CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

3RD AVENUE FROM STEVENS TO DIVISION STREETS

- **3rd Avenue will have night work Wednesday, June 3, to Thursday, June 4. 3rd Avenue will be closed between Washington and Stevens Streets.**
- Construction is underway; here is what to expect.
 - 3rd Avenue is reduced to two lanes between Howard and Bernard Streets.
 - Washington Street is reduced to two lanes between 5th and 2nd Avenues. There is a detour in place for trucks.

The proposed project will include curb-to-curb pavement grind and overlay, as well as replacement of ADA ramps where needed, and replace the aging water distribution main between Stevens and Washington Streets.

This is a \$1.1 million project.

9TH AND PINE BOOSTER STATION

- There are no street closures. However, construction vehicles use 9th Avenue to access the off-street construction site for the remainder of the construction.

This project will replace the out-of-service booster station with a modern facility.

This is a \$5.3 million project.

ARTERIAL PEDESTRIAN HYBRID BEACONS

- Crews are working in the following areas.
 - Market Street and Columbia Avenue – **Market Street between Central and Joseph Avenues will reopen on Friday, May 29.**
 - Nevada Street and Cozza Drive – Cozza Drive is closed between Cincinnati and Standard Streets.
 - **Regal Street and Thurston Avenue – Starting Monday, June 1, Regal Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction between 39th and 42nd Avenues.**

This project enhances pedestrian safety by installing four Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons (PHBs) on busy arterials. It also includes sidewalk upgrades, bike lanes, and improved pedestrian facilities to encourage safer, more accessible travel.

This is a \$1.5 million project.

NORTH HILLYARD SIDEWALKS

- Crews are working on Haven Street between Central and Bismark Avenues. Parking restrictions are in place.

The project will enhance pedestrian access and safety with a mix of separated and adjacent sidewalks and ADA curb ramps where needed.

This is a \$1 million project.

FREYA STREET WATER DISTRIBUTION MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

- **This work has been rescheduled for Thursday, June 4, and Friday, June 5.** Freya Street will be closed between 13th and 15th Avenues and 20th and 21st Avenues as crews repave two sections of Freya Street that did not meet compaction standards.

This project replaces approximately 3,050 feet of 8-inch cast iron water main with a 12-inch ductile iron main along Freya Street from 21st Avenue to 13th Avenue. Work also includes roadway repairs, ADA-compliant curb ramps, and coordination with utilities to minimize service disruptions.

This is a \$3.7 million project.

SPOTTED ROAD BOOSTER STATION

- There are no traffic impacts.

Construction of a new water booster station for the Plains Pressure Zone.

This is a \$2 million project.

SPRAGUE & ALKI-BROADWAY - FREYA TO HAVANA GRIND AND OVERLAY

- Sprague Avenue is reduced to one lane in each direction between Havana and Freya Streets.
- Havana Street is closed on the south side of Sprague Avenue through Wednesday, June 4.

This project rehabilitates portions of Sprague Avenue and Alki-Broadway Avenue. It also includes a water main replacement, ADA ramp upgrades, and selected stormwater improvements.

This is a \$3 million project.

STREET MAINTENANCE CURB RAMPS

- Construction will start Monday, June 1. Crews will be working at the following locations.
 - Dakota Street and Jay Avenue
 - Perry Street from Hoffman to Heroy Avenues

This project installs ADA-compliant curb ramps where the street department has completed a grind and overlay.

This is a \$700,000 project.

US 195 MEADOWLANE J-TURN

- Meadowlane Road exit on the west side of U.S. 195 is closed to traffic. Motorists should use the Cheney-Spokane Rd. exit to access the Eagle Ridge residential area.
- US 195 has northbound and southbound lane restrictions between Cheney Spokane Road and Hatch Road.

This project will reconstruct the intersection of US 195 and Meadowlane Road to include a J-turn, along with acceleration and deceleration lanes. These upgrades aim to enhance safety and reduce congestion during peak hours, while also preparing for future growth in the area.

This is a \$2.4 million project.

WELLESLEY - FREYA TO HAVANA RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

- Wellesley Avenue is closed between Havana and Freya Streets. A detour is in place.

Full reconstruction of Wellesley from Freya to Havana (35-ft., 3-lanes), including stormwater improvements, street trees, and replacing the water distribution main, and a shared use path on the south side of the street.

This is a \$4.5 million project.

NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Southbound Perry Street will have lane closure between 9th and 10th Avenues from 5/19/26 to 5/29/26 for Raptor Rooter & Plumbing LLC work.
- The Monroe Street Bridge will be closed on 5/30/26 from 6 – 10 p.m. with detours in place for North Star work.
- TDS Metrocom will be working at the following locations from 4/1/26 to 5/30/26.
 - Altamont Street between Riverside and Ferry Avenues will have lane closures with flaggers on-site.
 - Main Avenue between Magnolia and Altamont Streets will have lane closures with flaggers on-site.

 - Standard Street will have intermittent northbound lane closures with flaggers on-site between Rosewood and Holyoke Avenues.
- Nettleton Street between Maxwell Avenue and West Point Road will be reduced to one lane with flaggers on-site from 3/3/26 to 6/1/26 for TDS Metrocom work.
- Ziplly Fiber Pacific will be working at the following locations from 2/9/26 to 6/1/26.
 - Eastbound lane closure on Hartson Avenue from Thor to Freya Streets.
 - Northbound lane closure on Altamont Street from 3rd to Pacific Avenues.
 - Eastbound lane closure on 5th Avenue from Ralph to Thor Streets.
- Northbound Geiger Boulevard will have lane closures between Grove Street and Garden Springs Road from 5/27/26 to 6/3/26 for Inland Power & Light Co. work.

- Mastec North America will be working at the following locations from 5/4/26 to 6/4/26.
 - Southbound lane closure on Regal Street between Palouse Highway and 55th Avenue.
 - Flaggers at the intersection of Regal Street and 53rd Avenue.
- Northbound lane closure on Helena Street between Riverside and Front Avenues from 5/4/26 to 6/4/26 for Mastec North America work.
- North Sky Communications will be working at the following locations from 6/1/26 to 6/5/26.
 - Southbound lane closure on Freya Street between Euclid and Liberty Avenues.

- Eastbound lane closures on Mission Avenue between Regal and Rebecca Streets from 5/8/26 to 6/6/26 for TDS Metrocom LLC work.

 - The east curb lane of Maple Street will be closed between Sinto and Maxwell Avenues.

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT) NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER CROSSING

- The following streets are closed for work.
 - Ralph Street is closed between Grace Avenue and Upriver Drive.
 - Carlisle Avenue is closed between Greene and Ralph Streets.
 - Upriver Drive is closed between Freya and Ralph Streets.
- The Spokane River has reopened at the Greene Street Bridge.

This project will construct the North Spokane Corridor bridge that will cross the Spokane River and connect the skyway portion near Spokane Community College to the south and at Carslie Avenue to the north of the river.

I-90, SR 904 TO GEIGER BOULEVARD PAVING

- Starting Monday, June 1, I-90 will have single lane closures in both eastbound and westbound lanes between SR 490 and Geiger Boulevard. There will be occasional ramp closures. Work hours are Monday through Friday, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
