CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

9TH AND PINE BOOSTER STATION

- There are no street closures. However, construction vehicles use 9th Avenue to access the off-street construction site for the remainder of the construction.

This project will replace the out-of-service booster station with a modern facility.

This is a \$5.3 million project.

ADAPTIVE DESIGN TRAFFIC CALMING (SPOKANE SAFE STREETS FOR ALL)

- **Work has been suspended for 2025.**

All three districts will receive traffic calming improvements. Improvement projects will include bike lanes, shared-use pathways, stairway and crosswalk improvements, ADA ramps, and several other safety and mobility projects for non-motorized users.

This is a \$2.8 million project.

LINCOLN STREET – SUMMIT TO SINTO PEDESTRIAN AND BIKE SAFETY

- **This project is complete.**

This project enhances bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure along Lincoln Street from Summit Parkway to Sinto Avenue. Improvements include buffered and protected bike lanes, widened sidewalks, a grind-and-overlay from Summit to Boone, and a new signal at Lincoln/Broadway.

This is a \$2.6 million project.

SPOTTED ROAD BOOSTER STATION

- There are no traffic impacts.

Construction of a new water booster station for the Plains Pressure Zone.

This is a \$2 million project.

NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Empire Avenue will have lane closures between Division and Cook Streets from 10/8/25 to 12/6/25 for TDS Metrocom work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 11/10/25 to 12/7/25.
 - Francis Avenue between Belt and A Streets will have intermittent lane closures with flaggers on-site.
 - Alberta Street between Francis and Central Avenues will have intermittent lane closures with flaggers on-site.
- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 9/12/25 to 12/10/25.
 - Strong Road will have moving lane closures between Five Mile Road and Oak Street.
 - Austin Road will have moving lane closures between Strong Road and Cascade Way.
- Northbound Flint Road will have lane closures between Granite and Hilton Avenues from 12/1/25 to 12/12/25 for North Sky Communications work.
- Division Street will have curb lane closures between Magnesium Road and Newport Highway from 12/1/25 to 12/12/25 for Arc Electric & Lighting to install speed cameras.
- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 8/18/25 to 12/14/25.
 - Both curb lanes of Wellesley Avenue will be closed between Whitehouse and Wall Streets with flaggers on-site.
 - Flaggers on Garland Avenue and Whitehouse Street intersection.
- Southbound lane closure on Nevada Street/Wolverton Court between Liberty and Cleveland Avenues from 11/17/25 to 12/15/25 for TDS Metrocom work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 9/19/25 to 12/17/25.
 - Nevada Street will have intermittent lane closures between Queen and Wellesley Avenues.
 - The center lane of Lidgerwood Street will be closed between Queen and Wellesley Avenues.
- The westbound curb lane of Mission Avenue will be closed between Thor Court and Fiske Street from 11/17/25 to 12/19/25 for Mastec North America work.
- Mastec North America will be working in the following areas from 7/21/25 to 12/21/25.
 - The northbound curb lane of Cowley Street will be closed between Hartson and 4th Avenues.
 - The eastbound curb lane of 4th/5th Avenues will be closed between Cowley to Sherman Streets.
- Northbound Crestline Street will have lane closures between Dalton and Queen Avenues from 11/24/25 to 12/22/25 for TDS Metrocom work.
- Monroe Street will have lane closures between Fairview and Euclid Avenues from 11/24/25 to 12/23/25 for TDS Metrocom aerial fiber crossing work.

- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 9/26/25 to 12/23/25.
 - Northbound Nevada Street lane closure between Heroy and Princeton Avenues.
 - Northbound and southbound lane closures on Perry Street between Heroy and Princeton Avenues.
- Mastec North America will be working in the following areas from 8/25/25 to 12/26/25.
 - The south curb lane of 3rd Avenue will be closed between Conklin and Arthur Streets.
 - The eastbound curb lane of Arthur Street will be closed between 3rd and 2nd Avenues.
 - Flaggers at the intersection of Arthur Street and 3rd Avenue.
- Eastbound Boone Avenue lane closure between Howard and Atlantic Streets from 12/1/25 to 12/30/25 for Fatbeam LLC work.
- Eastbound and westbound Sinto Avenue lane closure between Washington and Atlantic Streets from 12/1/25 to 12/30/25 for Fatbeam LLC work.
- Freya Street between 11th to 14th Avenues will have temporary lane closures with flaggers on-site from 12/1/25 to 12/30/25 for LTS Managed Technical SRVS work.
- Lane closures and flaggers on Freya Street between 9th and 12th Avenues from 12/1/25 to 12/30/25 for LTS Managed Technical SRVS work.
- Lane closures on Division Street between Liberty and Bridgeport Avenues from 12/1/25 to 12/30/25 for TDS Metrocom work.
- Northbound Crestline Street lane closure between Wabash and Queen Avenues from 11/3/25 to 12/30/25 for TDS Metrocom work.
- Mastec North America will be working in the following areas from 10/12/25 to 12/30/25.
 - Hawthorne Road will have eastbound and westbound closures between Andrew Street and Northpointe Access Lane.
 - Southbound lane closure on Newport Highway between Eaton Avenue and Elm Street.
- Mastec North America will be working in the following areas from 10/20/25 to 12/31/25.
 - Crestline Street between Rich and Wabash Streets will have lane closures with flaggers.
 - Wellesley Avenue between Pittsburg and Lacey Streets will have lane closures with flaggers.
- Southbound Thor Street will have a lane closure between 11th to 8th Avenues from 10/1/25 to 12/31/25 for LTS Managed Technical Services LLC work.
- LTS Managed Technical Services LLC will be working at the following locations from 10/1/25 to 12/31/25.
 - Westbound lane closure on 5th Avenue between Freya and Greene Streets.
 - Westbound lane closure on Hartson Avenue between Freya and Fiske Streets.

- Mastec North America will be working in the following areas from 12/2/25 to 1/1/26.
 - Eastbound Holland Avenue will have lane closures between U.S. 2 and Hoerner Drive.
 - Northbound Hoerner Drive will have lane closures between Colton Street and Holland Avenue.
 - Westbound Holland Avenue will have lane closures between Dakota and Colton Streets.
 - Flaggers at the intersection of Hoerner Drive and Holland Avenue.
- The northbound curb lane of Havana Street will be closed between Ferry and Boone Avenues from 12/1/25 to 1/1/26 for Mastec North America work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 11/5/25 to 1/1/26.
 - Temporary closure of Division Street at Rockwell Avenue, this work will occur on a Sunday before 9 a.m.
 - Temporary closures on Nevada Street between Rockwell and Heroy Avenues.
 - Temporary closures on Addison Street between Rockwell and Heroy Avenues.
 - Temporary closures on Perry Street between Rockwell and Longfellow Avenues.
- TDS Metrocom will be working in the following areas from 10/3/25 to 1/1/26.
 - Division Street/Ruby Street will have a lane closure between North Foothills Drive and Dalton Avenue.
 - North Foothills Drive will have a lane closure between Ruby and Nevada Streets.
- Northbound lane closure on Altamont Street between Altamont Boulevard and Hartson Avenue from 10/6/25 to 1/3/26 for LTS Managed Technical Services LLC.
- Eastbound and westbound curb lane closures of North Foothills Drive between Magnolia Street and Fairview Avenue from 12/4/25 to 1/5/26 for Mastec North America work.
- Indian Trail Road will have lane closures between Barnes Road and Comanche Avenue from 12/4/25 to 1/5/26 for Mastec North America work.
- 6th Avenue closure between Maple and Walnut Streets from 11/4/25 to 2/4/26 for Halme Construction work.
- The northbound lane of Inland Empire Way will be closed between 27th Avenue and Oak Street from 11/3/25 to 1/31/26 for Mastec North America fiber work.
- Post Street is closed between Riverside and Sprague Avenue from 1/6/25 to March 2026 for the Peyton Building remodel.

STREET DEPARTMENT PROJECTS

LEAF PICKUP

- Leaf pickup is underway! The City's leaf pickup service is intended to remove only the leaves that naturally fall into the streets. **Residents *should not* rake leaves into the street.**

POTHOLE CREWS

- City crews continue to fill potholes as weather allows. If you see a pothole, report it by calling **3-1-1**. Potholes can also be reported online through [your Spokane 311 account](#). Crews focus on the largest holes on the busiest streets first. Include as much information as possible on the location and size of the pothole.

SNOW REMOVAL

- Residents are asked to park on the odd side of the street in residential areas for snow season, which runs from Nov. 15 to March 15.

- Crews will be working on utility cuts.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER CROSSING

- Carlisle Avenue between Greene and Ralph Streets is closed.
- Upriver Drive at Ralph Street will be flagged to accommodate overhead work.
- Ralph Street is closed between Grace and Carlisle Avenues.
- The Spokane River is closed at the Greene Street Bridge.

This project will construct the North Spokane Corridor bridge that will cross the Spokane River and connect the skyway portion near Spokane Community College to the south and at Carlisle Avenue to the north of the river.
