CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

9TH AND PINE BOOSTER STATION

- There are no street closures. However, construction vehicles use 9th Avenue to access the off-street construction site for the remainder of the construction.

This project will replace the out-of-service booster station with a modern facility.

This is a \$5.3 million project.

FRANCIS & ASSEMBLY WATER

- 9 Mile Road has a southbound lane closure between Wind River Drive and Rifle Club Road. The street is closed to pedestrian traffic.
- Wind River Drive is closed between 9 Mile Road and Pine Rock Street through Friday, April 17.

This project will enhance water, sewer, stormwater, and traffic infrastructure in the Northwest Terrace area. Phase One involves installing a new water transmission main from the Low Water Pressure System to the NW Terrace Water Pressure System, improving domestic water reliability and supporting future growth.

This is a \$3.3 million project.

FREYA STREET WATER DISTRIBUTION MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

- Construction resumes on Freya Street on Monday, April 20. Freya Street will be closed between 13th and 21st Avenues until Tuesday, April 21. Crews are repaving two sections of street that did not meet compaction standards.

This project replaces approximately 3,050 feet of 8-inch cast iron water main with a 12-inch ductile iron main along Freya Street from 21st Avenue to 13th Avenue. Work also includes roadway repairs, ADA-compliant curb ramps, and coordination with utilities to minimize service disruptions.

This is a \$3.7 million project.

SPOTTED ROAD BOOSTER STATION

- There are no traffic impacts.

Construction of a new water booster station for the Plains Pressure Zone.

This is a \$2 million project.

SPRAGUE & ALKI-BROADWAY - FREYA TO HAVANA GRIND AND OVERLAY

- Havana Street is reduced to one lane in each direction between Main and 2nd Avenues until Friday, April 17.
- Sprague Avenue is reduced to one lane in each direction between Havana and Freya Streets.

This project rehabilitates portions of Sprague Avenue and Alki-Broadway Avenue. It also includes a water main replacement, ADA ramp upgrades, and selected stormwater improvements.

This is a \$3 million project.

US 195 MEADOWLANE J-TURN

- US 195 has northbound and southbound lane restrictions between Cheney Spokane Road and Hatch Road.

This project will reconstruct the intersection of US 195 and Meadowlane Road to include a J-turn, along with acceleration and deceleration lanes. These upgrades aim to enhance safety and reduce congestion during peak hours, while also preparing for future growth in the area.

This is a \$2.4 million project.

WELLESLEY - FREYA TO HAVANA RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

- Wellesley Avenue is closed between Havana and Freya Streets.

Full reconstruction of Wellesley from Freya to Havana (35-ft., 3-lanes), including stormwater improvements, street trees, and replacing the water distribution main, and a shared use path on the south side of the street.

This is a \$4.5 million project.

NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Eastbound lane closure on 7th Avenue between McClellan and Browne Streets from 4/6/26 to 4/17/26 for Raptor Rooter Plumbing work.
- Southbound lane closure on Regal Street between 42nd and 46th Avenues from 4/13/26 to 4/17/26 for Go Green Concrete work.
- Main Avenue will be reduced to one lane between Lincoln and Post Streets from 4/15/26 to 4/17/26 for Rhodes Crane work.

 - Both curb lanes of Francis Avenue will be closed Belt and Lindeke Streets.
 - Center lane closure on Alberta Street between Midwick and Rosewood Avenues.
 - Flaggers at the intersection of Francis Avenue and Alberta Street.
- The curb lane and inside lane of Nevada Street will be closed between Dalke and Francis Avenues from 4/6/26 to 4/20/26 for Hydromax USA work.
- Hydromax USA will be working at the following locations from 4/7/26 to 4/21/26.
 - Northbound Division Street will have a curb lane closure between Sanson and Central Avenues.
 - Westbound Rowan Avenue will have a curb lane closure between Mayfair and Division Streets.
- Bouten Construction will be working at the following locations on 4/22/26.
 - McClellan Street will have lane closures between 8th and 7th Avenues.
 - 7th Avenue will have lane closures between McClellan and Browne Streets.
- Northbound lane closure on Freya Street between 16th and 15th Avenues from 4/20/26 to 4/22/26 for Inland Trenchless Swanson Holdings work.
- Nevada Street will have lane closures between Cozza Drive and Lyons Avenues from 4/22/26 to 4/23/26 for Walker Construction restriping work.
- Francis Avenue will have lane closures with flaggers on-site between Division and Calispel Streets from 2/23/26 to 4/23/26 for TDS Metrocom work.

- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 2/23/26 to 4/23/26.
 - Mission Avenue/Summit Boulevard reduced to one lane with flaggers between Pettet Drive and Cochran Street.
 - Summit Boulevard reduced to one lane with flaggers between Sherwood Street and Broadway Avenue.
 - A Street reduced to one lane with flaggers between Mallon and Broadway Avenues.
 - Boone Avenue reduced to one lane with flaggers between Lindeke Street and Summit Boulevard.
 - Maple Street lane closures between Mallon and Sharp Avenues.
 - Ash Street lane closures between Maxwell and Boone Avenues.
- LTS Managed Technical SRVS will be working in the following areas from 2/23/26 to 4/23/26.
 - Fancher Way lane closure with flaggers on-site between Rutter and Commerce Avenues.
 - Fancher Way northbound and center lane closures with flaggers on-site between Baldwin and Knox Avenues.
 - Flaggers at the intersection of Trent Avenue and Waldo Street.
 - Flaggers at the intersection of Trent Avenue and Byrd Street.

 - The south curb lane of 3rd Avenue will be closed between Lincoln and Stevens Streets.
 - Southbound and northbound lane closures on Wall Street between 2nd and 4th Avenues.

- Monroe Street will have lane closures between Fairview and Euclid Avenues from 11/24/25 to 4/24/26 for TDS Metrocom aerial fiber crossing work.
- Westbound Martin Luther King Way will have lane closures between Front Avenue and Erie Street from 3/25/26 to 4/26/26 for TDS Metrocom work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 3/30/26 to 4/28/26.
 - Trent Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Hogan and Madelia Streets.
 - Helena Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Front and Springfield Avenues.

 - Two west curb lanes of Maple Street closed between Spofford and Indiana Avenues.
 - Two west curb lanes of Ash Street closed between Indiana and Spofford Avenues.

- The east curb lane of Maple Street will be closed between Nora and Indiana Avenues from 3/17/26 to 4/30/26 for Go Green Concrete work.

- The westbound curb lane of Sunset Highway will be closed between Windsor Drive and the U.S. 2 on-ramp from 4/13/26 to 5/13/26 for Mastec North America work.

WASTEWATER DEPARTMENT

Perry Street, 11th to 17th Avenues

- Starting Monday, April 20, the City's Wastewater Department will be upgrading storm drains on Perry Street from 11th to 17th Avenues. This work will be rolling and will start with a Perry Street southbound closure between 11th and 17th Avenues. Traffic will be detoured at 5th Avenue to Sherman Avenue to 18th Avenue. This work is expected to be completed by Friday, May 15.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER CROSSING

- The following streets are closed for work.
 - The northbound and southbound inside lanes of Greene Street are closed between Mission and Ermina Avenues for traffic island installations.
 - Ralph Street is closed between Grace Avenue and Upriver Drive.
 - Carlisle Avenue is closed between Greene and Ralph Streets.
 - Upriver Drive between Ralph Street and Carlisle Avenue is being flagged to accommodate overhead work.
- The Spokane River is closed at the Greene Street Bridge.

This project will construct the North Spokane Corridor bridge that will cross the Spokane River and connect the skyway portion near Spokane Community College to the south and at Carslie Avenue to the north of the river.
