CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

3RD AVENUE FROM STEVENS TO DIVISION STREETS

- Crews are working in the following areas. Traffic control will be pulled on Friday, June 26.
 - 3rd Avenue is reduced to two lanes between Howard and Bernard Streets.
- Monday, June 29, and Tuesday, June 30, between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m., crews will be striping and making utility adjustments on 3rd Avenue. Here's what to expect:
 - 3rd Avenue will be closed between Stevens and Browne Streets, and Browne and Division Streets.
 - The intersection of 3rd Avenue and Browne Street will be open.
 - The intersection of 3rd Avenue and Washington Street will be closed.
 - Washington Street is reduced to two lanes between 4th and 2nd Avenues.
 - There is a detour in place for trucks.

The proposed project will include curb-to-curb pavement grind and overlay, as well as replacement of ADA ramps where needed, and replace the aging water distribution main between Stevens and Washington Streets.

This is a \$1.1 million project.

9TH AND PINE BOOSTER STATION

- There are no street closures. However, construction vehicles use 9th Avenue to access the off-street construction site for the remainder of the construction.

This project will replace the out-of-service booster station with a modern facility.

This is a \$5.3 million project.

ARTERIAL PAVEMENT REPAIR

- Crews are working in the following areas:
 - Southeast Boulevard is closed between 29th Avenue and Regal Street **through Tuesday, June 30**. Drivers should use Regal Street.
 - Crews will start Summit Drive between Cochran and A Streets on Monday, June 29.
 - Perry Street will be closed between 34th and 29th Avenues starting on Tuesday, June 30. Drivers should use Grand Boulevard.

Full-depth pavement repair to preserve and maintain Spokane's streets.

This is a \$480,000 project.

ARTERIAL PEDESTRIAN HYBRID BEACONS

- Crews are working in the following areas.
 - Whistalks Way and Randolph Rd. – Whistalks Way is reduced to one lane in each direction until **Wednesday, July 1**.
 - Market Street and Columbia Avenue – Crews are working at the corner of Columbia Avenue and Haven Street until **Tuesday, June 30**.
 - Nevada Street and Cozza Drive – Cozza Drive is closed between Cincinnati and Standard Streets until **Tuesday, June 30**.
 - Regal Street and Thurston Avenue – Work will take place through Friday, July 17.

This project enhances pedestrian safety by installing four Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons (PHBs) on busy arterials. It also includes sidewalk upgrades, bike lanes, and improved pedestrian facilities to encourage safer, more accessible travel.

This is a \$1.5 million project.

GREENE/FREYA/HAVANA ST. BRIDGE DECK RESURFACING

- Southbound Greene Street is closed between Euclid and Mission Avenues. Here is what to expect:
 - Southbound Greene St. will be detoured at Euclid Ave. west to Division St. Drivers are urged to use an alternate southbound route.
 - Northbound Greene St. will be reduced to one lane between Mission Ave. and Carlisle Ave. Expect significant slowdowns.
 - Local access on Greene St. will be maintained between Carlisle Ave. and Ermina Ave.

This project will include bridge deck preservation work using a thin concrete overlay on Greene St. Bridge, and a polyester modified concrete overlay on two Freya St. Bridges and Havana St. Bridge.

This is a \$3.5 million

MAPLE-WALNUT GRIND & OVERLAY – 4TH TO MAPLE STREET BRIDGE

- The Maple Street Bridge is closed in both directions, with plans to **reopen Thursday, June 25, at 8 p.m.**
- The Bike the Bridge event is planned for Thursday, June 25, 4 – 6 p.m.
- Monday, June 29 through Friday, July 3, Maple and Walnut Streets will have lane closures between 5th and 2nd Avenues for striping, signage, and punch list items.

This grind and overlay project is the continuation of the project that was postponed from 2025 due to an industry strike. This project rehabilitates Maple and Walnut Streets from 4th Avenue to the south approach of the Maple Street Bridge. Improvements include a grind and overlay of existing pavement, curb ramp upgrades to meet ADA standards, and a sidewalk widening near an overhead traffic sign pole on Maple Street.

This is a \$2 million project.

NORTH HILLYARD SIDEWALKS

- Crews are working on Lacey, **Regal, and Smith Street** between Francis and Central Avenues. Parking restrictions are in place.

The project will enhance pedestrian access and safety with a mix of separated and adjacent sidewalks and ADA curb ramps where needed.

This is a \$1 million project.

SPOTTED ROAD BOOSTER STATION

- There are no traffic impacts.

Construction of a new water booster station for the Plains Pressure Zone.

This is a \$2 million project.

SPRAGUE & ALKI-BROADWAY - FREYA TO HAVANA GRIND AND OVERLAY

- Sprague Avenue is reduced to one lane in each direction between Havana and Freya Streets.
- Southbound Havana Street is closed at Sprague Avenue through the weekend. **On Monday, June 29, there will be curb lane adjustments, and motorists will have impacts in the intersection on Tuesday, June 30, and Wednesday, July 1, for striping and joint sealing.**

This project rehabilitates portions of Sprague Avenue and Alki-Broadway Avenue. It also includes a water main replacement, ADA ramp upgrades, and selected stormwater improvements.

This is a \$3 million project.

STREET MAINTENANCE CURB RAMPS

- Construction is underway. Crews will be working at the following locations.
 - **Addison Street between Courtland and Providence Avenues.**

This project installs ADA-compliant curb ramps where the street department has completed a grind and overlay.

This is a \$700,000 project.

US 195 MEADOWLANE J-TURN

- **The US 195 Meadowlane J-Turn will open on Friday, June 26. Work will continue with light pole and sign installations, striping, and punch list items.**

This project will reconstruct the intersection of US 195 and Meadowlane Road to include a J-turn, along with acceleration and deceleration lanes. These upgrades aim to enhance safety and reduce congestion during peak hours, while also preparing for future growth in the area.

This is a \$2.4 million project.

WELLESLEY - FREYA TO HAVANA RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

- Wellesley Avenue is closed between Havana and Freya Streets. A detour is in place.

Full reconstruction of Wellesley from Freya to Havana (35-ft., 3-lanes), including stormwater improvements, street trees, and replacing the water distribution main, and a shared use path on the south side of the street.

This is a \$4.5 million project.

NON-CITY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Ziply Fiber Pacific will be working at the following locations from 4/14/26 to 6/26/26.
 - Thor Street between 8th and 9th will have a temporary closure with flaggers for an aerial fiber crossing.
 - Northbound and southbound lane closures on Thor Street between Hartson and 11th Avenues.
 - Freya Street between Hartson and 8th Avenues will have a temporary closure with flaggers for an aerial fiber crossing.
 - Hartson Avenue between Thor and Freya Streets will have a temporary closure with flaggers for an aerial fiber crossing.

Cars must be moved from these streets by 6 p.m. on Friday, June 26, or they will be towed. For north-south travel, the following streets will be open throughout downtown Spokane: Maple, Walnut, Lincoln, Monroe, Browne, and Division Streets.

Parking: The River Park Square parking garage will be accessible via Lincoln Street. The Parkade will be accessible via Howard Street. The Grand Hotel parking garage will be accessible via Spokane Falls Boulevard. The parking garage adjacent to the Wonder Building will be accessible via Mallon Avenue.

Alternative Transportation: Spokane Transit makes it simple and affordable to access Hoopfest! With regular bus service, the Jefferson Hoopfest Shuttle, and City Line, getting downtown is easy and affordable. Enjoy free parking at the Jefferson Lot, Spokane Community College, University District lots (WSU Spokane and Gonzaga), and ride for just \$2 each way. STA Plaza will be closed, alternative boarding bays will be located at Howard St. and 2nd Ave. More information on [STA's website](#).

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)

NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER CROSSING

- The following streets are closed for work.
 - Ralph Street is closed between Grace Avenue and Upriver Drive.
 - Riverton Avenue is closed under the Greene Street Bridge. Detours are in place.
- The Spokane River has reopened at the Greene Street Bridge.

This project will construct the North Spokane Corridor bridge that will cross the Spokane River and connect the skyway portion near Spokane Community College to the south and at Carslie Avenue to the north of the river.

I-90, SR 904 TO GEIGER BOULEVARD PAVING

- I-90 has single lane closures in both eastbound and westbound lanes between SR 940 and Geiger Boulevard. There will be occasional ramp closures. Work hours are Monday through Friday, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
