*Projects highlighted in **RED** have notable changes this week. Construction is tentative and subject to change at any time.*

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

3RD AVENUE FROM STEVENS TO DIVISION STREETS

- Construction is underway; here is what to expect.
 - 3rd Avenue is reduced to two lanes between Howard and Bernard Streets.
 - Washington Street is reduced to two lanes between 5th and 2nd Avenues.

The proposed project will include curb-to-curb pavement grind and overlay, as well as replacement of ADA ramps where needed, and replace the aging water distribution main between Stevens and Washington Streets.

This is a \$1.1 million project.

9TH AND PINE BOOSTER STATION

- There are no street closures. However, construction vehicles use 9th Avenue to access the off-street construction site for the remainder of the construction.

This project will replace the out-of-service booster station with a modern facility.

This is a \$5.3 million project.

ARTERIAL PEDESTRIAN HYBRID BEACONS

- Crews are working in the following areas.
 - Market Street and Columbia Avenue – Market Street is closed between Central and Joseph Avenues.
 - Nevada Street and Cozza Drive – Cozza Drive is closed between Cincinnati and Standard Streets.

This project enhances pedestrian safety by installing four Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons (PHBs) on busy arterials. It also includes sidewalk upgrades, bike lanes, and improved pedestrian facilities to encourage safer, more accessible travel.

This is a \$1.5 million project.

NORTH HILLYARD SIDEWALKS

- This project starts Monday, May 18, crews will be working on Haven Street between Central and Bismark Avenues. Parking restrictions will be in place.

The project will enhance pedestrian access and safety with a mix of separated and adjacent sidewalks and ADA curb ramps where needed.

This is a \$1 million project.

SPOTTED ROAD BOOSTER STATION

- There are no traffic impacts.

Construction of a new water booster station for the Plains Pressure Zone.

This is a \$2 million project.

SPRAGUE & ALKI-BROADWAY - FREYA TO HAVANA GRIND AND OVERLAY

- Sprague Avenue is reduced to one lane in each direction between Havana and Freya Streets.

This project rehabilitates portions of Sprague Avenue and Alki-Broadway Avenue. It also includes a water main replacement, ADA ramp upgrades, and selected stormwater improvements.

This is a \$3 million project.

US 195 MEADOWLANE J-TURN

- Meadowlane Road exit on the west side of U.S. 195 is closed to traffic. Motorists should use the Chene-Spokane Rd. exit to access the Eagle Ridge residential area.
- US 195 has northbound and southbound lane restrictions between Cheney Spokane Road and Hatch Road.

This project will reconstruct the intersection of US 195 and Meadowlane Road to include a J-turn, along with acceleration and deceleration lanes. These upgrades aim to enhance safety and reduce congestion during peak hours, while also preparing for future growth in the area.

This is a \$2.4 million project.

WELLESLEY - FREYA TO HAVANA RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

- Wellesley Avenue is closed between Havana and Freya Streets.

Full reconstruction of Wellesley from Freya to Havana (35-ft., 3-lanes), including stormwater improvements, street trees, and replacing the water distribution main, and a shared use path on the south side of the street.

This is a \$4.5 million project.

NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Strong Road will be closed between Nettleton Court and Orchard Street from 5/4/26 to 5/15/26.
- Northbound lane closure on Indian Trail Road between Ridgecrest Drive and Blackfoot Avenue from 4/16/26 to 5/15/26 for Utilities One work.
- Grandview Avenue will be closed between Garden Springs Road and 21st Avenue from 4/6/26 to 5/15/26 for ACI Northwest INC. work.

 - Ruby Street will have curb lane closures between Desmet and Sharp Avenues.
 - Westbound curb lane closure on Sharp Avenue between Ruby and Lidgerwood Street.
 - Eastbound lane closure on Sharp Avenue between Ruby and Pearl Streets.
 - Eastbound and westbound curb lane closures on Mission Avenue between Atlantic and Pearl Streets.
- Mastec North America Inc. will be working in the following locations from 4/20/26 to 5/19/26.
 - Northbound lane closure on Monroe Street between Gardner and Sharp Avenues.
 - Eastbound lane closure on Boone Avenue between Adams and Lincoln Streets.
 - Maxwell Avenue closed with flaggers between Monroe and Lincoln Streets.

 - Southbound lane closure on Washington Street between Boone and Cataldo Avenues.

 - Eastbound lane closure on 37th Avenue from Stone to Smith Streets with flaggers on-site.

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER CROSSING

- The following streets are closed for work.
 - Ralph Street is closed between Grace Avenue and Upriver Drive.
 - Carlisle Avenue is closed between Greene and Ralph Streets.
 - Upriver Drive is closed at Ralph Street.
- The Spokane River is closed at the Greene Street Bridge.

This project will construct the North Spokane Corridor bridge that will cross the Spokane River and connect the skyway portion near Spokane Community College to the south and at Carlisle Avenue to the north of the river.
