*Projects highlighted in **RED** have notable changes this week. Construction is tentative and subject to change at any time.*

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

9TH AND PINE BOOSTER STATION

- There are no street closures. However, construction vehicles use 9th Avenue to access the off-street construction site for the remainder of the construction.

This project will replace the out-of-service booster station with a modern facility.

This is a \$5.3 million project.

ADAPTIVE DESIGN TRAFFIC CALMING (SPOKANE SAFE STREETS FOR ALL)

- Crews are working at the following locations.
 - Belt Street between Garland and Wellesley Avenues
 - Riverside Avenue from Monroe to Division Streets
 - Riverside Avenue from Maple to Cedar Streets
 - Chestnut/Elms Street Greenway
 - 9th Avenue from Helena to Pittsburg Streets
 - Bernard Street from 19th to 27th Avenues
 - Farmdale Street and Shawnee Avenue
 - Barnes Road from Farmdale to Seminole Streets
 - Strong Road from Austin Road to Nettleton Court

All three districts will receive traffic calming improvements. Improvement projects will include bike lanes, shared-use pathways, stairway and crosswalk improvements, ADA ramps, and several other safety and mobility projects for non-motorized users.

This is a \$2.8 million project.

DESMET & SUPERIOR SEWER REROUTE

- Project is complete until next year.

This project replaces a damaged 10-inch sewer line near the intersection of Desmet Avenue and Superior Street. The existing pipe has deteriorated due to settlement and hydrogen sulfide damage, requiring full replacement. Work involves crossing the BNSF railroad and the Centennial Trail to connect to an existing siphon vault.

This is a \$1 million project.

FRANCIS & ASSEMBLY WATER

- Here is what to expect.
 - Nine Mile Road is open with one lane in each direction.
 - Rifle Club Road is closed at Old Fort Drive.

This is the first phase of a larger initiative to enhance water, sewer, stormwater, and traffic infrastructure in the Northwest Terrace area. Phase One involves installing a new water transmission main from the Low Water Pressure System to the NW Terrace Water Pressure System, improving domestic water reliability and supporting future growth.

This is a \$3.2 million project.

FREYA STREET WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT (21ST TO 13TH)

- Freya Street is closed between 21st and 13th Avenues. Motorists are detoured to Hartson Avenue to Ray Street, to 29th Avenue. Local access is being maintained.
- Paving is scheduled for the week of Monday, Nov. 3.

This project replaces approximately 3,050 feet of 8-inch cast iron water main with a 12-inch ductile iron main. Work also includes roadway repairs (not full-width, just the half where the water main is being replaced), ADA-compliant curb ramps, and coordination with utilities to minimize service disruptions.

This is a \$3.7 million project.

HIGH SYSTEM WATER TANK

- There are no impacts to the traveling public.

This project will construct a 2-million-gallon elevated steel and concrete water reservoir on the Hamblen Elementary property just south of Hamblen Park.

This is a \$9.8 million project.

LINCOLN STREET – SUMMIT TO SINTO PEDESTRIAN AND BIKE SAFETY

- The intersection of Lincoln Street and Broadway Avenue is closed. Lincoln Street is closed for construction from Sinto Avenue to Summit Parkway, local traffic only. Businesses remain open.
- Crews are working on Lincoln Street south of Mallon Avenue to Summit Parkway. Local access only.
- Anthony's is open, and access is available off Summit Parkway.

This project enhances bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure along Lincoln Street from Summit Parkway to Sinto Avenue. Improvements include buffered and protected bike lanes, widened sidewalks, a grind-and-overlay from Summit to Boone, and a new signal at Lincoln/Broadway.

This is a \$2.6 million project.

MAXWELL AVENUE – PETTET TO WALNUT BIKE/PEDESTRIAN SAFETY UPGRADES

- Crews are finishing up striping.

This project enhances bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure along Maxwell Avenue from Pettet Drive to Walnut Street. Improvements include new sidewalks, buffered bike lanes, and crosswalk enhancements to better connect the West Central Neighborhood with A.M. Cannon Park, the West Central Community Center, and the Centennial Trail.

This is a \$1.2 million project.

SPOTTED ROAD BOOSTER STATION

- There are no traffic impacts.

Construction of a new water booster station for the Plains Pressure Zone.

This is a \$2 million project.

NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- The westbound curb lane of Sunset Boulevard will be closed between Elm and Cannon Streets for Cameron-Reilly work from 10/20/25 to 10/31/25.
- North Sky Communications will be working in the following areas from 10/20/25 to 10/31/25.
 - Westbound lane closure on Holland Avenue between Nevada and Dakota Streets.
 - Eastbound lane closure on Holland Avenue between Northpointe Access Lane and Nevada Street.

- North Sky Communications will be working at the following locations from 10/31/25 to 6/20/25.
 - Pacific Avenue will be closed between Haven and Fiske Street.
 - 3rd Avenue reduced to one lane between Fiske and Greene Street.
 - The south curb lane of 2nd Avenue will be closed between Ralph and Ray Street.
 - The north curb lane of 3rd Avenue will be closed between Freya and Rebecca Street.
- LTS Managed Technical Services LLC will be working at the following locations from 10/1/25 to 11/1/25.
 - Westbound lane closure on 5th Avenue between Freya and Greene Streets.
 - Westbound lane closure on Hartson Avenue between Freya and Fiske Streets.
- Southbound Ray Street will have a lane closure between 15th and 12th Avenues from 10/1/25 to 11/1/25 for LTS Managed Technical Services LLC work.
- Southbound Thor Street will have a lane closure between 11th to 8th Avenues from 10/1/25 to 11/1/25 for LTS Managed Technical Services LLC work.
- Northbound Assembly Street will be shifted to the center lane between Olympic and Sanson Avenues from 10/3/25 to 11/3/25 for Mastec North America work.
- Northbound lane closure on Altamont Street between Altamont Boulevard and Hartson Avenue from 10/6/25 to 11/4/25 for LTS Managed Technical Services LLC.
- 6th Avenue between Maple and Walnut Streets will be closed from 8/4/25 to 11/4/25 for Halme Construction work.
- The eastbound lane of 5th Avenue will be closed between Howard and Stevens Streets from 9/17/25 to 11/7/25 for Zero DB Communications work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 9/12/25 to 11/10/25.
 - Strong Road will have moving lane closures between Five Mile Road and Oak Street.
 - Austin Road will have moving lane closures between Strong Road and Cascade Way.
- Westbound Lyons Avenue will have a lane closure between Napa and Perry Street from 10/13/25 to 11/13/25 for Mastec North America work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 9/8/25 to 11/15/25.
 - Westbound lane closure on Wellesley Avenue between Division and Whitehouse Streets.
 - Westbound lane closure on Wellesley Avenue between Monroe and Madison Streets.
 - Eastbound lane closure on Wellesley Avenue between Jefferson and Monroe Streets.
 - Northbound lane closure on Monroe Street between Fredrick and Dalton Avenues.

- Mastec North America will be working in the following areas from 10/17/25 to 11/17/25.
 - Garland Avenue will have westbound and eastbound curb lane closures between Oak and Maple Streets.
 - The west curb lane of Ash Street will be closed between Walton and Providence Avenues.
- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 9/19/25 to 11/17/25.
 - Nevada Street will have intermittent lane closures between Queen and Wellesley Avenues.
 - The center lane of Lidgerwood Street will be closed between Queen and Wellesley Avenues.
- Mastec North America will be working in the following areas from 10/12/25 to 11/18/25.
 - Hawthorne Road will have eastbound and westbound closures between Andrew Street and Northpointe Access Lane.
 - Southbound lane closure on Newport Highway between Eaton Avenue and Elm Street.
- Mastec North America will be working in the following areas from 10/20/25 to 11/20/25.
 - Crestline Street between Rich and Wabash Streets will have lane closures with flaggers.
 - Wellesley Avenue between Pittsburg and Lacey Streets will have lane closures with flaggers.
- Mastec North America will be working in the following areas from 7/21/25 to 11/21/25.
 - The northbound curb lane of Cowley Street will be closed between Hartson and 4th Avenues.
 - The eastbound curb lane of 4th/5th Avenues will be closed between Cowley to Sherman Streets.
- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 9/26/25 to 11/23/25.
 - Northbound Nevada Street lane closure between Heroy and Princeton Avenues.
 - Northbound and southbound lane closures on Perry Street between Heroy and Princeton Avenues.
- Palouse Power will be working in the following areas from 9/22/25 to 11/26/25.
 - The south curb lane of Spokane Falls Boulevard will be closed between Lincoln and Monroe Streets.
 - The east curb lane of Monroe Street will be closed between Main and Sprague Avenues.
- Mastec North America will be working in the following areas from 8/25/25 to 11/26/25.
 - The south curb lane of 3rd Avenue will be closed between Conklin and Arthur Streets.
 - The eastbound curb lane of Arthur Street will be closed between 3rd and 2nd Avenues.
 - Flaggers at the intersection of Arthur Street and 3rd Avenue.

- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 9/30/25 to 11/29/25.
 - Eastbound lane closure on Queen Avenue between Division and Mayfair Streets.
 - Southbound lane closures on Addison Street between Crown and Wabash Avenues.
 - The eastbound and westbound curb lanes of Wellesley Avenue between Standard and Nevada Streets.
 - The southbound curb lane of Nevada Street will be closed between Broad and Wellesley Avenue.
 - Northbound lane closure on Crestline Street between Longfellow and Hoffman Avenues.
- Big Sky ID Corp will be working in the following area from 8/4/25 to 11/30/25.
 - Garland Avenue will be closed between Greene and N Freya Streets.
 - Freya Street will be reduced to one lane with flaggers between Rich and Rockwell Avenues.
- First Avenue will be closed between Stevens and Washington Street for Corridor Contractors work from 10/27/25 to 10/31/25.
- LTS Managed Technical SRVS LLC will be working in the following locations from 11/1/25 to 12/1/25.
 - Northbound Freya Street will have a lane closure between Hartson and 5th Avenues.
 - Eastbound and westbound Hartson Avenue lane closures with flaggers from Myrtle and Havana Streets.
- Mastec North America will be working in the following locations from 11/1/25 to 12/1/25.
 - Eastbound Trent Avenue will be reduced to one lane with flaggers between Fiske and Ralph Streets.
 - Westbound Trent Avenue will be reduced to one lane with flaggers between Thor and Ralph Streets.
- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 10/3/25 to 12/2/25.
 - Division Street/Ruby Street will have a lane closure between North Foothills Drive and Dalton Avenue.
 - North Foothills Drive will have a lane closure between Ruby and Nevada Streets.
- The northbound lane of Inland Empire Way will be closed between 27th Avenue and Oak Street from 11/3/25 to 12/3/25 for Mastec North America fiber work.
- Mastec North America will be working in the following locations from 11/3/25 to 12/3/25.
 - Southbound lane closure on Geiger Boulevard between Park Drive and Flightline Boulevard.
 - Flagging at the intersection of Rowand Road and Geiger Boulevard.
 - Westbound lane closure on Garden Springs Road between Geiger Boulevard and Lawton Road.

- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 10/6/25 to **12/4/25**.
 - Lane closure on Lidgerwood Street between Francis and Central Avenues.
 - Lane closure on Central Avenue between Division and Astor Streets.
- Empire Avenue will have lane closures between Division and Cook Streets from 10/8/25 to **12/6/25** for TDS Metrocom work.
- Post Street is closed between Riverside and Sprague Avenue from 1/6/25 to March 2026 for the Peyton Building remodel.

STREET DEPARTMENT PROJECTS

POTHOLE CREWS

- City crews continue to fill potholes as weather allows. If you see a pothole, report it by calling **3-1-1**. Potholes can also be reported online through [your Spokane 311 account](#). Crews focus on the largest holes on the busiest streets first. Include as much information as possible on the location and size of the pothole.

- Crews will be working on mud boils and utility cuts.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER CROSSING

- The curb lane of northbound Greene Street is closed between Mission and Ermina Avenues.
- Carlisle Avenue between Greene and Ralph Streets is closed.
- Upriver Drive at Ralph Street will be flagged to accommodate overhead work.
- Ralph Street is closed between Grace and Carlisle Avenues.
- The Spokane River is closed at the Greene Street Bridge.

This project will construct the North Spokane Corridor bridge that will cross the Spokane River and connect the skyway portion near Spokane Community College to the south and at Carslie Avenue to the north of the river.
