CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

9TH AND PINE BOOSTER STATION

- There are no street closures. However, construction vehicles use 9th Avenue to access the off-street construction site for the remainder of the construction.

This project will replace the out-of-service booster station with a modern facility.

This is a \$5.3 million project.

FRANCIS & ASSEMBLY WATER

- Work on this project resumes Monday, March 30. Here is what to expect:
 - A southbound lane closure on 9 Mile Road between Wind River Drive and Rifle Club Road.
 - 9 Mile Road will be closed to pedestrian traffic.

This project will enhance water, sewer, stormwater, and traffic infrastructure in the Northwest Terrace area. Phase One involves installing a new water transmission main from the Low Water Pressure System to the NW Terrace Water Pressure System, improving domestic water reliability and supporting future growth.

This is a \$3.3 million project.

SPOTTED ROAD BOOSTER STATION

- There are no traffic impacts.

Construction of a new water booster station for the Plains Pressure Zone.

This is a \$2 million project.

SPRAGUE & ALKI-BROADWAY - FREYA TO HAVANA GRIND AND OVERLAY

- Work on this project resumes Monday, March 30. Sprague Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Havana and Freya Streets.

This project rehabilitates portions of Sprague Avenue and Alki-Broadway Avenue. It also includes a water main replacement, ADA ramp upgrades, and selected stormwater improvements.

This is a \$3 million project.

US 195 MEADOWLANE J-TURN

- US 195 has northbound and southbound lane restrictions between Cheney Spokane Road and Hatch Road.

This project will reconstruct the intersection of US 195 and Meadowlane Road to include a J-turn, along with acceleration and deceleration lanes. These upgrades aim to enhance safety and reduce congestion during peak hours, while also preparing for future growth in the area.

This is a \$2.4 million project.

WELLESLEY - FREYA TO HAVANA RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

- Construction begins Monday, March 30. Wellesley Avenue will be closed between Havana and Freya Streets.

Full reconstruction of Wellesley from Freya to Havana (35-ft., 3-lanes), including stormwater improvements, street trees, and replacing the water distribution main, and a shared use path on the south side of the street.

This is a \$4.5 million project.

NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Westbound lane closure on 44th Avenue between Fiske and Regal Streets from 3/23/24 to 3/27/26 for North Sky Communications work.
- The center turn lane of Buckeye Avenue will be closed between Atlantic and Normandie Streets from 3/13/26 to 3/27/26 for Hydromax work.
- Ermina Avenue between Greene Street and South Riverton Avenue will have lane closures from 2/23/26 to 3/27/26 for Kuney Construction overhead bridge work.
- Carlilse Avenue between Greene and Ralph Streets will have eastbound and westbound lane closures from 2/23/26 to 3/27/26 for Kuney Construction work.
- Lane closures and flaggers on Freya Street between 9th and 12th Avenues from 12/1/25 to 3/27/26 for LTS Managed Technical SRVS work.

- Freya Street between 11th to 14th Avenues will have temporary lane closures with flaggers on-site from 12/1/25 to 3/27/26 for LTS Managed Technical SRVS work.
- The westbound curb lane of Boone Avenue will be closed between Normandie and Washington Streets along with the turn lane from 3/18/26 to 4/1/26 for Hydromax work.
- The northbound inside lane of Five Mile Drive will be closed between Dell Drive and Wedgewood Avenue from 3/18/26 to 4/1/26 for Hydromax work.
- The northbound inside lane of Five Mile Drive will be closed between Wedgewood and Weile Avenues from 3/18/26 to 4/1/26 for Hydromax work.
- The northbound curb lane of Market Street will be closed between Bismark and Decatur Avenues from 3/18/26 to 4/1/26 for Hydromax work.
- Southbound lane closure on Howard Street between Boone and Sharp Avenues from 3/18/26 to 4/1/26 for Hydromax work.
- The eastbound inside lane and center lane of Queen Avenue will be closed between Atlantic and Lidgerwood Streets from 3/18/26 to 4/1/26 for Hydromax work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 3/3/26 to 4/1/26.
 - Mission Avenue reduced to one lane with flaggers on-site between Pettet Drive and Cochran Street.
 - Ash Street closed east of Gardner Avenue with flaggers stopping traffic no longer than 2-3 minutes at a time.
- Crestline Street will have intermittent lane closures between Garland and Rich Avenues from 2/2/26 to 4/2/26 for TDS Metrocom work.
- Fatbeam will be working at the following locations from 3/4/26 to 4/2/26.
 - Division Street northbound curb lane closure between Lincoln Road and Newport Highway.
 - Magnesium Road eastbound and westbound curb lane closures between Mayfair and Division Streets.
 - Magnesium Road eastbound curb lane closure between Antietam Drive and Crestline Street.
 - Nevada Street northbound curb lane closure between St Thomas Moore Way to Jay Avenue.
- Strong Road will be closed at Nettleton Court with flaggers on-site from 3/5/26 to 4/3/26 for TDS Metrocom work.
- Inland Empire Way northbound lane closure between Oak Street and 27th Avenue from 3/5/26 to 4/6/26 for Mastec North America work.
- LTS Managed Technical SRVS will be working at the following locations from 3/9/26 to 4/7/26.
 - Sprague Avenue westbound curb lane closure between Perry and Ivory Streets.
 - Sprague Avenue center lane closure between Perry and Pittsburg Streets.
- Belt Street will have lane closures with flaggers between Sinto and Boone Avenues from 3/10/26 to 4/8/26 for TDS Metrocom work.

- Eastbound Mission Avenue will have a lane closure between Haven and Greene Street from 2/9/26 to 4/9/26 for LTS Managed Technical Services work.
- TDS Metrocom LLC will be working at the following locations from 2/9/26 to 4/9/26.
 - Ash Street between Gardner and Dean Avenues will have intermittent lane closures with flaggers on-site.
 - Maple Street between Boone and Dean Avenues will have intermittent lane closures with flaggers on-site.
- **Greene Street will have northbound and southbound inside lane closures between Mission and Ermina Avenues from 3/30/26 to 4/20/26 for Max J Kuney Construction work.**
- Thor Street will have intermittent northbound and southbound lane closures between Hartson and 11th Avenues from 2/2/26 to 4/11/26 for Ziplly Fiber Pacific work.
- Ash Street will have intermittent lane closures with flaggers on-site between Augusta and Maxwell Avenue from 2/11/26 to 4/11/26 for TDS Metrocom work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 3/16/26/ to 4/14/26.
 - Belt Street between Pettet Drive and Sharp Avenue will have intermittent lane closures with flaggers on-site.
 - East curb lane of Ash Street will be closed between Mission and Sinto Avenues.
 - The east curb lane of Maple Street will be closed between Sharp and Maxwell Avenues.
- The east curb lane of Freya Street will be closed between Hartson and 5th Avenues from 3/17/26 to 4/15/26 for Ziplly Fiber Pacific work.
- Crestline Street will have lane closures with flaggers on-site between Wabash and Lacrosse Avenue from 1/19/26 to 4/16/26 for TDS Metrocom work.
- The intersection of Freya Street and Palouse Highway will be closed from 3/23/26 to 4/17/26 for construction of the Moody Townhomes.
- Copenhagen Construction will be working in the following locations from 3/16/26 to 4/17/26.
 - Palouse Highway will be closed between Freya and Regal Streets.
 - Southbound Freya Street shoulder closed between Palouse Highway and 55th Avenue.
 - Flaggers at the intersections of Freya Street and 55th Avenue and Palouse Highway and Freya Street.
- Mastec North America will be working at the following locations from 3/19/26 to 4/19/26.
 - Both curb lanes of Francis Avenue will be closed Belt and Lindeke Streets.
 - Center lane closure on Alberta Street between Midwick and Rosewood Avenues.
 - Flaggers at the intersection of Francis Avenue and Alberta Street.
- Boone Avenue will have lane closures between Lindeke Street and Summit Boulevard with flaggers on-site from 2/18/26 to 4/19/26 for TDS Metrocom work.

- Mastec North America will be working at the following locations from 2/16/26 to 4/23/26.
 - The south curb lane of 3rd Avenue will be closed between Lincoln and Stevens Streets.
 - Southbound and northbound lane closures on Wall Street between 2nd and 4th Avenues.
 - Southbound and northbound lane closures on Howard Street between 2nd and 4th Avenues.
- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 2/23/26 to 4/23/26.
 - Mission Avenue/Summit Boulevard reduced to one lane with flaggers between Pettet Drive and Cochran Street.
 - Summit Boulevard reduced to one lane with flaggers between Sherwood Street and Broadway Avenue.
 - A Street reduced to one lane with flaggers between Mallon and Broadway Avenues.
 - Boone Avenue reduced to one lane with flaggers between Lindeke Street and Summit Boulevard.
 - Maple Street lane closures between Mallon and Sharp Avenues.
 - Ash Street lane closures between Maxwell and Boone Avenues.
- Monroe Street will have lane closures between Fairview and Euclid Avenues from 11/24/25 to 4/24/26 for TDS Metrocom aerial fiber crossing work.
- The east curb lane of Maple Street will be closed between Gardner and Shannon Avenues from 2/25/26 to 4/25/26 for TDS Metrocom work.
- Westbound Martin Luther King Way will have lane closures between Front Avenue and Erie Street from 3/25/26 to 4/26/26 for TDS Metrocom work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 12/23/25 to 4/28/26.
 - Maple Street will have curb lane closures between Cora Court and Providence Avenue.
 - Flaggers on Ash Street between Garland and Kiernan Avenues.
 - Flaggers on Ash Street between Gordon and Glass Avenues.
- Division Street temporary closure between Liberty and Bridgeport Avenues from 12/1/25 to 4/29/26 for TDS Metrocom aerial fiber crossing work.
- The north curb lane of Main Avenue will be closed between Lincoln and Wall Streets from 3/16/26 to 4/30/26 for Baker Construction work.
- The east curb lane of Maple Street will be closed between Nora and Indiana Avenues from 3/17/26 to 4/30/26 for Go Green Concrete work.
- 6th Avenue closure between Maple and Walnut Streets from 11/4/25 to 5/5/26 for Halme Construction work.

STREET DEPARTMENT PROJECTS

POTHOLE CREWS

- City crews continue to fill potholes as weather allows. If you see a pothole, report it by calling **3-1-1**. Potholes can also be reported online through [your Spokane 311 account](#). Crews focus on the largest holes on the busiest streets first. Include as much information as possible on the location and size of the pothole.

ADDITIONAL WORK

- Crews will be working on some grading throughout the City; this work is weather-dependent.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER CROSSING

- The following streets are closed for work.
 - Riverton Avenue is closed between Ermina Avenue and Fiske Street.
 - Carlisle Avenue between Greene and Ralph Streets is closed.
 - Upriver Drive between Ralph Street and Carlisle Avenue is being flagged to accommodate overhead work.
- The Spokane River is closed at the Greene Street Bridge.

This project will construct the North Spokane Corridor bridge that will cross the Spokane River and connect the skyway portion near Spokane Community College to the south and at Carslie Avenue to the north of the river.
