CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

3RD AVENUE FROM STEVENS TO DIVISION STREETS

- **This project is substantially complete.**

The proposed project will include curb-to-curb pavement grind and overlay, as well as replacement of ADA ramps where needed, and replace the aging water distribution main between Stevens and Washington Streets.

This is a \$1.1 million project.

3RD AVENUE FROM WALNUT TO STEVENS STREETS AND STEVENS STREET FROM 8TH TO 3RD AVENUES

- Stevens Street has lane reductions between 3rd and 9th Avenues.

This project is a grind and overlay of 3rd Avenue from Walnut to Stevens Streets, replacement of curb ramps for ADA compliance where needed, and stormwater upgrades.

This is a \$1 million project.

9TH AND PINE BOOSTER STATION

- There are no street closures. However, construction vehicles use 9th Avenue to access the off-street construction site for the remainder of the construction.

This project will replace the out-of-service booster station with a modern facility.

This is a \$5.3 million project.

ARTERIAL PAVEMENT REPAIR

- Crews are working in the following areas:
 - Summit Drive is closed between Cochran and A Streets.
 - Perry Street is closed between 31st and 29th Avenues. Drivers should use Grand Boulevard.
 - Crews will be working at the intersection of Maxwell Avenue and Post Street starting Tuesday, July 14.

Full-depth pavement repair to preserve and maintain Spokane's streets.

This is a \$480,000 project.

ARTERIAL PEDESTRIAN HYBRID BEACONS

- Crews are working on Regal Street and Thurston Avenue. The westbound lane of Thurston Avenue is closed between Regal and Lacey Streets.

This project enhances pedestrian safety by installing four Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons (PHBs) on busy arterials. It also includes sidewalk upgrades, bike lanes, and improved pedestrian facilities to encourage safer, more accessible travel.

This is a \$1.5 million project.

CHESTNUT ST. BRIDGE SCOUR MITIGATION

- This project will start on Monday, July 13. Chestnut St. Bridge will be closed with detours in place.

This project will include scour damage repair of the Chestnut St. Bridge including stream bottom and bank restoration, removal of fill, improve hydraulics under the bridge, rip/rap and repair around piers. No work is being done on the bridge structure or deck.

This is a \$2 million project.

GREENE/FREYA/HAVANA ST. BRIDGE DECK RESURFACING

- Southbound Greene Street is closed between Euclid and Mission Avenues. Here is what to expect:
 - Southbound Greene St. will be detoured at Euclid Ave. west to Division St. Drivers are urged to use an alternate southbound route.
 - Northbound Greene St. will be reduced to one lane between Mission Ave. and Carlisle Ave. Expect significant slowdowns.
 - Local access on Greene St. will be maintained between Carlisle Ave. and Ermina Ave.

This project will include bridge deck preservation work using a thin concrete overlay on Greene St. Bridge, and a polyester modified concrete overlay on two Freya St. Bridges and Havana St. Bridge.

This is a \$3.5 million

MAPLE-WALNUT GRIND & OVERLAY – 4TH TO MAPLE STREET BRIDGE

- This project is substantially complete! Temporary traffic control may be in place as crews work on punchlist items.

This grind and overlay project is the continuation of the project that was postponed from 2025 due to an industry strike. This project rehabilitates Maple and Walnut Streets from 4th Avenue to the south approach of the Maple Street Bridge. Improvements include a grind and overlay of existing pavement, curb ramp upgrades to meet ADA standards, and a sidewalk widening near an overhead traffic sign pole on Maple Street.

This is a \$2 million project.

NORTH HILLYARD SIDEWALKS

- Project will be suspended on Friday, July 10. Utility companies will be on-site to move utility poles.
- Crews are working on Lacey, Regal, and Smith Street between Francis and Central Avenues. Parking restrictions are in place.

The project will enhance pedestrian access and safety with a mix of separated and adjacent sidewalks and ADA curb ramps where needed.

This is a \$1 million project.

SCHOOL WALK ROUTES

- Monday, July 13, crews will start work in the following areas near Browne Elementary:
 - Upper Driscoll Boulevard and Queen Place
 - Upper Driscoll Boulevard and Olympic Place
 - Driscoll Boulevard and Queen Place
 - Driscoll Boulevard and Olympic Place
 - Greenwood Boulevard and Olympic Place
- Crews are working in the following areas near Audubon Elementary:
 - Belt Street from Montgomery to Jackson Avenues
 - Cannon Street and Jackson Avenue
 - Cannon Street and Carlisle Avenue
- Crews are working in the following areas near Indian Trail Elementary:
 - Weile Avenue and Sutherlin Street
 - Weile Avenue and Valerie Street
 - Woodside Avenue and Drumheller Street

Spokane School Walk Routes project that will increase pedestrian safety with crossing treatments, sidewalk infill, bumpouts, and ADA curb ramp improvements for children, parents and staff walking to and from school.

This project is funded through the state.

SPOTTED ROAD BOOSTER STATION

- There are no traffic impacts.

Construction of a new water booster station for the Plains Pressure Zone.

This is a \$2 million project.

SPRAGUE & ALKI-BROADWAY - FREYA TO HAVANA GRIND AND OVERLAY

- This project is substantially complete; crews will have partial lane closures as needed.

This project rehabilitates portions of Sprague Avenue and Alki-Broadway Avenue. It also includes a water main replacement, ADA ramp upgrades, and selected stormwater improvements.

This is a \$3 million project.

SUNSET HIGHWAY TRAIL - SPOTTED ROAD TO ROYAL STREET

- This project will start on Monday, July 13. Sunset Highway and Sunset Frontage Road will have lane closures between Spotted and Assembly Roads. The sidewalk will be closed to pedestrians.

The Sunset Boulevard Bike Path Project will construct a dedicated multi-use path along the north side of Sunset Boulevard, connecting Spotted Road to Royal Street. This 10–12-foot-wide path will improve safety and accessibility for pedestrians and cyclists in a high-traffic corridor.

This project is funded through local transportation funds.

STREET MAINTENANCE CURB RAMPS

- Construction is underway. Crews will be working at the following locations.
 - Perry Street between 11th and 17th Avenues.

This project installs ADA-compliant curb ramps where the street department has completed a grind and overlay.

This is a \$700,000 project.

US 195 MEADOWLANE J-TURN

- The US 195 Meadowlane J-Turn is open. Work continues with light pole and sign installations, striping, and punch list items.

This project will reconstruct the intersection of US 195 and Meadowlane Road to include a J-turn, along with acceleration and deceleration lanes. These upgrades aim to enhance safety and reduce congestion during peak hours, while also preparing for future growth in the area.

This is a \$2.4 million project.

WELLESLEY - FREYA TO HAVANA RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

- Wellesley Avenue is closed between Havana and Freya Streets. A detour is in place.

Full reconstruction of Wellesley from Freya to Havana (35-ft., 3-lanes), including stormwater improvements, street trees, and replacing the water distribution main, and a shared use path on the south side of the street.

This is a \$4.5 million project.
