



Safety tips during extreme heat temperatures!

- ☀ Reduce, eliminate, or reschedule strenuous activities until the coolest time of the day.
- ☀ Drink plenty of water (not very cold): Drink water even if you don't feel thirsty.
- ☀ Stay cool, in air-conditioned spaces and in shaded areas.
- ☀ Take a cool bath or shower.
- ☀ Never leave children or pets in a car.
