CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

3RD AVENUE FROM WALNUT TO STEVENS STREETS AND STEVENS STREET FROM 8TH TO 3RD AVENUES

- Crews are working at the following locations:
 - Stevens Street has lane reductions between 3rd and 9th Avenues.
 - 3rd Avenue will have periodic lane closures at Stevens Street.

This project is a grind and overlay of 3rd Avenue from Walnut to Stevens Streets, replacement of curb ramps for ADA compliance where needed, and stormwater upgrades.

This is a \$1 million project.

9TH AND PINE BOOSTER STATION

- There are no street closures. However, construction vehicles use 9th Avenue to access the off-street construction site for the remainder of the construction.

This project will replace the out-of-service booster station with a modern facility.

This is a \$5.3 million project.

ARTERIAL PAVEMENT REPAIR

- Crews will be working at the following locations:
 - Empire Avenue from Addison to Nevada Streets will wrap up on Friday, Aug. 21.
 - **Friday, Aug. 21, crews will start North Foothills Drive between Mayfair and Dakota Streets.**
 - **Tuesday, Aug. 25, crews will start Hamilton Street between Boone and Carlisle Avenues.**
 - **Tuesday, Aug. 25, crews will start Boone Avenue between Cedar and Madison Streets.**

Full depth pavement repair to preserve and maintain Spokane's streets.

This is a \$480,000 project.

CHESTNUT ST. BRIDGE SCOUR MITIGATION

- The Chestnut St. Bridge is closed with detours in place.

This project will include scour damage repair of the Chestnut St. Bridge including stream bottom and bank restoration, removal of fill, improve hydraulics under the bridge, rip/rap and repair around piers. No work is being done on the bridge structure or deck.

This is a \$2 million project.

CYCLE 13 TRAFFIC CALMING

- Crews will be working at the following locations:
 - Lacey Street from Wellesley to Wabash Avenues
 - Lacey Street from Wellesley to Hoffman Avenues
 - Queen Avenue from Regal to Havana Streets
 - Queen Avenue from Haven to Market Streets
 - F Street from Gordon Avenue to Northwest Boulevard
 - F Street from Northwest Boulevard to Glass Avenue

Improvements include installing Rectangle Rapid Flashing Beacons, curb bumpouts, Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons, bus pads, and hi-visibility Zicla zebra crosswalks, promoting a walkable and accessible community.

This project is funded by red light cameras.

DESMET & SUPERIOR SEWER REROUTE

- The Centennial Trail is closed between Superior Street and Sharp Avenue.

This project replaces a damaged 10-inch sewer line near the intersection of Desmet Avenue and Superior Street. The existing pipe has deteriorated due to settlement and hydrogen sulfide damage, requiring full replacement. Work involves crossing the BNSF railroad and the Centennial Trail to connect to an existing siphon vault.

This is a \$1 million project.

GREENE/FREYA/HAVANA ST. BRIDGE DECK RESURFACING

- Crews are working on the Freya Street Bridge and Freya Way Bridge **through Thursday, Aug. 27**. Here is what to expect.
 - Southbound Freya Street is detoured at Mission Avenue. A detour utilizing Mission/Trent Ave. to Fancher Way to Broadway/Alki Ave is in place.
 - Northbound Freya Street is reduced to one lane between Sprague and Mission Avenues.

- On Thursday, Aug. 27, crews will swap over to northbound Freya work; here is what to expect:
 - Northbound Freya Street will be detoured at Broadway/Alki Avenue. A detour utilizing Broadway/Alki Avenue to Fancher Way to Trent/Mission Avenue will be in place.
 - Southbound Freya Street will be reduced to one lane between Mission and Sprague Avenues.

This project will include bridge deck preservation work using a thin concrete overlay on Greene St. Bridge, and a polyester modified concrete overlay on two Freya St. Bridges and Havana St. Bridge.

This is a \$3.5 million.

HIGH VIS CROSSWALKS

- Crews are bouncing from one location to another. Lane reductions in the locations where crews are working. Crews will be working Monday through Friday from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

The project will install high visibility piano key crosswalks in various locations throughout the City, some locations with PCC pavement will include grooving to inset the pavement markings and replace and upgrade stop bars as needed.

This is a \$1.7 million project.

LOCAL ACCESS GRIND AND OVERLAY AND CHIP SEAL

- The following streets are closed to through traffic with local access only and on-street parking restrictions.
 - Moran View Street and Eagle Ridge Road to Crest View Street
 - Addison Street from Euclid to Bridgeport Avenues
 - Rockwell Avenue from Crestline to Cook Streets
 - 6th Avenue from Cedar to Monroe Streets
 - Holyoke Avenue from Traft Drive to Indian Trail Road
 - Rowan Avenue from Ash to Maple Streets will start on Thursday, Aug. 27.

The project will include curb to curb asphalt repair, modifying curb ramps so they are ADA compliant and striping if necessary.

This is a \$2.5 million project.

PACIFIC AVENUE GREENWAY FROM HOWARD TO SHERMAN STREET

- This project will start on Thursday, Aug. 27.

The Pacific Avenue Greenway creates an east-west bike route from Howard Street to Sherman Street, improving pedestrian safety and connecting downtown Spokane to the University District. Enhancements include bike lanes, pedestrian crosswalks, green space, and signal updates.

This is a \$5 million project.

SCHOOL WALK ROUTES

- Crews are working near Logan Elementary and Yasuhara Middle School:
 - Marietta Avenue from Hamilton to Nevada Streets
 - Morton Street from Marietta to Jackson Avenues
 - Columbus Street and Jackson Avenue
 - Columbus Street and Morton Avenue
 - Columbus Street and Carlisle Avenue
 - Perry Street and Jackson Avenue
 - Perry Street and Marietta Avenue
 - Nevada Street and Carlisle Avenue
- Crews are working near Garfield Elementary:
 - Normandie Street and Buckeye Avenue
 - Washington Street and Mansfield Avenue
 - Howard Street and Mansfield Avenue
 - Calispel Street and Mansfield Avenue

Spokane School Walk Routes project that will increase pedestrian safety with crossing treatments, sidewalk infill, bumpouts, and ADA curb ramp improvements for children, parents and staff walking to and from school.

This project is funded through the state.

SPOTTED ROAD BOOSTER STATION

- There are no traffic impacts.

Construction of a new water booster station for the Plains Pressure Zone.

This is a \$2 million project.

STREET MAINTENANCE CURB RAMPS

- This project is complete.

This project installs ADA-compliant curb ramps where the street department has completed a grind and overlay.

This is a \$700,000 project.

SUNSET HWY (US 2) FROM SPOTTED ROAD TO ROYAL STREET BICYCLE/SHARE USE PATH

- Sunset Highway and W. Sunset Frontage Road between Spotted Road and Assembly Road have lane closures, and the sidewalk is closed to pedestrians.

The Sunset Boulevard Bike Path Project will construct a dedicated multi-use path along the north side of Sunset Boulevard, connecting Spotted Road to Royal Street and pedestrian hybrid beacon. This 10–12-foot-wide path will improve safety and accessibility for pedestrians and cyclists in a high-traffic corridor.

This is a \$2.5 million project.

US 195 MEADOWLANE J-TURN

- This project is complete.

This project will reconstruct the intersection of US 195 and Meadowlane Road to include a J-turn, along with acceleration and deceleration lanes. These upgrades aim to enhance safety and reduce congestion during peak hours, while also preparing for future growth in the area.

This is a \$2.4 million project.

WELLESLEY - FREYA TO HAVANA RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

- This project is complete.

Full reconstruction of Wellesley from Freya to Havana (35-ft., 3-lanes), including stormwater improvements, street trees, and replacing the water distribution main, and a shared use path on the south side of the street.

This is a \$4.5 million project.
