## **CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

### **3<sup>RD</sup> AVENUE FROM STEVENS TO DIVISION STREETS**

- 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue from Division to Stevens Streets has lane reductions as crews work on utility adjustments and striping. **The project is expected to be complete by 5 a.m. Friday, July 3.**
- **3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue will be closed from Stevens to Division Streets from Thursday, July 2, at 7 p.m. to Friday, July 3, at 5 a.m.**

The proposed project will include curb-to-curb pavement grind and overlay, as well as replacement of ADA ramps where needed, and replace the aging water distribution main between Stevens and Washington Streets.

**This is a \$1.1 million project.**

### **3<sup>RD</sup> AVENUE FROM WALNUT TO STEVENS STREETS AND STEVENS STREET FROM 8<sup>TH</sup> TO 3<sup>RD</sup> AVENUES**

- This project will start on Monday, July 6. Stevens Street will have lane reductions between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Avenues.

This project is a grind and overlay of 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue from Walnut to Stevens Streets, replacement of curb ramps for ADA compliance where needed, and stormwater upgrades.

**This is a \$1 million project.**

### **9<sup>TH</sup> AND PINE BOOSTER STATION**

- There are no street closures. However, construction vehicles use 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue to access the off-street construction site for the remainder of the construction.

This project will replace the out-of-service booster station with a modern facility.

**This is a \$5.3 million project.**

### ARTERIAL PAVEMENT REPAIR

- Crews are working in the following areas:
  - Southeast Boulevard is closed between 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Regal Street until **Thursday, July 2**. Drivers should use Regal Street.
  - Crews are working on Summit Drive between Cochran and A Streets.
  - **Perry Street will be closed between 31<sup>st</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> Avenues starting on Monday, July 6. Drivers should use Grand Boulevard.**

Full-depth pavement repair to preserve and maintain Spokane's streets.

**This is a \$480,000 project.**

### ARTERIAL PEDESTRIAN HYBRID BEACONS

- Crews are working on Regal Street and Thurston Avenue. **Starting Monday, July 6, the westbound lane of Thurston Avenue will be closed between Regal and Lacey Streets.**

This project enhances pedestrian safety by installing four Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons (PHBs) on busy arterials. It also includes sidewalk upgrades, bike lanes, and improved pedestrian facilities to encourage safer, more accessible travel.

**This is a \$1.5 million project.**

### GREENE/FREYA/HAVANA ST. BRIDGE DECK RESURFACING

- Southbound Greene Street is closed between Euclid and Mission Avenues. Here is what to expect:
  - Southbound Greene St. will be detoured at Euclid Ave. west to Division St. Drivers are urged to use an alternate southbound route.
  - Northbound Greene St. will be reduced to one lane between Mission Ave. and Carlisle Ave. Expect significant slowdowns.
  - Local access on Greene St. will be maintained between Carlisle Ave. and Ermina Ave.

This project will include bridge deck preservation work using a thin concrete overlay on Greene St. Bridge, and a polyester modified concrete overlay on two Freya St. Bridges and Havana St. Bridge.

**This is a \$3.5 million**

### MAPLE-WALNUT GRIND & OVERLAY – 4<sup>TH</sup> TO MAPLE STREET BRIDGE

- Maple and Walnut Streets have lane closures between 5<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenues for striping, signage, and punch list items until Friday, July 3.

This grind and overlay project is the continuation of the project that was postponed from 2025 due to an industry strike. This project rehabilitates Maple and Walnut Streets from 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the south approach of the Maple Street Bridge. Improvements include a grind and overlay of existing pavement, curb ramp upgrades to meet ADA standards, and a sidewalk widening near an overhead traffic sign pole on Maple Street.

**This is a \$2 million project.**

### NORTH HILLYARD SIDEWALKS

- Crews are working on Lacey, Regal, and Smith Street between Francis and Central Avenues. Parking restrictions are in place.

The project will enhance pedestrian access and safety with a mix of separated and adjacent sidewalks and ADA curb ramps where needed.

**This is a \$1 million project.**

### SPOTTED ROAD BOOSTER STATION

- There are no traffic impacts.

Construction of a new water booster station for the Plains Pressure Zone.

**This is a \$2 million project.**

### SPRAGUE & ALKI-BROADWAY - FREYA TO HAVANA GRIND AND OVERLAY

- This project is nearing completion; crews will have partial lane closures as needed.

This project rehabilitates portions of Sprague Avenue and Alki-Broadway Avenue. It also includes a water main replacement, ADA ramp upgrades, and selected stormwater improvements.

**This is a \$3 million project.**

### SCHOOL WALK ROUTES

- Construction starts Monday, July 6, near Audubon and Indian Trail Elementary Schools.
- Crews will be working in the following areas near Audubon Elementary:
  - Belt Street from Montgomery to Jackson Avenues
  - Cannon Street and Jackson Avenue
  - Cannon Street and Carlisle Avenue.

- Crews will be working in the following areas near Indian Trail Elementary:
  - Weile Avenue and Sutherlin Street
  - Weile Avenue and Valerie Street
  - Woodside Avenue and Drumheller Street

Spokane School Walk Routes project that will increase pedestrian safety with crossing treatments, sidewalk infill, bumpouts, and ADA curb ramp improvements for children, parents and staff walking to and from school.

### **STREET MAINTENANCE CURB RAMPS**

- Construction is underway. Crews will be working at the following locations.
  - Addison Street between Courtland and Providence Avenues **until Wednesday, July 8.**
  - Crews will start work on Perry Street between 11<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> Avenues starting on **Wednesday, July 8.**

This project installs ADA-compliant curb ramps where the street department has completed a grind and overlay.

**This is a \$700,000 project.**

### **US 195 MEADOWLANE J-TURN**

- The US 195 Meadowlane J-Turn is open. Work continues with light pole and sign installations, striping, and punch list items.

This project will reconstruct the intersection of US 195 and Meadowlane Road to include a J-turn, along with acceleration and deceleration lanes. These upgrades aim to enhance safety and reduce congestion during peak hours, while also preparing for future growth in the area.

**This is a \$2.4 million project.**

### **WELLESLEY - FREYA TO HAVANA RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT**

- Wellesley Avenue is closed between Havana and Freya Streets. A detour is in place.

Full reconstruction of Wellesley from Freya to Havana (35-ft., 3-lanes), including stormwater improvements, street trees, and replacing the water distribution main, and a shared use path on the south side of the street.

**This is a \$4.5 million project.**

## **STREET DEPARTMENT PROJECTS**

### **BRIDGE WORK**

- Crews will be working on the Greene Street Bridge.

### **CRACK SEALING**

- Rowan Avenue, Driscoll Boulevard to Monroe Street. There will be lane restrictions.

### **GRIND & OVERLAY**

- Crews are working on a grind and overlay project on Perry Street between Empire and Wellesley Avenues. There will be lane closures and temporary closures when paving.

### **POTHOLE CREWS**

- City crews continue to fill potholes as weather allows. If you see a pothole, report it by calling **3-1-1**. Potholes can also be reported online through [your Spokane 311 account](#). Crews focus on the largest holes on the busiest streets first. Include as much information as possible on the location and size of the pothole.

### **WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT)**

#### **NORTH SPOKANE CORRIDOR-US 395/NSC SPOKANE RIVER CROSSING**

- The following streets are closed for work.
  - Ralph Street is closed between Grace Avenue and Upriver Drive.
  - Riverton Avenue is closed under the Greene Street Bridge. Detours are in place.
  
- The Spokane River has reopened at the Greene Street Bridge.

This project will construct the North Spokane Corridor bridge that will cross the Spokane River and connect the skyway portion near Spokane Community College to the south and at Carslie Avenue to the north of the river.

#### **I-90, SR 904 TO GEIGER BOULEVARD PAVING**

- I-90 has single lane closures in both eastbound and westbound lanes between SR 940 and Geiger Boulevard. There will be occasional ramp closures. Work hours are Monday through Friday, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
