#### **CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

# **9<sup>TH</sup> AND PINE BOOSTER STATION**

• There are no street closures. However, construction vehicles use 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue to access the off-street construction site for the remainder of the construction.

This project will replace the out-of-service booster station with a modern facility.

This is a \$5.3 million project.

### ADAPTIVE DESIGN TRAFFIC CALMING (SPOKANE SAFE STREETS FOR ALL)

- Crews are working at the following locations.
  - o Belt Street between Garland and Wellesley Avenues
  - Riverside Avenue from Monroe to Division Streets
  - Riverside Avenue from Maple to Cedar Streets
  - Chestnut/Elms Street Greenway
  - 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Helena to Pittsburg Streets
  - Bernard Street from 19<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> Avenues
  - Farmdale Street and Shawnee Avenue
  - Barnes Road from Farmdale to Seminole Streets
  - Strong Road from Austin Road to Nettleton Court

All three districts will receive traffic calming improvements. Improvement projects will include bike lanes, shared-use pathways, stairway and crosswalk improvements, ADA ramps, and several other safety and mobility projects for non-motorized users.

This is a \$2.8 million project.

#### **DESMET & SUPERIOR SEWER REROUTE**

Centennial Trail has reopened between Sharp Avenue and Superior Street.

This project replaces a damaged 10-inch sewer line near the intersection of Desmet Avenue and Superior Street. The existing pipe has deteriorated due to settlement and hydrogen sulfide damage, requiring full replacement. Work involves crossing the BNSF railroad and the Centennial Trail to connect to an existing siphon vault.

This is a \$1 million project.

#### FRANCIS & ASSEMBLY WATER

- Here is what to expect.
  - o Nine Mile Road is open with one lane in each direction.
  - Rifle Club Road is closed at Old Fort Drive.

This is the first phase of a larger initiative to enhance water, sewer, stormwater, and traffic infrastructure in the Northwest Terrace area. Phase One involves installing a new water transmission main from the Low Water Pressure System to the NW Terrace Water Pressure System, improving domestic water reliability and supporting future growth.

This is a \$3.2 million project.

### FREYA STREET WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT (21<sup>ST</sup> TO 13<sup>TH</sup>)

• Freya Street is closed between 21<sup>st</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> Avenues. Motorists are detoured to Hartson Avenue to Ray Street, to 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Local access is being maintained.

This project replaces approximately 3,050 feet of 8-inch cast iron water main with a 12-inch ductile iron main. Work also includes roadway repairs (not full-width, just the half where the water main is being replaced), ADA-compliant curb ramps, and coordination with utilities to minimize service disruptions.

This is a \$3.7 million project.

#### **HIGH SYSTEM WATER TANK**

There are no impacts to the traveling public.

This project will construct a 2-million-gallon elevated steel and concrete water reservoir on the Hamblen Elementary property just south of Hamblen Park.

This is a \$9.8 million project.

#### LINCOLN STREET – SUMMIT TO SINTO PEDESTRIAN AND BIKE SAFETY

- The intersection of Lincoln Street and Broadway Avenue is closed. Lincoln Street is closed for construction from Sinto Avenue to Summit Parkway, local traffic only. Businesses remain open.
- Crews are working on Lincoln Street south of Mallon Avenue to Summit Parkway. Local access only.
- Anthony's is open, and access is available off Summit Parkway.

This project enhances bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure along Lincoln Street from Summit Parkway to Sinto Avenue. Improvements include buffered and protected bike lanes, widened sidewalks, a grind-and-overlay from Summit to Boone, and a new signal at Lincoln/Broadway.

This is a \$2.6 million project.

# **LOCAL ACCESS GRIND & OVERLAY**

• This project is substantially complete; crews are working on punchlist items.

Several streets will undergo grind and overlay (milling and resurfacing) in the upcoming construction season. These improvements target areas with deteriorated asphalt, enhancing ride quality and extending pavement life.

This is a \$1.5 million project.

#### MAXWELL AVENUE – PETTET TO WALNUT BIKE/PEDESTRIAN SAFETY UPGRADES

- Crews are working on punchlist items.
- Lane restrictions will be in place, Thursday, Oct. 30, to finish striping; this work is weatherdependent.

This project enhances bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure along Maxwell Avenue from Pettet Drive to Walnut Street. Improvements include new sidewalks, buffered bike lanes, and crosswalk enhancements to better connect the West Central Neighborhood with A.M. Cannon Park, the West Central Community Center, and the Centennial Trail.

This is a \$1.2 million project.

#### ROCKWOOD BOULEVARD GRIND AND OVERLAY (GRAND BLVD. TO COWLEY ST.)

• This project is substantially complete. Crews are working on punchlist items.

This project provides a 2-inch grind and overlay along Rockwood Boulevard, from Grand Boulevard to Cowley Street, and redesigns the Rockwood/Cowley & 10th Avenue intersection. It also replaces outdated water mains, a crushed sewer main segment, and brick catch basins within the project limits.

This is a \$640,000 project.

#### **SPOTTED ROAD BOOSTER STATION**

• There are no traffic impacts.

Construction of a new water booster station for the Plains Pressure Zone.

This is a \$2 million project.

#### **NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS**

- North Sky Communications will be working in the following areas from 10/20/25 to 10/24/25.
  - Westbound lane closure on Holland Avenue between Nevada and Dakota Streets.
  - Eastbound lane closure on Holland Avenue between Northpointe Access Lane and Nevada Street.

- LTS Managed Technical Services LLC will be working at the following locations from 10/1/25 to 11/1/25.
  - o Westbound lane closure on 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Freya and Greene Streets.
  - Westbound lane closure on Hartson Avenue between Freya and Fiske Streets.

- Southbound Ray Street will have a lane closure between 15<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Avenues from 10/1/25 to 11/1/25 for LTS Managed Technical Services LLC work.
- Southbound Thor Street will have a lane closure between 11<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Avenues from 10/1/25 to 11/1/25 for LTS Managed Technical Services LLC work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 10/3/25 to 11/2/25.
  - Division Street/Ruby Street will have a lane closure between North Foothills Drive and Dalton Avenue.
  - North Foothills Drive will have a lane closure between Ruby and Nevada Streets.
- Northbound Assembly Street will be shifted to the center lane between Olympic and Sanson Avenues from 10/3/25 to 11/3/25 for Mastec North America work.
- Northbound lane closure on Altamont Street between Altamont Boulevard and Hartson Avenue from 10/6/25 to 11/4/25 for LTS Managed Technical Services LLC.

  - o Lane closure on Lidgerwood Street between Francis and Central Avenues.

  - The southbound curb lane of Nevada Street will be closed between Broad and Wellesley Avenue.
  - Northbound lane closure on Crestline Street between Longfellow and Hoffman Avenues.
- Big Sky ID Corp will be working in the following area from 8/4/25 to 11/30/25.
  - o Garland Avenue will be closed between Greene and N Freya Streets.
  - Freya Street will be reduced to one lane with flaggers between Rich and Rockwell Avenues.
- First Avenue will be closed between Stevens and Washington Street for Corridor Contractors work from 10/27/25 to 10/31/25.
- Mastec North America will be working in the following locations from 11/1/25 to 12/1/25.
  - Eastbound Trent Avenue will be reduced to one lane with flaggers between Fiske and Ralph Streets.
  - Westbound Trent Avenue will be reduced to one lane with flaggers between Thor and Ralph Streets.
- Post Street is closed between Riverside and Sprague Avenue from 1/6/25 to March 2026 for the Peyton Building remodel.

- On Wednesday, Oct. 29, crews will be doing sidewalk work at the intersection of Maple Street and Francis Avenue. The northbound curb lane of Maple Street and the westbound curb lane of Francis Avenue will be closed.

#### NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER CROSSING

- The curb lane of northbound Greene Street is closed between Mission and Ermina Avenues.
- Carlisle Avenue between Greene and Ralph Streets is closed.
- Upriver Drive at Ralph Street will be flagged to accommodate overhead work.
- Ralph Street is closed between Grace and Carlisle Avenues.
