Projects highlighted in RED have notable changes this week. Construction is tentative and subject to change at any time.

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

9TH AND PINE BOOSTER STATION

• There are no street closures. However, construction vehicles use 9th Avenue to access the off-street construction site for the remainder of the construction.

This project will replace the out-of-service booster station with a modern facility.

This is a \$5.3 million project.

ADAPTIVE DESIGN TRAFFIC CALMING (SPOKANE SAFE STREETS FOR ALL)

- This project will start Monday, Oct. 6. Crews will be working at the following locations.
 - o Belt Street will have lane closures between Garland and Wellesley Avenues.
 - Riverside Avenue and Walnut Street
 - Boone Avenue and Chestnut Street
 - Boone Avenue and Belt Street

All three districts will receive traffic calming improvements. Improvement projects will include bike lanes, shared-use pathways, stairway and crosswalk improvements, ADA ramps, and several other safety and mobility projects for non-motorized users.

This is a \$2.8 million project.

DESMET & SUPERIOR SEWER REROUTE

The Centennial Trail is closed between Sharp Avenue and Superior Street.

This project replaces a damaged 10-inch sewer line near the intersection of Desmet Avenue and Superior Street. The existing pipe has deteriorated due to settlement and hydrogen sulfide damage, requiring full replacement. Work involves crossing the BNSF railroad and the Centennial Trail to connect to an existing siphon vault.

This is a \$1 million project.

FRANCIS & ASSEMBLY WATER

- Work has resumed. Here is what to expect.
 - o Nine Mile Road has lane restrictions from Royal Drive to Wind River Drive.
 - Lyons Avenue, Woodside Avenue, and Rifle Club Road will have some closures during this work. Motorists will be detoured to adjacent streets during the closure.
 - o The sidewalk on Nine Mile Road will be closed to pedestrian traffic.
 - A noise variance is in place to allow work to be done between the hours of 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday through Saturday.

This is the first phase of a larger initiative to enhance water, sewer, stormwater, and traffic infrastructure in the Northwest Terrace area. Phase One involves installing a new water transmission main from the Low Water Pressure System to the NW Terrace Water Pressure System, improving domestic water reliability and supporting future growth.

This is a \$3.2 million project.

FREYA STREET WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT (21ST TO 13TH)

• Freya Street is closed between 21st and 13th Avenues. Motorists are detoured to Hartson Avenue to Ray Street, to 29th Avenue. Local access is being maintained.

This project replaces approximately 3,050 feet of 8-inch cast iron water main with a 12-inch ductile iron main. Work also includes roadway repairs (not full-width, just the half where the water main is being replaced), ADA-compliant curb ramps, and coordination with utilities to minimize service disruptions.

This is a \$3.7 million project.

HIGH SYSTEM WATER TANK

There are no impacts to the traveling public.

This project will construct a 2-million-gallon elevated steel and concrete water reservoir on the Hamblen Elementary property just south of Hamblen Park.

This is a \$9.8 million project.

LINCOLN STREET – SUMMIT TO SINTO PEDESTRIAN AND BIKE SAFETY

- The intersection of Lincoln Street and Broadway Avenue is closed. Lincoln Street is closed for construction from Sinto Avenue to Summit Parkway, local traffic only. Businesses remain open.
- Crews are working on Lincoln Street south of Mallon Avenue to Summit Parkway. Local access only.
- Anthony's is open, and access is available off Summit Parkway.

This project enhances bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure along Lincoln Street from Summit Parkway to Sinto Avenue. Improvements include buffered and protected bike lanes, widened sidewalks, a grind-and-overlay from Summit to Boone, and a new signal at Lincoln/Broadway.

This is a \$2.6 million project.

LOCAL ACCESS GRIND & OVERLAY

- Crews are working at the following locations
 - o Elm Street from Central to Francis Avenues

Several streets will undergo grind and overlay (milling and resurfacing) in the upcoming construction season. These improvements target areas with deteriorated asphalt, enhancing ride quality and extending pavement life.

This is a \$1.5 million project.

MAPLE-WALNUT GRIND & OVERLAY - 5TH TO MAPLE STREET BRIDGE

• The curb lanes of Walnut Street are closed between 2nd and 5th Avenues. Crews are installing ADA ramps and electrical.

This project rehabilitates Maple and Walnut Streets from 5th Avenue to the south approach of the Maple Street Bridge. Improvements include a grind and overlay of existing pavement, curb ramp upgrades to meet ADA standards, and a sidewalk widening near an overhead traffic sign pole on Maple Street.

This is a \$2 million project.

MAXWELL AVENUE – PETTET TO WALNUT BIKE/PEDESTRIAN SAFETY UPGRADES

Work is almost complete! Crews are working on punchlist items.

This project enhances bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure along Maxwell Avenue from Pettet Drive to Walnut Street. Improvements include new sidewalks, buffered bike lanes, and crosswalk enhancements to better connect the West Central Neighborhood with A.M. Cannon Park, the West Central Community Center, and the Centennial Trail.

This is a \$1.2 million project.

REHABILITATION OF CSO FACILITIES

- Crews are working at CSO 34-2 at Underhill Park. There are no impacts to the traveling public. The Underhill Park parking lot is closed for this work.
- Crews are working on CSO 34-3 on Ray Street between 20th and 21st Avenues. There are no impacts on the traveling public.

Rehabilitation of the following combined sewer overflow (CSO) tanks; CSO 10, CSO 34-2, and CSO 34-3.

This is a \$1.2 million project.

ROCKWOOD BOULEVARD GRIND AND OVERLAY (GRAND BLVD. TO COWLEY ST.)

- Crews are working in the following areas.
 - Rockwood Boulevard has lane restrictions between Grand Boulevard and Cowley Street.
 - o 10th Avenue and Sumner Avenue are closed at Rockwood Boulevard.
 - o 9th Avenue is temporarily a two-way street.

This project provides a 2-inch grind and overlay along Rockwood Boulevard, from Grand Boulevard to Cowley Street, and redesigns the Rockwood/Cowley & 10th Avenue intersection. It also replaces outdated water mains, a crushed sewer main segment, and brick catch basins within the project limits.

This is a \$640,000 project.

SPOTTED ROAD BOOSTER STATION

• There are no traffic impacts.

Construction of a new water booster station for the Plains Pressure Zone.

This is a \$2 million project.

SPRAGUE & ALKI-BROADWAY - FREYA TO HAVANA GRIND AND OVERLAY

Broadway Avenue/Alki Way from Havana to Freya Streets is closed.

This project rehabilitates portions of Sprague Avenue and Alki-Broadway Avenue with a 2-inch grind and overlay. It also includes ADA ramp upgrades and selected stormwater improvements, extending pavement life and enhancing road safety.

This is a \$1.9 million project.

NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Burlington Northern Railroad will be working at the following locations on 10/3/25.
 - The north curb lane on 2nd Avenue will be closed between Walnut and Maple Streets.
 - The east and west curb lanes of Maple Street will be closed between 1st and 2nd
 Avenues.
- There will be eastbound and westbound lane closures on 3rd Avenue between Sunset Boulevard and Ash Street for a bridge inspection by Burlington Northern Railroad on 10/3/25.
- Greene Street between Illinois Avenue and Market Street will have lane closures for a bridge inspection by Burlington Northern Railroad on 10/3/25.
- Napa Street between Trent and Main Avenues will have lane closures for a bridge inspection by Burlington Northern Railroad on 10/3/25.
- Burlington Northern Railroad will be working at the following locations on 10/3/25.
 - The northbound lane of Napa Street between Trent and Main Avenues will be closed.
 - The southbound lane of Napa Street between Trent and Springfield Avenues will be closed

- Inland Asphalt Co will be working in the following areas from 7/28/25 to 10/3/25.
 - The east curb lane of Ash Street will be closed between York and Mansfield Avenues.
 - The east curb lane closure on Ash Street will be closed between Sinto and Dean Avenues.

- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 9/8/25 to 10/6/25.
 - Westbound lane closure on Wellesley Avenue between Division and Whitehouse Streets.
 - Westbound lane closure on Wellesley Avenue between Monroe and Madison Streets.
 - Eastbound lane closure on Wellesley Avenue between Jefferson and Monroe Streets.
 - Northbound lane closure on Monroe Street between Fredrick and Dalton Avenues.
- Mastec North America will be working in the following areas from 8/8/25 to 10/8/25.
 - Alternating lane closures on Stevens Street between 7th Avenue and Ben Garnett Way.
 - Southbound lane closures on 9th Avenue between Stevens Street and Ben Garnett Way.
- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 9/12/25 to 10/10/25.
 - Strong Road will have moving lane closures between Five Mile Road and Oak Street.
 - Austin Road will have moving lane closures between Strong Road and Cascade Way.
- The northbound curb lane of Country Homes Boulevard will be closed between Five Mile Road and Wedgewood Avenue from 8/18/25 to 10/15/25 for Spokane County work.
- TDS Metrocom LLC will be installing underground and aerial fiber optic lines in the area bounded by N A Street to N Belt Street and W Longfellow Avenue and W Garland Avenue from 5/19/25 to 10/15/25.
- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 8/18/25 to 10/16/25.
 - Both curb lanes of Wellesley Avenue will be closed between Whitehouse and Wall Streets with flaggers on-site.
 - Flaggers on Garland Avenue and Whitehouse Street intersection.
- TDS Metrocom LLC will be working at the following locations from 8/18/25 to 10/16/25.
 - Southbound lane closure on Division Street between Columbia and Nebraska Avenues.
 - Northbound lane closures on Division Street between Rowan and Central Avenues.

 - Eastbound lane closure on Queen Avenue between Howard and Division Streets.

- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 8/25/25 to 10/23/25.
 - Maple Street lane closure between Wellesley and Euclid Avenues.
 - Westbound Garland Avenue lane closure between Maple and Division Streets.
 - o Northbound Monroe Street lane closure between Garland and Wellesley Avenues.
 - Northbound Wall Street between Garland and Wellesley Avenues.
 - Westbound Wellesley Ave between Maple and N Division Streets.

- 6th Avenue between Maple and Walnut Streets will be closed from 8/4/25 to 11/4/25 for Halme Construction work.
- Mastec North America will be working in the following areas from 7/21/25 to 11/21/25.
 - The northbound curb lane of Cowley Street will be closed between Hartson and 4th
 Avenues
 - The eastbound curb lane of 4th/5th Avenues will be closed between Cowley to Sherman Streets.

- Palouse Power will be working in the following areas from 9/22/25 to 11/26/25.
 - The south curb lane of Spokane Falls Boulevard will be closed between Lincoln and Monroe Streets.
 - The east curb lane of Monroe Street will be closed between Main and Sprague Avenues.
- Big Sky ID Corp will be working in the following area from 8/4/25 to 11/30/25.
 - o Garland Avenue will be closed between Greene and N Freya Streets.
 - Freya Street will be reduced to one lane with flaggers between Rich and Rockwell Avenues.
- Post Street is closed between Riverside and Sprague Avenue from 1/6/25 to March 2026 for the Peyton Building remodel.

- Crews will be working on mud boils and utility cuts.

- On Tuesday, Oct. 17, crews are scheduled to have two fog seal projects. There will be flaggers, lane closures, and some street closures.

WASTEWATER DEPARTMENT

LINCOLN STREET, 19TH TO 29TH AVENUES

Wastewater crews are rehabilitating swale plantings along Lincoln Street between 19th Avenue and 29th Avenue. Flaggers are on-site to direct vehicle traffic when necessary. Traffic delays can be expected when flagging is necessary. Alternate routes include High Drive and Bernard Street.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER CROSSING

- Riverton Avenue between Ermina Avenue and Fiske Street is closed.
- The Spokane River is closed at the Greene Street Bridge.
- Northbound Greene Street is closed between Mission and Ermina Avenues until Monday, Oct. 6. Detour is signed via Mission Avenue to Perry Street, back to North Foothills Drive, and Euclid Avenue.
- Carlisle Avenue between Greene and Ralph Streets is closed.

This project will construct the North Spokane Corridor bridge that will cross the Spokane River and connect the skyway portion near Spokane Community College to the south and at Carslie Avenue to the north of the river.
