flaggers from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Intermittent work on Saturday from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. is possible.
- Riverton Avenue between Ermina Avenue and Fiske Street is closed.
- The Spokane River is closed at the Greene Street Bridge.

This project will construct the North Spokane Corridor bridge that will cross the Spokane River and connect the skyway portion near Spokane Community College to the south and at Carslie Avenue to the north of the river.
