Projects highlighted in RED have notable changes this week. Construction is tentative and subject to change at any time.

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

9TH AND PINE BOOSTER STATION

- There are no street closures. However, construction vehicles use 9th Avenue to access the off-street construction site for the remainder of the construction.

This project will replace the out-of-service booster station with a modern facility.

This is a \$5.3 million project.

SPOTTED ROAD BOOSTER STATION

- There are no traffic impacts.

Construction of a new water booster station for the Plains Pressure Zone.

This is a \$2 million project.

NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Eastbound lane closure on Shawnee Avenue between Seminole Drive and Loganberry Court from 2/9/26 to 3/9/26 for Mastec North America work.
- LTS Managed Technical Services will be working at the following locations from 2/9/26 to 3/10/26.
 - Intermittent lane closures on Napa Street between Boone and Desmet Avenues.
 - Intermittent lane closures on Napa Street between Cataldo and Mallon Avenues.
- Eastbound Mission Avenue will have a lane closure between Haven and Greene Street from 2/9/26 to 3/10/26 for LTS Managed Technical Services work.
- Ziplly Fiber Pacific will be working at the following locations from 2/9/26 to 3/10/26.
 - Eastbound lane closure on Hartson Avenue from Thor to Freya Streets.
 - Northbound lane closure on Altamont Street from 3rd to Pacific Avenues.
 - Eastbound lane closure on 5th Avenue from Ralph to Thor Streets.

- MJM Grand will be working at the following locations from 3/4/26 to 3/13/26.
 - Division Street northbound curb lane closure between Dalke and Lyons Avenues.
 - Frances Avenue westbound curb lane closure between Mayfair and Division Streets.
- LTS Managed Technical SRVS will be working in the following areas from 12/15/25 to 3/13/26.
 - Northwest Boulevard's center turn lane will be closed between Grace and York Avenues.
 - Southbound lane closure with flaggers on Belt Street between Northwest Boulevard and Montgomery Avenue.
- Eastbound I-90 ramp closure; 3rd Avenue between Rebecca St. and eastbound I-90 will be closed between 3/11/26 to 3/15/26 for Geoengineers Inc. work.
- LTS Managed Technical SRVS will be working in the following areas from 12/17/25 to 3/16/26.
 - Northbound and southbound curb lanes of Washington Street will be closed between Knox and Indiana Avenues.
 - The northbound curb lane of Howard Street will be closed between Indiana and Knox Avenues.
 - The northbound curb lane of Post Street will be closed between Shannon and Mansfield Avenues.
 - Division Street will have flaggers between Jackson and Indiana Avenue for side road work.
- Crestline Street will have lane closures with flaggers on-site between Wabash and Lacrosse Avenue from 1/19/26 to 3/17/26 for TDS Metrocom work.
- Boone Avenue will have lane closures between Lindeke Street and Summit Boulevard with flaggers on-site from 2/18/26 to 3/19/26 for TDS Metrocom work.
- LTS Managed Technical SRVS will be working in the following areas from 12/22/25 to 3/21/26.
 - Washington Street will have northbound and southbound lane closures between Shannon and Augusta Avenues.
 - The east curb lane of Ruby Street will be closed between Ermina and Montgomery Avenues.
- Crews will be working at the Flightline Boulevard, Geiger Boulevard, and Grove Road roundabout; flaggers will be at all four roundabout entrances. This is Zero DB Communications' work scheduled for 2/23/26 to 3/23/26.

- Mastec North America will be working at the following locations from 2/16/26 to 3/23/26.
 - The south curb lane of 3rd Avenue will be closed between Lincoln and Stevens Streets.
 - Southbound and northbound lane closures on Wall Street between 2nd and 4th Avenues.
 - Southbound and northbound lane closures on Howard Street between 2nd and 4th Avenues.
- LTS Managed Technical SRVS will be working in the following areas from 2/23/26 to 3/24/26.
 - Fancher Way lane closure with flaggers on-site between Rutter and Commerce Avenues.
 - Fancher Way northbound and center lane closures with flaggers on-site between Baldwin and Knox Avenues.
 - Flaggers at the intersection of Trent Avenue and Waldo Street.
 - Flaggers at the intersection of Trent Avenue and Byrd Street.
- Francis Avenue will have lane closures with flaggers on-site between Division and Calispel Streets from 2/23/26 to 3/24/26 for TDS Metrocom work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 2/23/26 to 3/24/26.
 - Mission Avenue/Summit Boulevard reduced to one lane with flaggers between Pettet Drive and Cochran Street.
 - Summit Boulevard reduced to one lane with flaggers between Sherwood Street and Broadway Avenue.
 - A Street reduced to one lane with flaggers between Mallon and Broadway Avenues.
 - Boone Avenue reduced to one lane with flaggers between Lindeke Street and Summit Boulevard.
 - Maple Street lane closures between Mallon and Sharp Avenues.
 - Ash Street lane closures between Maxwell and Boone Avenues.
- Monroe Street will have lane closures between Fairview and Euclid Avenues from 11/24/25 to 3/25/26 for TDS Metrocom aerial fiber crossing work.
- The east curb lane of Maple Street will be closed between Gardner and Shannon Avenues from 2/25/26 to 3/26/26 for TDS Metrocom work.
- Ermina Avenue between Greene Street and South Riverton Avenue will have lane closures from 2/23/26 to 3/27/26 for Kune Construction overhead bridge work.
- Carlilse Avenue between Greene and Ralph Streets will have eastbound and westbound lane closures from 2/23/26 to 3/27/26 for Kune Construction work.
- Lane closures and flaggers on Freya Street between 9th and 12th Avenues from 12/1/25 to 3/27/26 for LTS Managed Technical SRVS work.
- Freya Street between 11th to 14th Avenues will have temporary lane closures with flaggers on-site from 12/1/25 to 3/27/26 for LTS Managed Technical SRVS work.

- Division Street temporary closure between Liberty and Bridgeport Avenues from 12/1/25 to 3/30/26 for TDS Metrocom aerial fiber crossing work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 3/3/26 to 4/1/26.
 - Mission Avenue reduced to one lane with flaggers on-site between Pettet Drive and Cochran Street.
 - Ash Street closed east of Gardner Avenue with flaggers stopping traffic no longer than 2-3 minutes at a time.
- Crestline Street will have intermittent lane closures between Garland and Rich Avenues from 2/2/26 to 4/2/26 for TDS Metrocom work.
- Fatbeam will be working at the following locations from 3/4/26 to 4/2/26.
 - Division Street northbound curb lane closure between Lincoln Road and Newport Highway.
 - Magnesium Road eastbound and westbound curb lane closures between Mayfair and Division Streets.
 - Magnesium Road eastbound curb lane closure between Antietam Drive and Crestline Street.
 - Nevada Street northbound curb lane closure between St Thomas Moore Way to Jay Avenue.
- Inland Empire Way northbound lane closure between Oak Street and 27th Avenue from 3/5/26 to 4/6/26 for Mastec North America work.
- LTS Managed Technical SRVS will be working at the following locations from 3/9/26 to 4/7/26.
 - Sprague Avenue westbound curb lane closure between Perry and Ivory Streets.
 - Sprague Avenue center lane closure between Perry and Pittsburg Streets.
- TDS Metrocom LLC will be working at the following locations from 2/9/26 to 4/9/26.
 - Ash Street between Gardner and Dean Avenues will have intermittent lane closures with flaggers on-site.
 - Maple Street between Boone and Dean Avenues will have intermittent lane closures with flaggers on-site.
- Thor Street will have intermittent northbound and southbound lane closures between Hartson and 11th Avenues from 2/2/26 to 4/11/26 for Ziplly Fiber Pacific work.
- Ash Street will have intermittent lane closures with flaggers on-site between Augusta and Maxwell Avenue from 2/11/26 to 4/11/26 for TDS Metrocom work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 12/23/25 to 4/28/26.
 - Maple Street will have curb lane closures between Cora Court and Providence Avenue.
 - Flaggers on Ash Street between Garland and Kiernan Avenues.
 - Flaggers on Ash Street between Gordon and Glass Avenues.
- 6th Avenue closure between Maple and Walnut Streets from 11/4/25 to 5/5/26 for Halme Construction work.

STREET DEPARTMENT PROJECTS

POTHOLE CREWS

- City crews continue to fill potholes as weather allows. If you see a pothole, report it by calling **3-1-1**. Potholes can also be reported online through [your Spokane 311 account](#). Crews focus on the largest holes on the busiest streets first. Include as much information as possible on the location and size of the pothole.

SNOW REMOVAL

- Residents are asked to park on the odd side of the street in residential areas for snow season, which runs from Nov. 15 to March 15.

SWEEPING CREWS

- Northwest
 - Arterial Routes
 - Residential route 10
 - Residential route 12
- Northeast
 - Arterial Routes
 - Residential route 35
- South
 - Arterial Routes
 - Residential route 43
 - Residential route 42

ADDITIONAL WORK

- Crews will be working on some grading throughout the City; this work is weather-dependent.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER CROSSING

- The following streets are closed for work.
 - Carlisle Avenue between Greene and Ralph Streets is closed.
 - Upriver Drive at Ralph Street will be flagged to accommodate overhead work.
- The Spokane River is closed at the Greene Street Bridge.

This project will construct the North Spokane Corridor bridge that will cross the Spokane River and connect the skyway portion near Spokane Community College to the south and at Carlisle Avenue to the north of the river.
