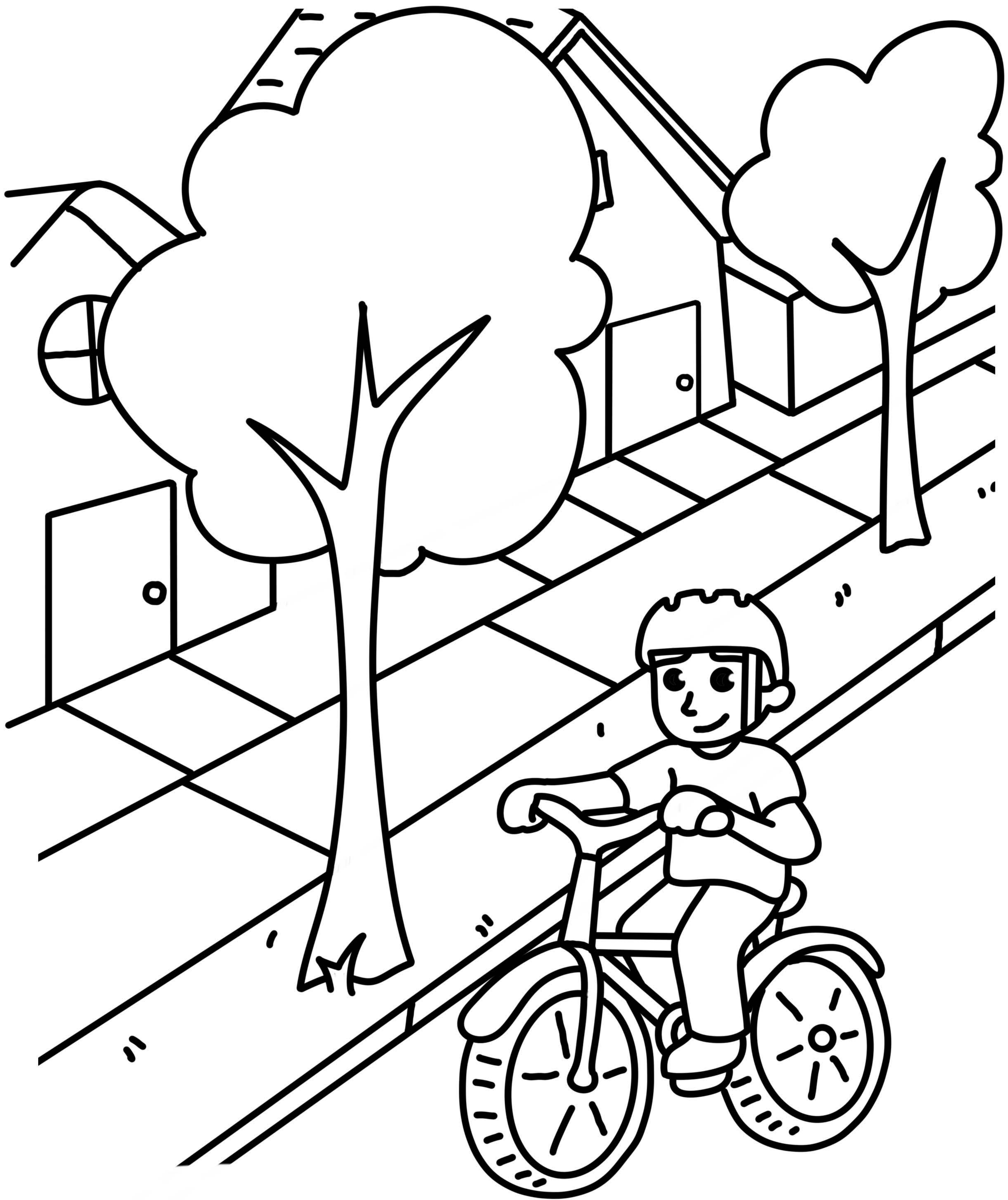

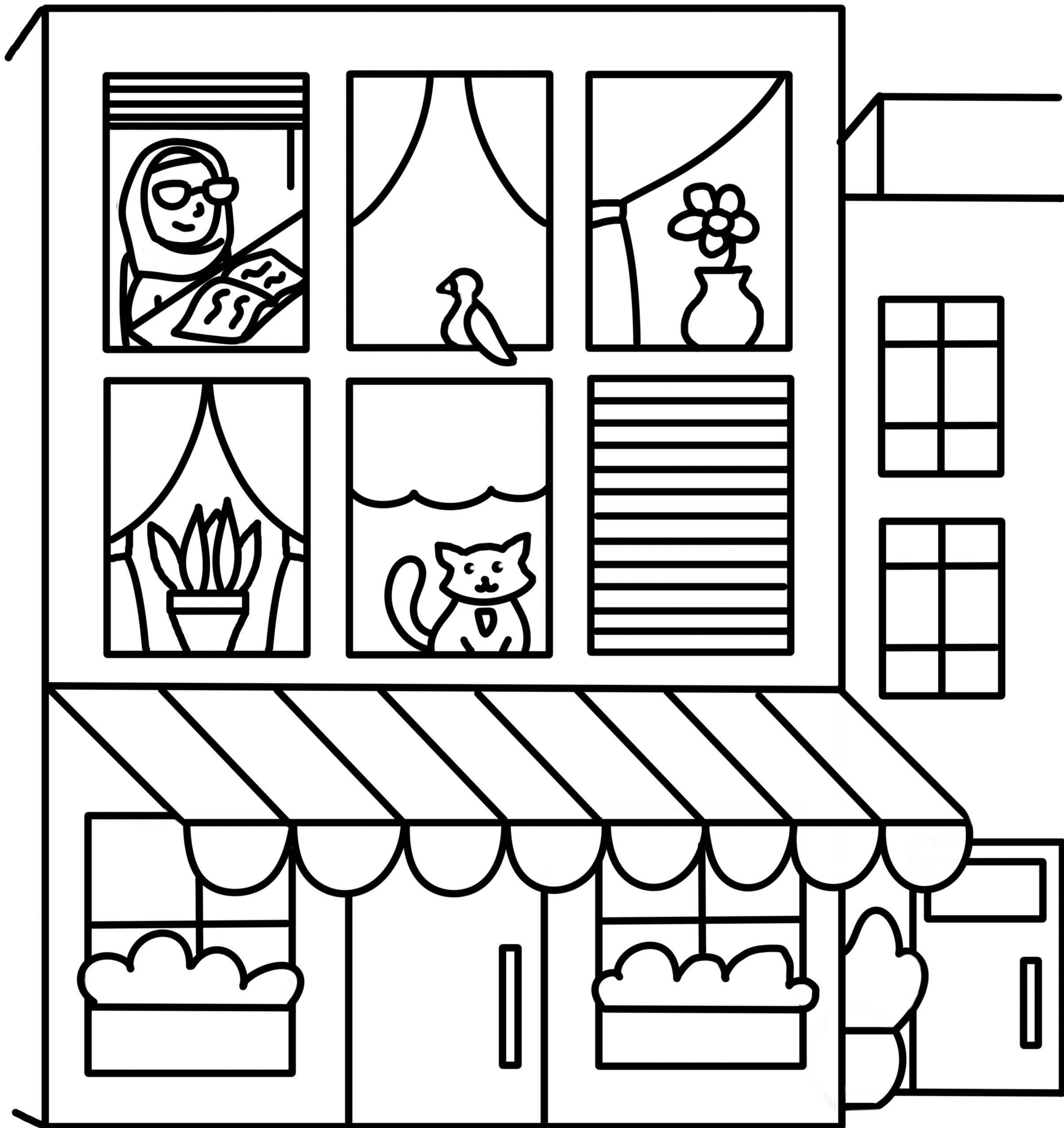
**Have you ever wondered why

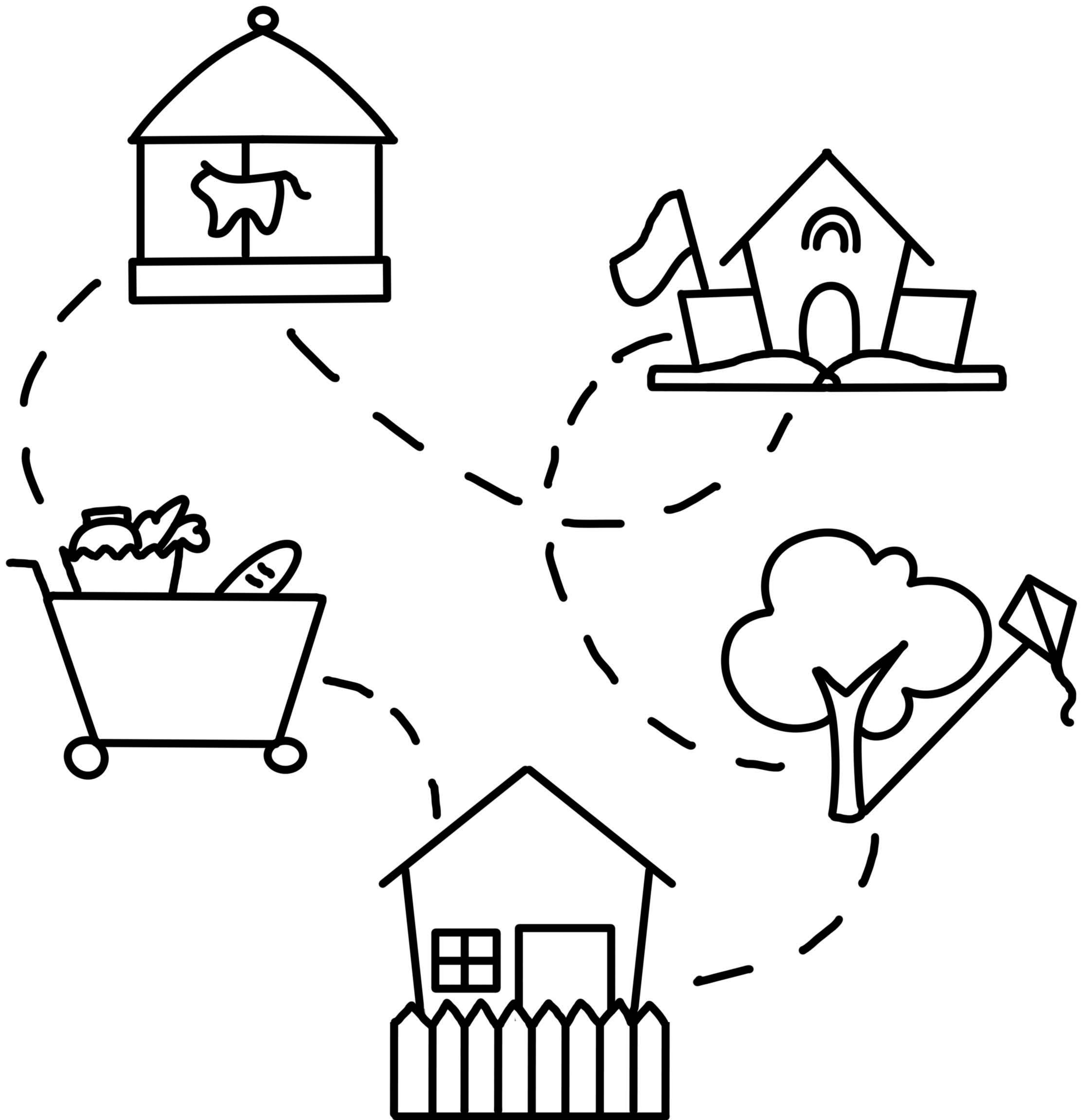


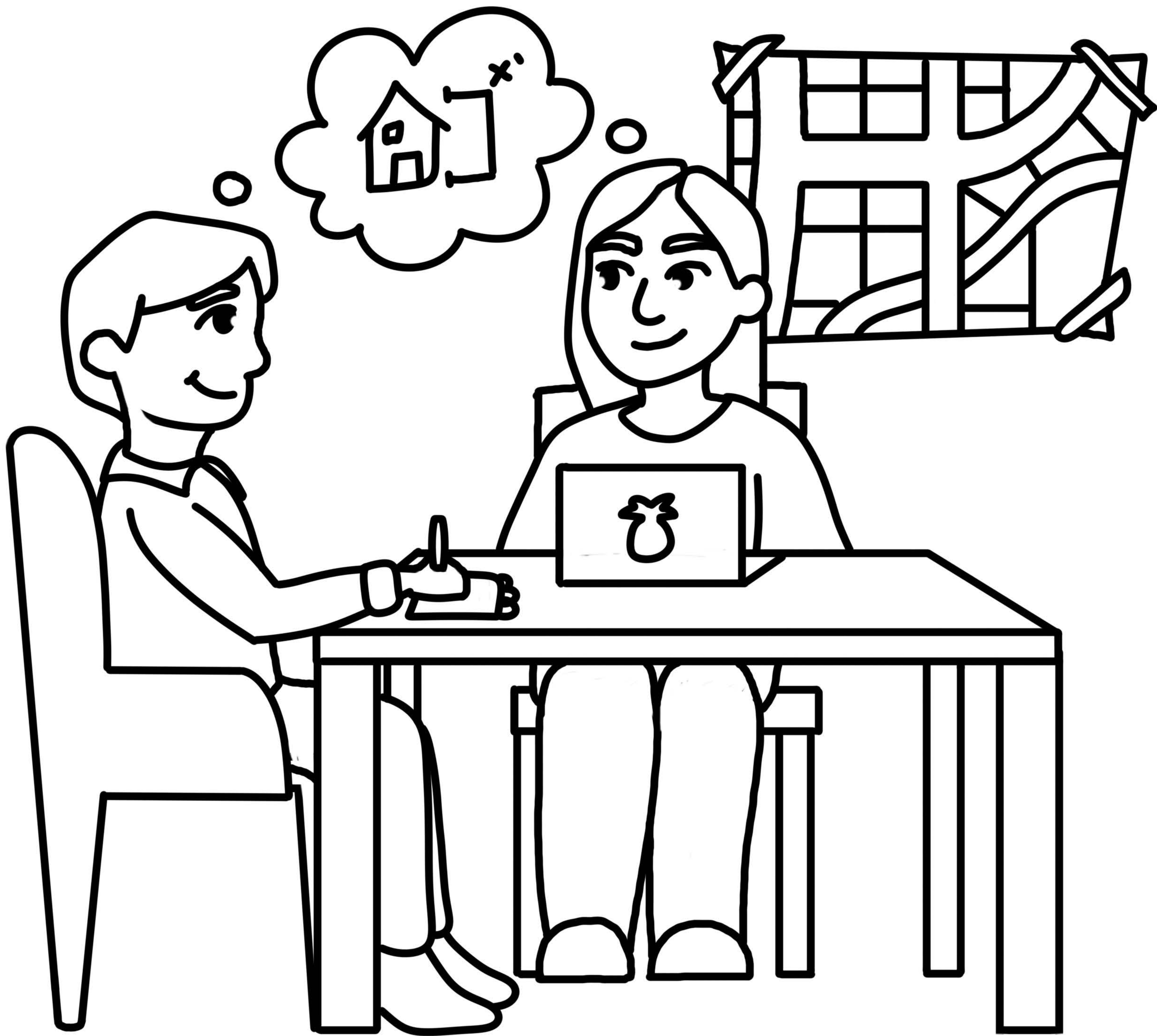

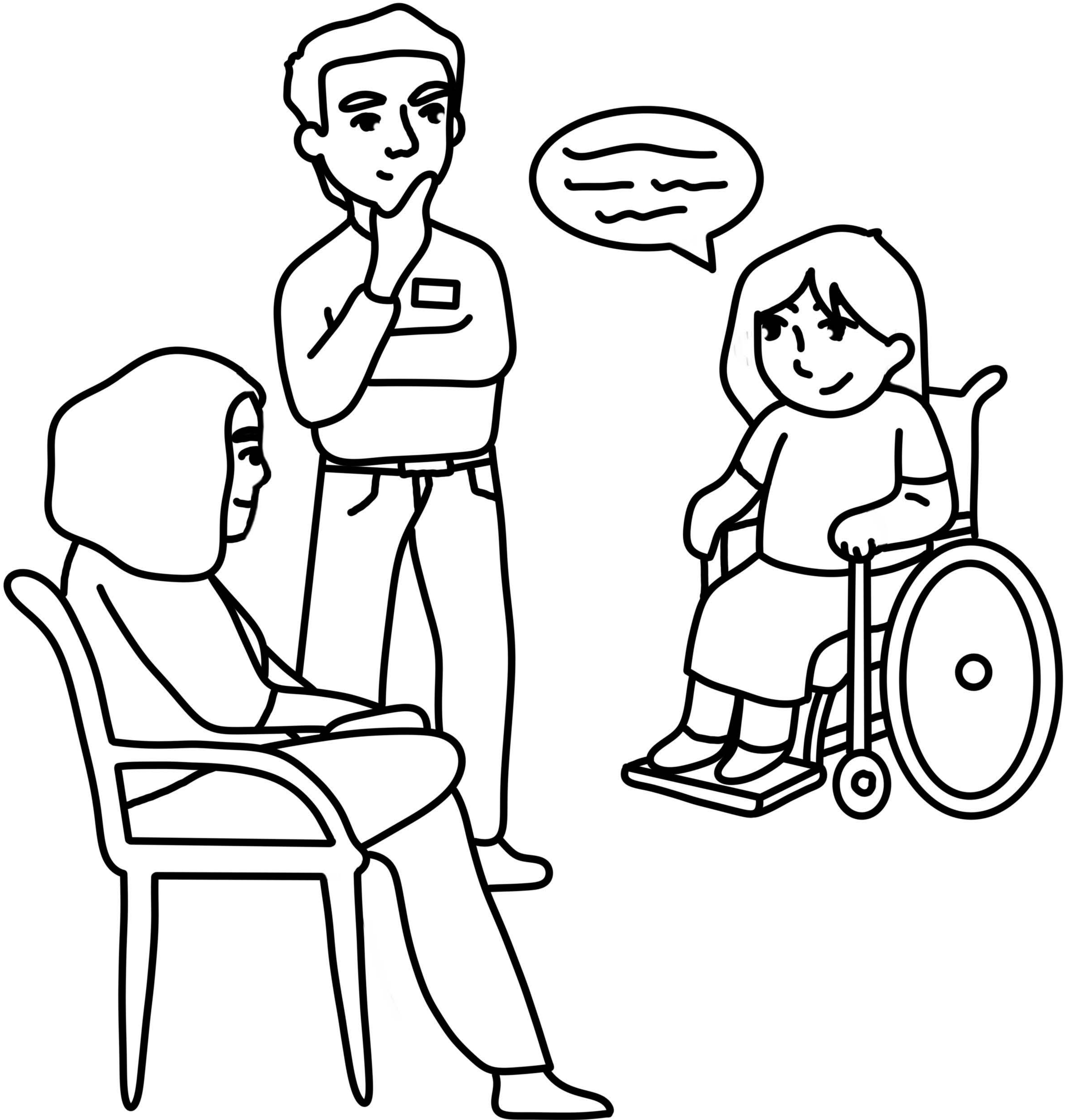
City planning decides what
should go where.

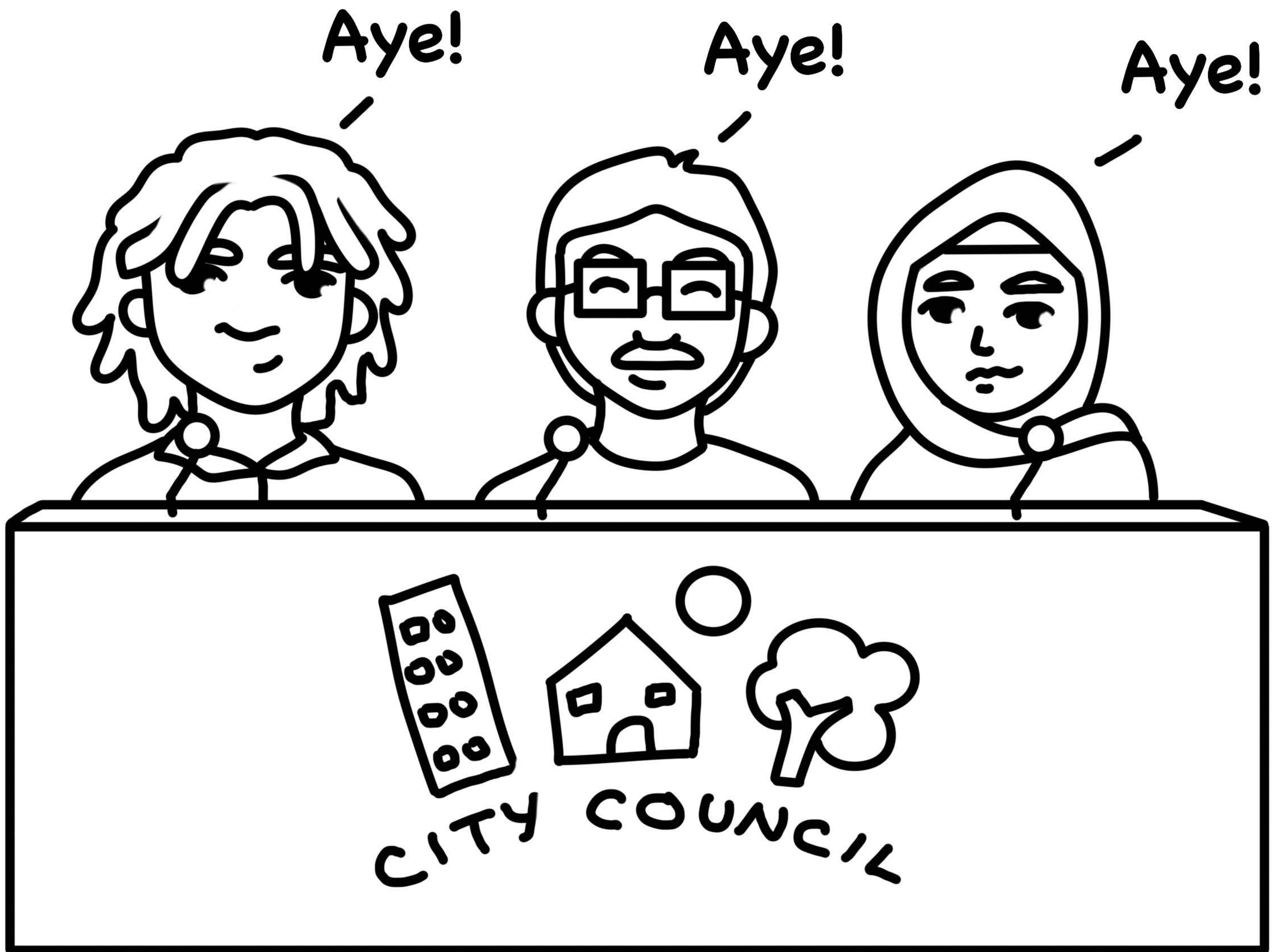




**Planners make rules to make

when constructing new buildings.**



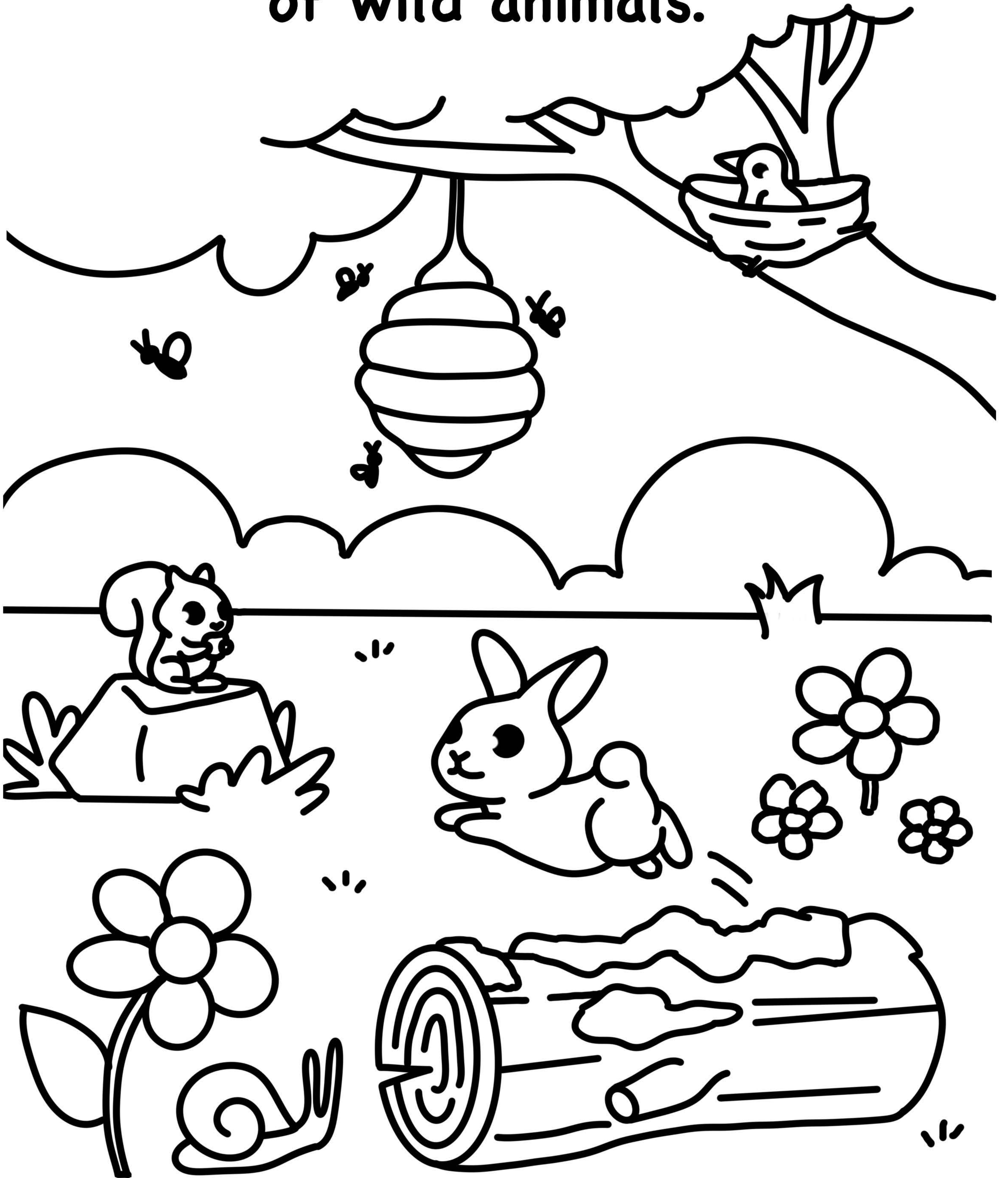


**Planning can bring a new restaurant
